One way we find abundant life is through CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY

<u>Read</u> – Acts 2:42-47

- Verse 44 says that these people had all things in common. What do you think is meant by that statement?
- Describe what you think this CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY was like? Was it enjoyable? Challenging? Refreshing?

Read – Colossians 3:9-11 and Galatians 3:28

- Describe your understanding of how we all, being very different, can still be ONE in Christ.
- What are some of the things that prevent us from experiencing this "ONENESS" in Christ with each other?
- Why don't all Christians get along perfectly all the time?
- Is "getting along" necessary for true Christian community?

Read – 2 Corinthians 13:11, 1 Peter 3:8, and Ephesians 4:1-6

What were Paul and Peter pleading with these Christian people to do?

<u>Read</u> – John 17:20-21

- What do you think Jesus meant by wanting us to be "ONE"?
- Why do you think our "ONENESS" is so important to Jesus?
- If you are a parent of more than one child, do you want your children to be ONE? Why?
- How can we bless our Father in heaven by seeking to be ONE?

<u>Read</u> – Romans 12:9-16

• In these verses, what are some of the attitudes and actions Paul points to as being necessary to create true Christian community?

Read - Proverbs 18:1

- What does this exhortation have to say about community?
- What is unwise about isolating ourselves?
