Truth and Compromise Revelation 19:6-10

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

- What was the best... party/celebration/wedding reception... you have ever been to?
- What made it so great?
- When you think about going to be with Jesus, what do you think it will be like?

QUICK REVIEW

MAIN POINT

The "marriage supper of the Lamb" is going to be the most enjoyable celebration we have ever experienced!

DIGGING DEEPER

Read - Revelation 19:6-10

REVIEW

(READ THROUGH THIS TO REFRESH EVERYONE'S MEMORY ABOUT THIS ANALOGY)

Marriage in John's day consisted of 3 parts...

1) THE MARRIAGE CONTRACT

Parents and bride and groom would agree to the marriage A dowry was paid to the bride's family Couple was considered married but did not live together Groom prepared a house for the couple Bride prepared herself for her groom and waited expectantly

2) GETTING THE BRIDE

Nobody knew when this would happen except the father of the groom When the groom's father said it was time, the groom would go get the bride

When the groom and his friends arrived at the bride's house, she would know it was time to get married by the blowing of the Shofar (a horn) The bride needed to be ready for the groom to come and get her at any time

3) THE WEDDING FEAST/SUPPER

The groom took the bride back to their new home and had a 7 day feast to celebrate the consummation of their marriage
