What Do You Seek? – Amos 6:1

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

MAIN POINT

Seeking pleasure above all else, leads to destruction. While seeking God above all else, leads to joy.

REVIEW

DIGGING INTO THE WORD

- Can you share any examples of how you have seen Christians living like we should just focus on BEING GOOD and not interested in HAVING JOY?

- Can you share any examples of how you have seen Christians thinking we should just SEEK PLEASURE and not worry about BEING GOOD?
- What is the danger of that type of Christianity?

Read – Matthew 6:33 and 1 Timothy 6:17

- What do these verses have to teach us about...
 - 1) What WE should seek
 - VS.
 - 2) What GOD wants to give us
- What can happen if we get these 2 things backwards?

Pastor Paul shared these 5 "ERROR CODES" that can happen in our lives when we begin seeking pleasure above seeking God...

1) WE MISPLACE OUR TRUST

2) WE PROCRASTINATE IMPORTANT SPIRITUAL ISSUES

3) WE HURT OTHER PEOPLE

4) WE LOVE OURSELVES MORE THAN WE LOVE GOD AND OTHERS

5) WE ARE NOT GRIEVED BY OUR SIN
