- How does God creating humanity in His image show us His desire for relationship with us?
- What wrecked Adam and Eve's perfect relationship with God?

<u>Read</u> – Ephesians 2:14

• What did Jesus do for our relationship with God?

<u>Read</u> – Genesis 2:18 and Proverbs 18:1

- What do these verses teach us about our need for relationship with others?
- What can make relationship with other Christians difficult?

Read - Proverbs 18:24

- What does this verse say we need to do if we want to have friends?
- According to this verse who is probably at fault if we don't have any good relationships?

<u>**Read**</u> – Matthew 5:23-24

- What does this verse teach us regarding fractured relationships?
- Have you ever thought, "I will make amends but only after that person says they're sorry."?
- What does Jesus say in Matthew 5 that contradicts that thought process?
- Why would Jesus want us to make every attempt to heal relationships with people who are mad at us?

<u>**Read**</u> – Romans 12:18

- How do you know if you have done everything possible to live at peace with all people?
- Based on all these verses how important do you think it is to God that we live in harmony with other people... specifically people in our church?
- Why do you think God takes our relationships with one another so seriously?
