# DIGGING INTO THE WORD

#### Read Ephesians 4:1-2

• How is healthy lowliness/humility different than unhealthily hating ourselves?

#### Read Philippian 2:3

- Why do you think God wants us to love others more than ourselves?
- When someone treats you like they esteem you more than themselves, how does that make you feel?

Gentleness = meekness – having our strength and emotions under control

• What kinds of things cause you to lose control of yourself?

#### Read Proverbs 15:1

- Why do you think God did not instruct us to get angrier and yell louder than the other person?
- What might cause you to not want to respond to someone's anger with a soft answer? How might this be a lack of trust in God?

#### Read Romans 12:17-21

- How do these verses in Romans relate to God's call for us to be gentle?
- How can the term *longsuffering* be more accurate than the term *patience*?
- How do patience, and a desire to be in control, contrast with each other?
- How does loving others help us to be lowly/humble?
- How does loving others help us to be gentle?
- How does loving others help us to be longsuffering/patient?
- If we find it difficult to love others, what do you think the issue is? How do we fix it?
- Why is faith and trust in God necessary to see these 3 things active in our lives?
- How does the Holy Spirit help us to accomplish these 3 things?
- How does looking to Jesus help us live out these 3 things?
- How did Jesus live out these 3 things in His life?
