Understand What the Will of the Lord Is - Ephesians 5:17

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

- Share a time you really wanted to know God's will about something, but you had a difficult time figuring out what His will was.
- How did you feel during that struggle?
- How did that situation get resolved? Did you ever learn God's will?

MAIN POINT

It is wise for us to understand God's will for our lives.

REVIEW

Looking over your notes from this past teaching... was there anything you heard for the first time, caught your attention, challenged you, or confused you?

DIGGING INTO THE WORD

Read – Ephesians 5:17

- What do you think is the difference between KNOWING God's will and UNDERSTANDING God's will?
- Why would it be foolish/unwise to not understand God's will?
- Share a time you made a choice and later came to the realization that was not God's will for you.
- Do you think God gives up on us if we choose to not follow His will? Why or why not?

- What are some negatives about having a boss who does not clearly communicate their expectations of you?
- When we feel like God is not clearly communicating His will with us, what might be the issue?

Pastor Nate shared these 5 steps to discovering God's will...

- 1) Silence your voice
- 2) Spend time in God's word
- 3) Spend time in prayer
- 4) Seek Godly counsel
- 5) Look for where God is working
- What are the dangers of only doing one of these 5 steps, but not all of them?
- Of these 5 steps, which one do you find the most difficult?
- What are you currently needing to know God's will about?
