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Intro:

Two ways of being lost:

1. You're lost and you know it.
2. You're lost but confident that you aren't

Who do you listen to? (1-2)

1. The Lost Sheep and the Lost Coin (3-10)
 - a. Lost
 - b. Found
 - c. Rejoicing
2. The Lost Sons (11-32)
 - a. The younger brother (11-24)
 - i. Lost: His request and results
 - ii. Found: His repentance
 - iii. Rejoicing: The Fathers Response
 - b. The older brother (25-32)
 - i. The Fathers Response
 - ii. The older sons lack of response

3. Our true elder brother (Heb. 2:11, Phil 2, Isaiah 42:3-4)

Questions to dwell on:

- a. Do I receive sinners and eat with them? Could I be “Accused” like Jesus was? (1-2)
- b. What ways am I, or could I be building bridges to those that are lost? How can I partner with Jesus to reach the lost?
- c. In what ways am I like the hedonistic younger brother? What does repenting and trusting in Jesus look like for that?
- d. In what ways am I like the self-righteous elder brother? What does repenting and trusting in Jesus look like for that?
- e. How could I share the prodigal son story with someone who is actively living as the young brother?
- f. Who could I share the prodigal son story with someone who is actively living as the elder brother?
