

Group Questions – Joshua 24:1-28 – Choose This Day

How would you define the title “GOD”?

What is the difference between a BIG “G” - God... and LITTLE “g” - gods?

How would you define “WORSHIP” of a god?

What are some common LITTLE “g” – gods people worship today?

What are some LITTLE “g” – gods YOU have worshipped in your life?

Read – Matthew 6:24

What are the extreme positions Jesus presents regarding our feelings towards BIG “G” - God... and LITTLE “g” - gods?

Pastor Nate shared, ***“You can’t worship God AND anything else... You’ll either worship God OR worship the other thing.”***

Why does the worship of other things hinder our ability to worship God?

Read – Joshua 24:1-14

How can the way our “forefathers” worshipped effect the way we worship?

Read – Joshua 24:15

Why might some people incorrectly think it is “evil” to worship God?

Why do you think Joshua pushes the people to make a decision on who to serve?

Why do you think it’s important for us to make a decision on who to serve?

An old worship song states, ***“I have decided to follow Jesus, no turning back.”***

Do you think it’s a one-time decision or a continual decision to serve the Lord?

Read – James 2:19

Since they both believe, why is a Christian saved and a demon not saved?

What do you think is the difference between... choosing to serve God, and just believing in God?

Read – Luke 6:46-49

Pastor Nate shared how there are many good things in life that are not to be our foundation for life.

Through your life, what are some good things you have mistakenly set as the foundation for your life?

What happens to a building when its foundation crumbles?

What happens to a life when its foundation crumbles?

Why is it a KIND thing for Jesus to tell us to set Himself, and His teaching, as the foundation for our lives?

Read – Matthew 6:31-33

How can the foundation of Jesus, and His teaching, destroy worry in our life?

Some people WORRY that if they give their whole life to serving the Lord, that they will not have the life they want to have.

Read – Romans 8:32

How does that verse alleviate the worry of giving your all to serve the Lord?
