Icebreaker

What's something you've spent money, time, or energy on recently that felt totally "worth it" to you?

Read Together

John 12:1-8

Discussion Questions

1. What stood out to you most from the message or passage?

Was there a moment, phrase, or idea that stuck with you?

2. "We are all worshippers... the question isn't if, but what."

What tends to get your time, attention, and energy right now?
If someone looked at your calendar or habits, what would they say you value most?

3. Worship costs something

Why do you think we tend to give Jesus our "leftovers" instead of our best?
What is one area (time, finances, energy, attention, etc.) where God may be inviting you to put Him first?

4. Worship is unashamed

What are some things that make us self-conscious or hesitant in our worship (public or private)?
How does focusing on *who Jesus is* help us care less about what others think?

5. Worship has a fragrance (it impacts others)

Can you think of someone whose faith or devotion to Jesus has impacted you personally?

In what ways can your everyday life reflect worship to the people around you?

6. Mary saw what others missed

Why do you think Mary recognized what Jesus was about to do when others didn't?
How can we grow in awareness of what Jesus is doing in our lives right now?

Response Question

What is one specific thing you feel God is asking you to “pour out” or surrender to Him right now?

(Encourage people to be specific and, if appropriate, share it with the group)

Close in Prayer

Thank Jesus for giving everything for us

Pray for courage to live lives “poured out” in response

Invite the Holy Spirit to help each person take a next step in worship this week
