## <u>Group Questions – Revelation 11:1-13 – The Two Witnesses</u>

What are some things that make you bold in your communication with others?

Share a time you felt a boldness to talk about something even though you knew it might not be received well.

Read - Revelation 11:1-6

Would you consider these 2 witnesses to be WEAK or STRONG?

Describe the power these 2 witnesses possess.

What is the source of power for these 2 witnesses?

<u>Read</u> – Jesus' instruction to His disciples in... Luke 24:49 - "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven."

How does Jesus describe the Holy Spirit here?

The word "POWER" is the Greek word "DYNAMIS" which is the same word from where we get our word "DYNAMITE".

What does that tell you about what the Holy Spirit is able to do in us?

Why did Jesus tell His disciples to WAIT until they were filled with this power?

- ~ Before Jesus was crucified, Peter denied knowing Jesus to a few people.
- ~ After Pentecost, Peter publicly shared Jesus with thousands of people.

## What changed in Peter?

**Read** – about a prayer meeting in... Acts 4:31 - And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

What was the result of being filled with the Holy Spirit?

**Read** – Paul's instruction to Christians in... Ephesians 5:18 – "do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit"

Why do you think Paul COMMANDED us to be filled with the Spirit?

Based on Acts 4:31, what is the result we can expect from being filled with the Holy Spirit?

**Read** – John 15:18-19

Based on these verses, what can we expect as part of our boldness in sharing the word of God?

Why do most people hate to be hated?

How can our desire to be liked, keep us from sharing the Lord with others?

**Read** – Revelation 11:7-10

What happened to these two bold witnesses?

Why do you think the beast was able to kill them?

You might not have your life threatened for sharing the Lord with people, but what other threats might you face?

Read - Matthew 10:28

What is Jesus' exhortation to us regarding where we should place our fear?

How does this statement give us a "secret" to overcoming the fear of people?

**<u>Read</u>** – Revelation 11:11-13

Who had the REAL POWER over these two witnesses?

**<u>Read</u>** – Psalm 139:16

What does this verse tell us about who has the REAL POWER over our lives?

How can all these truths help encourage us to be bold for the Lord?

Close in prayer asking for the filling of the Holy Spirit to give us the POWER to be bold in sharing the Lord with people
