# **Community Group Discussion Questions:**

- 1. What in Jonah as an individual is praiseworthy? What can you admire?
- 2. Consider Jonah's character, especially through the lens of Truth, Love, and Mission. As individuals how do we get so strong in some areas and so weak in others? Why do we get so lopsided so easily?
- 3. God's judgement against sin is not always immediately expressed. How can we be more sensitive to what God is communicating to ourselves and to the people, to the city and to the nations around us? What kinds of warnings does God give?
- 4. Why do we run from God? Why did Jonah run from God? How can we learn to stop running from God and begin walking with God?
