Group Questions – Joshua 23 – God Keeps His Promises

Joshua 23 is Joshua's "farewell speech" to the Israelite people.

If you knew you would die soon, what would you want to tell people?

<u>**Read**</u> – Joshua 23

What are some of the promises Joshua had seen God fulfill in his lifetime? **Remind people that Joshua was a slave in Egypt many years before **Try to recount all the miraculous promises God fulfilled over those years

What are some of the promises YOU have seen God fulfill in YOUR lifetime?

What are some of the promises God has yet to fulfill?

What are some of the reasons why we don't think God will fulfill His promises?

<u>**Read**</u> – Joshua 23:14

Why do you think Joshua had to remind the Israelites of this fact?

<u>**Read**</u> – Numbers 23:19

What does this verse teach us regarding God's ability to keep His promises?

Read - Hebrews 10:23

What does this verse teach us regarding God keeping His promises?

Read – 2 Timothy 2:13

Whose faithfulness are God's promises dependent upon?

Pastor Nate shared the example of threatening to spray someone with bear spray and people believe that very readily.

Why is it easier for us to believe God's promise of judgment, rather than God's promise of blessing?

A blindfolded person cannot see the things around them, but they are still there

How are the reality of God's promises similar to the reality of things a blindfolded person can't see?

Pastor Nate shared the example of us being sheep just needing to follow our shepherd

Share some ways we can trust in God's promises the way a sheep trusts its shepherd.

Read – Matthew 6:25-33

How does Jesus' teaching relate to trusting in God's promises?

What are the things you are worried about today?

How does trusting God's promises help us to not worry?
