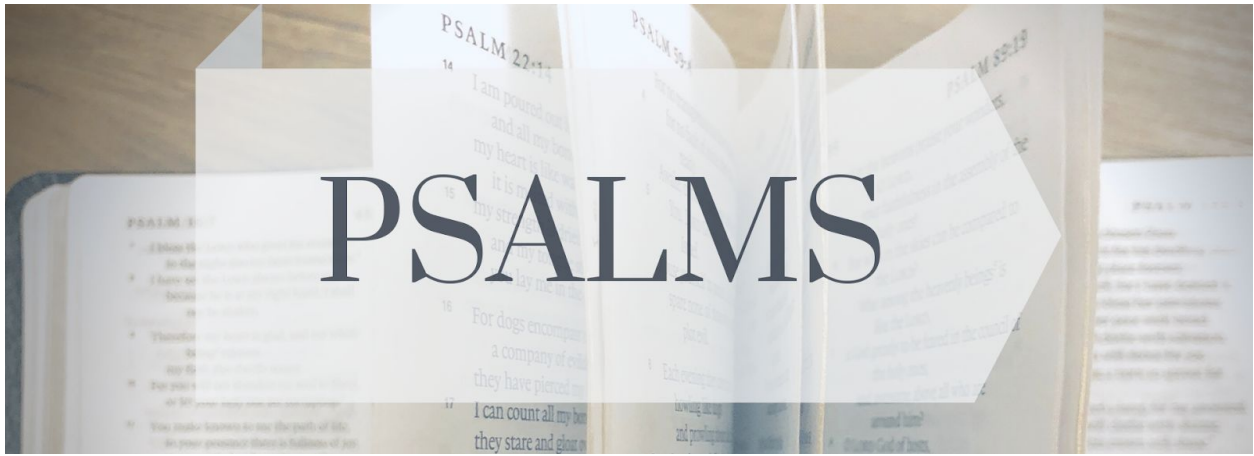

Reflection:

1. Reflect on the struggles you may have in submitting to God's word

4. Reflect on the depth of your knowledge of Christ, your reverence to Christ, and your worship of Christ



Application:

1. Study the following passages (Genesis 6:5; 8:21; Jeremiah 17:9; Ecclesiastes 7:9; Jeremiah 13:23; Romans 3:9-20) and explain Scripture's depiction of humanity's condition and what the gospel declares is the remedy (Romans 3:21-26; Acts 3:19).
2. Study the following passages (Isaiah 53:4-5, 10; Romans 3:23-26; John 3:14-21; Titus 3:3-7) and explain how God's justice and mercy displayed in the sacrifice of Christ aids your response to the problems in this world.
3. Study the following passages (Ephesians 1:4-10; Philippians 2:9-11; Colossians 1:15-17; John 20:24-29) and explain the significance of Christ's rule in your life.
4. Study the following passages (John 14:15-24; Matthew 7:24-27; Romans 6:15-19; James 1:22-25) and evaluate your obedience to Christ.
