So I want to encourage you to do that. Also, for those of you on the fly, you can download

the Bill Crone app for free, and that basically unlocks the whole thing. You can watch all

kinds of studies for the last 11 years. You know those preachers; they just keep going on and

on.

But anyway, that's right, we are here to talk about what?

The reward of the rapture. And again, last time we dealt with the aspect of the importance

of it, the purpose for the saved and unsaved.

But even as the saved, we go, Yeah, I believe in the rapture, you know, and that's great. It's

the blessed hope, looking forward to it. But we kind of stop there and some of the ways that

I know that we kind of stop there is because I look at our countenances. Have you ever

noticed that, right?

You know, people sit there and say, I'm a Christian.

But it's not like, Hi, I'm a Christian! (Said with excitement)

It's I'm a Christian. (Sounding depressed)

It's like man, what have you been eating, pickles, prunes, sour lemons?

What's your diet consist of?

That's not really a good advertisement, I'm a Christian. (Sounding depressed)

You make it look like it's a chore. It's just so tough being a Christian. (Sounding depressed).

What?

It's not a good advertisement. It's, Hey, yeah, right?

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And I'm telling you, if you understand the reward at the rapture, all that Christ has won for

us, yes, praise God, He saved us from eternal damnation to hell, that should keep a smile on

your face.

But folks, I'm telling you, we forget He saved us for so much more. It's the future and bang, it

all starts at the rapture. Nobody can take it away.

And I'm telling you, if you really get that today, then you're going to walk out of here and

you'll have to pay somebody five bucks to slap that smile off. And you're going to be a

positive advertisement for Jesus. So let's talk about that.

But let's pray. Father, we love You and thank You so much for today. We thank You for the

privilege to be encouraged in your truth, and certainly as we now take a look at our future

that nobody can take away. You tell us in Your Word, God, that it's kept in heaven for you.

That means nobody can rip it off, they can't take it away. And so it's safe and secure because

it's all done; it's finished. Just like we just sung, it's finished through the cross of Jesus Christ.

He did all the work, and it's just a wonderful gift for you that last forever and ever. So open

our hearts and our minds, God. Help us to do what You tell us to do. Get your mind off this

earth; get your mind on things above, oh!

We're not saved for this messed up version of the earth down here. We're saved for the

world to come. What a day that's going to be. And it all begins at the rapture.

So God, if we're not really being a good advertisement for Jesus, just lumping around with

our face, God, please put that smile back on today. It should be there every day if we really

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get what You've done for us.

And as always God, if there's anybody here that's not truly born-again, that's not saved,

would You please save them before it's too late?

As we saw especially last service, this is not a joke. They don't want to be left behind. And so

God, please have mercy on them and save them. May they join us in this incredible future

that You won for we the church, Your bride.

And we ask Your blessings upon this study, even now we ask all this in Your wonderful name,

in Jesus' name, and all God's people said, Amen.

Hey, that's right, once again, the reward of the rapture. You guys have sung that song

before, probably, right?

But have you looked at people in the church today?

They sing it this way: I got the joy, joy, joy down in my heart. (Sounding depressed)

And then, of course, the next line: Where?

Because I don't see it in you. What's going on? What is going on with the church today,

right?

It's just like, what happened to being excited for Jesus and that you're saved? What's going

on?

And again, I think it's a lack of Bible prophecy. Nearly one third of the Bible deals with

prophecy. Okay, and dare I say, how could you be a faithful shepherd if you skip nearly one

third?

If I was up here – I actually did this illustration once when I was speaking in Australia, and

they freaked out. I said, If I got up here and took one third of this Bible and went rip. I acted

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like I was ripping it. (Gasp!)

And I said, But if I did that and threw it behind me and I say, I love you as your shepherd, but

you'll never get that from me. That's what you're doing when you say, No, we don't do that

here. There's other things to teach on. We're not going to... What?

I didn't say that you've got to teach on it every week, but come on, that's one third of the

Bible. You've got to teach the whole Council of God.

