#### **Our Relationship With Jesus**

- 1. Our Relationship With Jesus Has Simple Joys (Mark 3:7)
- 2. Our Relationship With Jesus Has Complex Responsibilities (Mark 3:9-10)
- 3. Our Relationship With Jesus Has A Healthy Tension Between Work & Rest (Look at the Last Two Sabbaths-Mark 2:23-27 & Mark 3:1-6 & Mark 3:7-8)

#### **3 Ways To Relate With Jesus**

- 1. Fan: This "Great Crowd" Of Fans Was Coming From Every Direction: (Mark 3:7-10)
  - Their Goal: Touch Him & Be Healed; Jesus Experienced This As Crushing Him!
  - Jesus Was Literally Being Crushed By Their Needs
  - Jesus Goes Down To The Sea & Is Almost Driven Into The Sea

... Not By His Foes But By His Fans

- 2. Follower: What Kind Of Follower Are You?
  - ἀκολουθέω (akoloutheo) to travel with, go after, to follow the behavior of someone, to obey (Mark 3:7)
- 3. Friend: (Mark 3:9, 13-14)
  - Jesus Desires His Disciples To Be With Him & To Become His Friends (John 15:15)
  - Jesus Is Able To Move You From Fan-ship to Friendship

### The Obstacles & Opportunities To Your Relationship With Jesus

- 1. An Obstacles & An Opportunity: Truth- How Is Jesus Spoken About?
  - **Obstacle:** Opponents That Speak Partial Truths In A Lying Way (Mark 3:11)
  - **Opportunity:** Jesus Cares About How He Is Made Known & Desires To Use You (Mark 3:11-12, 14)
- 2. An Obstacles & An Opportunity: Love How Does Jesus Meet Real Human Needs?
  - Obstacle: Crushing Christ With Our Diseases & Distresses (Mark 3:11)
  - **Opportunity:** Jesus Christ Has The Authority To Not Just Heal The Body But Restore The Soul (**Mark 3:10** ... 'For he had healed many.')
- 3. An Obstacles & An Opportunity: Mission What Is The Result Of Jesus' Ministry?
  - **Obstacle:** The Spectacle Of Ministry Can Be An Obstacle To Knowing Christ
  - **Opportunity:** The Spectacle Of Ministry Is An Opportunity To Know Christ Rightly

How Is Your Relationship With Jesus? Have You Been Following Him Like A Fan Or Like A Friend?

You Can Follow Jesus As A Fan, But He Desires You To Follow Him As Lord & Know Him As A Friend.

- 4. We all have a relationship with Jesus. Are you relating with Jesus as a fan? As a follower? As a friend? Or as a foe? How has your relationship with Jesus developed over the years?
- 5. What obstacles and opportunities are in your life right now to grow or distract from your relationship with Jesus?
- 6. What motivates you to grow in your relationship and friendship with Jesus?
