### MAIN POINT

- How can understanding the incredibly heavy persecution of the first Christians, including the execution of most of the writers of the New Testament, debunk this thought?
- Why do you think the Bible has been the most scrutinized collection of literature throughout the ages?
- Although it has been the most scrutinized book ever, still nothing in the Bible has ever been definitively disproven. What does this tell you?

#### <u>Read</u> – Revelation 1:19

This is only one of many places where God instructs someone to write down what He is revealing to them.

• Why do you think God wants the things in the Bible to be written down and preserved?

#### <u>Read</u> – Genesis 3:1

- How was Satan attempting to set Eve up to sin?
- How can modern day skepticism of the Bible be in line with Satan's mission?
- What is the difference between searching out questions you have about the Bible vs. looking for excuses not to believe the Bible?
- What is the difference between BLIND FAITH and INTELLECTUAL FAITH?
- Do we need to set aside our intellect to believe the Bible? Why or why not?
- What are current questions you have about the authenticity of the Bible?
- What do you plan to do to seek out answers to these questions?
