

Group Questions – Revelation 4:1 – Repentance and Revival

Can you share a time, as a CHILD, you were disciplined and didn't understand why, but then, later in life, you got it?

Or...

Can you share a time, as a PARENT, when you had to discipline your child, but they didn't understand?

In Revelation 2-3, Jesus shared some rebukes He had for Christian people

Read – Revelation 2:4-5

What is the rebuke Jesus shares?

In what ways can we leave our first love?

How does Jesus say we can get back?

Read – Revelation 3:14-19

What is the rebuke Jesus shares?

What can cause us to become "luke-warm"?

How does Jesus say we can catch fire again?

The answer Jesus gives to both situations is to REPENT or TURN AROUND

Read – Ephesians 5:14

Who do you think this verse is directed to? Believers or unbelievers?

How can believers in Jesus "fall asleep" or become "dead"?

How can we "awake from our sleep" or "rise from the dead"?

If you were on your way to a party and you realized your phone map app had given you the wrong directions and led you down the wrong road, what would you do?

Turning around in order to get where you want to go is a GOOD THING.

Why do you think many people have a hard time thinking about turning around – REPENTING – in their walk with the Lord?

Read – John 7:37-38

What do you think Jesus meant by “out of his heart will flow rivers of living water”?

Do you feel like this describes your life right now?

If not, what do you think is the problem?

If you are going down the wrong road, do you want to turn around?

How do we do turn around in our walk with the Lord?

Do you think the “rivers of living water” are something that we create or something that God does in us?

If God wants “rivers of living water” flowing out of us, what could be stopping it from happening?

Read – 2 Chronicles 7:14

What advice does God give us in this verse?

Read – Acts 3:19

What is the promise that repentance will bring?
