Passover versus Holy Week

•	Jesus' triumphal entry was on the same day as the Passoverentry into Jerusalem.	
•	Jesus cleanses His Father's house when the people are cleansing their own of all leaven.	
•	Jesus teaches in the Temple and is examined and tried by the very priests who are responsible for all Temple sacrifices.	
•	Jesus suffers and dies on the day the Passover lambs are slaughtered at the Temple.	
•	Jesus then rises from the dead when the first fruits of the harvest are offered before the Lord.	
Religious systems versus faith in Jesus:		

You cannot remain neutral when it comes to who Jesus is. Jesus is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world.

John 14:⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

bondage. Jesus offers	Freedom from the oppression and bondage of sin.
