Theme: Every Family Is On A Journey

Opening Scriptures

- Deuteronomy 6:4–7
- Philippians 4:6–7
- Psalm 119:112

Ice Breaker

If our family were taking a cross-country road trip together:

- Who would be driving?
- Who would be navigating?
- Who would probably get us lost?
- Who would keep everyone laughing?

1. Every Family Is Headed Somewhere

Question: If someone watched our family for one month, where would they say we're headed?

Discuss: priorities, habits, conversations, and spiritual direction.

2. Is God Our Road Map?

Read Deuteronomy 6:4–7. Discuss loving God wholeheartedly, talking about God throughout the week, and when your family can study Scripture together.

3. Are We Navigating With Prayer?

Read Philippians 4:6–7. Discuss your worries, whether you've prayed together, and how God has answered prayer. End by praying together.

4. Does Our Family Live By Faith?

Read Psalm 119:112. Discuss God's promises, perseverance, and faithfulness this week.

5. Are We Refueling?

Discuss what spiritually refreshes each family member (worship, Scripture, prayer, serving, fellowship, quiet time) and plan how to refuel together.

Family Challenge

Choose one this week: Pray together every evening; read one chapter of Scripture daily; eat one phone-free meal discussing God; memorize Deuteronomy 6:5; serve someone together; share one testimony of God's faithfulness each day.

Closing Prayer

Heavenly Father, thank You for placing our family together. Help us follow Your roadmap, love You with all our heart, soul, and strength, make prayer our first response, faith our lifestyle, and Your Word our guide.
