• Is Good - Nowhere In The Bible Except Possibly <b>Genesis 1:31</b>
The Commands In <b>Mark 10:19-20</b> : The Of The 10 Commandments Is Good For Business; The Does Not Allow Any Other God Including Your Business & Other Good Things To Take God's Place
