How Jesus Treats Sinners

- 1. Jesus Initiates The Relationship (Mark 2:14)
- 2. Jesus Calls The Unclean & Unlikely (Mark 2:14-15)
- 3. He Ate With "Sinners" Treated Them Like Family & Friends (Mark 2:15-16)
 - ἀμαρτωλῶν (hamartolon) to forfeit by missing the mark, 'wide of the mark' (Mark 2:16)
- 4. To Befriend Many, Befriend One (Mark 2:14-15)

What People Say About It

- "Why does he eat with tax collectors and sinners?" (Mark 2:16)
- 1. Questions Are Asked & Accusations Are Made (Mark 2:16)
 - "He was teaching them..." 2:13
- 2. Jesus Teaches *Who* He Is By Teaching *Why* He Befriends This Way (Mark 2:13,17)

What Jesus Says About It

- "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I came not to call the righteous, but sinners." (Mark 2:17)
- 1. Sick Sinners Need A Soul Physician (Mark 2:17)
- 2. Sinners Need Both Proximity & Potency (Mark 2:17)
 - · Proximity: The Physician Near Us
 - · Potency: Medicine Strong Enough To Heal

How Jesus Can Change Us

- 1. Jesus Makes Us Unafraid To Be The Sinners We Are (Mark 2:17)
- 2. Jesus Changes How We Relate With God (Mark 2:14-17)

- 3. Jesus Changes How We Relate With Others (Mark 2:17)
- 4. Jesus Changes How We Pray, Care, & Share (Col. 4:2-6)

Because Jesus Lovingly Restores Sinners Moms Can Lovingly Pray, Care & Share Christ With Others Around The Table!
