30,000 foot level: The Position of Psalm 100 in the book of Psalms

-88&89: No more Davidic king

-90 Moses: Before the Davidic king, God was king

-91–99: God as king; "the Lord reigns"

-100: Celebration of God the true king

[Ps 100: 1–5]

-Superscription: A Psalm for Giving Thanks

1) Call to praise

"<u>Make a joyful noise</u>"=shout joyfully to the Lord

"all the earth"

2) "Serve the Lord with gladness"

"Serve"=Worship

"Come into his presence with singing"

3) Cause of praise

-Poetic structure of Ps 100: Seven commands

Make, Serve, Come—Know—Enter, Give, bless

-3 things the nations of the world need to know/acknowledge:

- 1) Yahweh is God.
- 2) He made us.
- 3) We belong to him.

-The sheep imagery/metaphor applies primarily to Israel in Psalms.

-The nations need to acknowledge Israel's special position to be saved.

4) Renewed call to praise

"Enter his gates/courts with thanksgiving"

"Thanksgiving...praise...thanks....bless"

T: Thanks R: Respond I: Intercede
