Luke 19:29-44 – Which Jesus Do You Want?

GETTING TO KNOW YOU

- Share a time you were part of a big celebration. What was the cause for the celebration? How were people celebrating?

QUICK REVIEW

Looking over your notes from this past teaching... was there anything you heard for the first time, caught your attention, challenged you, or confused you?

MAIN POINT

It is important for us to have a correct understanding of who Jesus truly is, and who we truly are.

DIGGING INTO THE WORD

- Jesus has many titles. Explain what these titles mean to you.
 - Christ/Messiah/Savior
 - Lord/King
- Do you think it's possible to have Jesus as your Savior but not as your Lord?
- Why might some desire to have Jesus as their Savior but not as their Lord?
- If Jesus is your SAVIOR, is that something for this life, eternity, or both?
- If Jesus is your KING, is that something for this life, eternity, or both?
- Describe what life is like for people with these 2 different views of life...
 - Us trying to get GOD on OUR PROGRAM
 - Us trying to get OURSELVES on GOD'S PROGRAM

- What can cause us to drift into an incorrect view where we see ourselves in the place of king and Jesus in the place of servant?
- How can we keep ourselves in a place of accurate relationship with ourselves in the place of servant and Jesus in the place of king?
- Jesus came first to suffer and die, and will come again as the conquering king. What does this mean for the lives of those of us who seek to follow Jesus?
- How would you describe the difference between just believing in Jesus and living a life of relationship with Jesus?
- How can you know you have a relationship with the TRUE JESUS, rather than a Jesus you have created in your own mind?
- What is the difference between asking Jesus to answer our prayers, and seeing that Jesus is the answer to our prayers?

PRAISE REPORTS & PRAYER REQUESTS

Take some time each week to share prayer requests and praise reports.

Have someone in your group record these prayer requests and email them out to the whole group to be praying for each other throughout the week.

Close with a time of prayer.
