1. After The Promise Of The Cross \_\_\_\_\_ The Promise Of Glory (**Mark 8:38-9:1**)
  - **δόξα** (doxa) - glory, brightness, splendor, radiance; greatness, fame (**Mark 8:38**)
  - **τιβό** (kavod) - glory, weight, something substantial
2. The Promise Of Glory In **Mark 9:1** Finds Its \_\_\_\_\_ In **Mark 9:2-8**
3. There Is A God Given \_\_\_\_\_ For Glory That We All Share (**Mark 9:1, Col. 1:27-28**)

### Jesus' Glory

- **μεταμορφώω** (metamorphoo) - be transfigured, be transformed, a change on the outside that comes from the inside (**Mark 9:2**)

  3. Jesus Is The \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ Moses Leading The Real Exodus (**Luke 9:30-31**)
  4. Jesus Is The Glorious Fulfillment Of The \_\_\_\_\_ (Moses) & The \_\_\_\_\_ (Elijah) (**Malachi 4:4-6**)
  5. It Is Hard For Any Disciple To \_\_\_\_\_ To Jesus' Glory (**Mark 9:5-6**)
