Read – Revelation 1:4-19

What do you think it means that Jesus is the LAMB of God?

What do you think it means that Jesus is the LION of the tribe of Judah?

How could this depiction of Jesus be harmful?

How much do you think of Jesus as your FRIEND, compared to Jesus as your LORD?

Why do you think understanding Jesus as both the LAMB and the LION is important?

How can a good mother or father be both LION and LAMB?

How could it be bad for a mother or father to be ONLY... LION or LAMB?

What are the dangers of mistakenly seeing Jesus as ONLY... LAMB?

What are the dangers of mistakenly seeing Jesus as ONLY... LION?



The Jewish leaders of Jesus' day were expecting the Messiah to show up on the scene as the LION of the tribe of Judah, so they missed the Messiah when Jesus showed up as the LAMB of God.

How can we run the same risk of “missing the Messiah” if we are not willing to see Jesus as both LION and LAMB?
