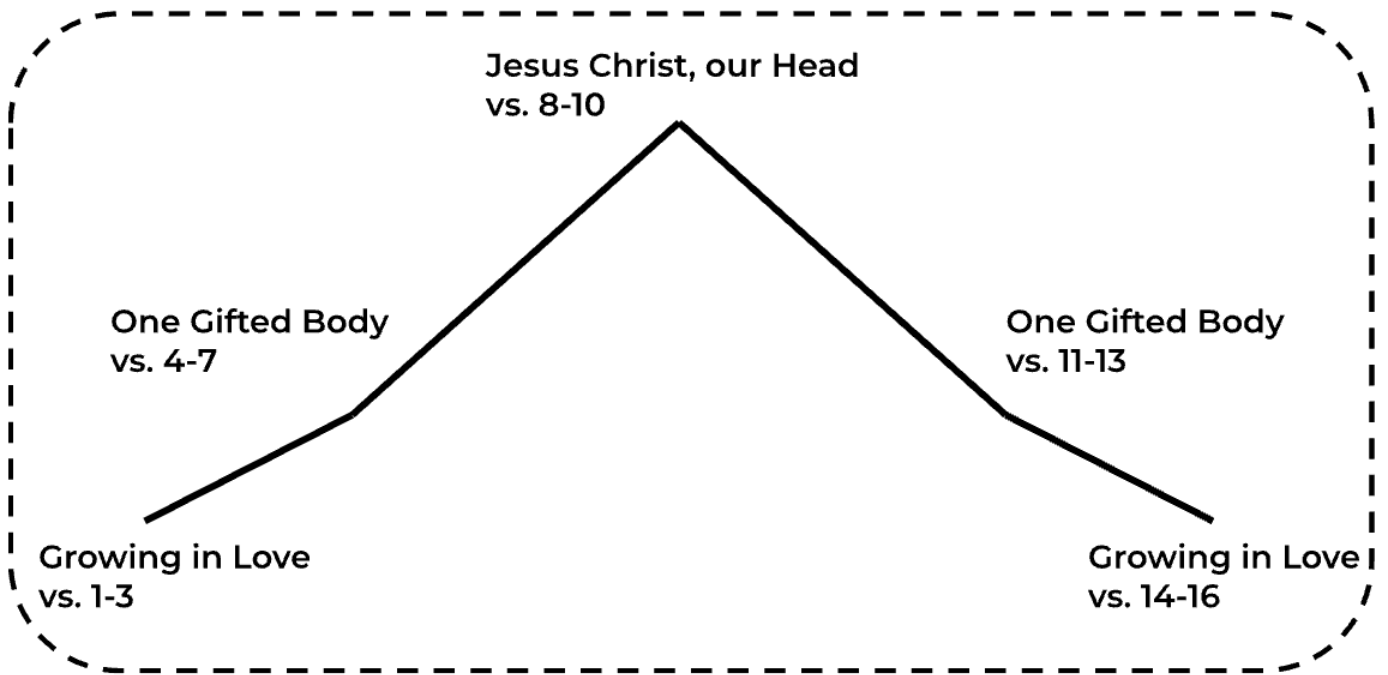

5. How does our society define unity? How does our society define maturity?
6. What are some practical ways we can cultivate a culture at SW Hills that speaks the truth in love and welcomes the truth being spoken in love?
7. How does Christ's ascension affect the way you walk and the way you treat his Body?
8. Is Christ the head of your life? What is an area of your life you need to more faithfully surrender to Christ and his lordship, and walk in a manner worthy of your calling?
