Questions for Discussion:

1. Jesus came to bring life abundant. Are you experiencing that abundance today?
2. Jesus sends us all out within our spheres of influence to bring the good news of his kingdom. Pray for God to save and heal others through your life and testimony.
3. Jesus' mission is often accomplished in and through weakness and bleak circumstances. Are you learning to trust his timing and provision? Pray for one another to walk by faith.
4. If you're a Christian, God has transferred you from the domain of darkness to the kingdom of His beloved Son. In Christ, we have power and authority over the evil one. Rejoice and walk in the freedom of no longer being a slave to darkness. Col. 1:13-14, Eph. 2:1-6
5. God accomplishes his mission through the multiplication of his church. Who are you faithfully discipling? Ask God to send you with Good News and God's healing to the next generation that will carry the torch of the gospel after you die.
6. Are you in a desolate place? Cry out for God to work exceedingly and abundantly beyond what you can ask or imagine. Ephesians 3:20-21
7. Are you feasting on Christ? Read the corollary account of the Feeding of the 5,000 in The Gospel of John, chapter 6. Are you looking to Christ for mere bread or truly seeing Christ as Bread from Heaven in whom we are called to feast upon and delight in. Psalm 34:8
