Getting Money

- Get Money Honestly Through Productive Work (Eph. 4:28; 2 Thess. 3:10-12)
- 2. Work Hard To Earn Plenty of Money but be Content with What You Have (Prov. 20:22; Luke 3:14; Phil. 4:10-13; Proverbs 23:4)
- 3. Beware of Borrowing to Get Money (Prov. 22:7; Rom. 13:8)
- 4. Get so You can Give (Eph. 4:28)

Giving Money

- 1. Give to God Because God has Given Everything to You (1 Chronicles 29:13-14; Deut. 8:11-20)
- 2. Give to God by Giving to God's House (Malachi 3:6-12; Acts 4:34-27)
