

Group Questions – Revelation 5 – Who Is Worthy?

Generally speaking, would you characterize yourself as a person who...

- A) ENJOYS... being told by other people what to do**
- B) DISLIKES... being told by other people what to do**

What makes us resistant to being led by other people?

Why do you think some people want Jesus as SAVIOR, but not as LORD?

Have you ever struggled having Jesus as LORD of your life?

What makes us resistant to being led by JESUS?

Since we are sinful people, and Jesus is perfect in all His ways, how has Jesus led you by changing your mind, or your behavior recently?

If Jesus hasn't recently changed anything in us, either we have become perfect, or we are resisting His lordship in our life... which one do you think is more likely true?

Read – Revelation 5:1-3

Pastor Nate shared that the scroll represented a will and testament. The only ones who were "worthy" to open it, were the ones who sealed it and were receiving the inheritance.

Pastor Nate shared that this scroll represented the inheritance to the perfect kingdom of God.

What do you think it means that no one was found worthy to open this scroll?

In what ways has mankind tried to usher in a perfect kingdom?

Why do you think none of these attempts have succeeded?

Read – Revelation 5:4

Why do you think John is weeping?

In what ways might we "weep" over the future condition of our world?

Read – Revelation 5:5

What does the elder say is the solution for John's weeping?

Read – Revelation 5:6-7

What does John see?

Where's the Lion?

How is Jesus both the Lion and the Lamb?

Why do you think Jesus displays Himself as a lamb instead of a lion here?

Pastor Nate shared... 7 = COMPLETION - HORNS = POWER - EYES = KNOWLEDGE

What does it mean that this lamb had 7 HORNS and 7 EYES?

Read – Revelation 5:8-14

Why is it said that Jesus, the Lamb, is the only one WORTHY to open this scroll?

Since Jesus is the only one worthy to usher in God's perfect kingdom here on earth, do you think He is worthy to rule your life?

What makes us doubt Jesus' worthiness to rule our lives?

How can we help ourselves be more open to Jesus' rule in our lives?
