GETTING TO KNOW YOU

 Have you ever "wandered" from the Lord? What happened? How were you brought back?

QUICK REVIEW

Looking over your notes from this past teaching... was there anything you heard for the first time, caught your attention, challenged you, or confused you?

MAIN POINT

Life is short, eternity is real, and revival begins when ordinary people are unashamed to speak about Jesus.

DIGGING IN

 Do you think we should speak to other believers about sin we notice in their life? Why or why not?

READ - James 5:19-20

- Since the gospel literally means "good news" why would we be hesitant to share that with other people?
- How does the understanding that the Apostle Paul experienced fear in sharing the gospel effect your feelings about your own fear?
- Pastor Nate shared,
 - "Fear does not disqualify you but makes room for God's power."
- How does that quote effect your courage to share with others?

- How can this understanding we, who believe in Jesus, are here on earth as AMBASSADORS for the kingdom of God – effect the way we live and speak?
- What might it reveal about us, if we don't know how to explain our relationship with God?
- How could sharing our own testimony help turn a sinner from their sin?
- Where do you think fear and embarrassment over the truth of the gospel of Jesus Christ comes from?
- How can understanding the above answer help us fight fear and embarrassment?
- Do you ever wish you could have been a part of a past powerful move of God?
- How might it be possible that God is calling us today to be the start of a new powerful move of God?
