 - How He Didn't Save Us-
 - How He Did Save Us-
- 3. Saved and Changed By the Holy Spirit (3:5-6)
 - How He Saved Us?
 - By the Washing of Regeneration & Renewal of the Holy Spirit
 - The Line Between Regeneration & Renewal is Hard For Us To Draw