But I'm convinced that a lot of people, that's why their countenances are so messed-up.

That's why they're apathetic. I tell pastors all the time, Hey, you want to get your

congregation all fired up for Jesus?

Yeah, yeah, yeah! Hey, you want to get them to evangelize like never before?

Oh, yeah, yeah! And you want to get them just totally excited and motivated, and

they're going to serve and do all this stuff and you don't have to twist the arm or nothing?

Yeah, yeah! What is it?

And they expect some big giant program, some cookie-cutter method that you pay \$19.99

right from the denominational headquarters.

No! Just preach prophecy, because when you preach prophecy – yeah, you talk about a lot of

the 7-year tribulation. You don't want to go there, but we know we're not going there as

Christians.

But keep reading. It tells you about the future that Christ has won for us, the reward. And

folks, oh, I think it's the missing antidote.

Many Christians act like this is the only world to come. No wonder you're in the dumps and

your face looks like it. Come on, it's reward time.

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And so we're going to talk about that and hopefully to put that smile back on your face.

Okay, but the first reward folks is this: We're going to heaven, right?

And last time I checked, when the rapture happens, I'm sure you guys know this, but when

the rapture happens, we get instantly translated in the twinkling of an eye to that 13th aisle

at Wal-Mart and Jesus starts handing out \$50 gift certificates.

[Laughter]

Yeah! Yeah! Are you kidding me?

No, we go to heaven. Last time I checked, heaven is way better than that, as cool as that

might be, lower prices every day. Well, let's take a look at that; believe it or not, What is that

going to be like?

The instant it says in the twinkling of an eye, bang! We saw that last study. What's it going to

be like, man?

Folks, this place is awesome, and nobody can take it away. If you received Jesus Christ as

your Lord and Savior, trusting in Him and Him alone, His death on the cross for the

forgiveness of your sins, you're going to walk where we're about ready to read. This is

amazing!

Revelation 21. Let's go ahead and stand as we read God's holy Word, Revelation 21. Okay,

and if you find the tables of weights and measures, what do you do?

Take a left. You're at the back end there. So anyway, Revelation 21, we're going to read

verses, just simply, 1-4. What's it going to be like?

"Then I saw [What?] a new heaven and a new earth, [Why?] because the first heaven and

the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. And I saw the Holy City,

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the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, [Listen] prepared as a bride

beautifully dressed for her husband.

And then I heard this loud voice from the throne saying, 'Now the dwelling of God is with

men, and He will live with them, and they will be His people.

[Listen] God himself will be with them and be their God. [Listen] He will wipe away every

tear from their eyes. There's not going to be any more death or mourning or crying or pain,

[Why?] because the old order of things has passed away."

You may be seated if you can. Folks, this is the first reward we get when we experience the

rapture. As a born-again Christian, we are going to heaven. Heaven is so awesome! And your

first clue that this is an amazing existence, is he says it's going to be decked out like a bridal

dress.

As we all know, ladies, when it was time to get married, you just, meh. You're very

pragmatic, just to get the job done, right?

Hey, Mom, you got some curtains I can borrow? I'm going to wrap a plastic Hefty Bag around

me and get the job done. Are you kidding me?

What did you do?

You shopped for that special dress. And it wasn't just any dress. It was a one-time, awesome

- It was decked out with all these studs and jewels and that because it was a once - That's

how heaven is for you and I. God has spared no expense.

In fact, the word there in the Greek, 'adorned' is 'kosmeo', where we get cosmetics. God's

got this place made up awesome! It's going to be incredible.

The instant – 2 Corinthians 5:8 says, "Absent from the body is to be present with the Lord."

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And the rapture says in a twinkling of an eye, all of a sudden were aren't here in this garbage

can – By the way, Jesus is preparing a place for us, right, in John 14, which is a rapture

passage, right?

He's been preparing that place for us for 2000 years, right?

Now listen, this place, the reason why I keep calling it garbage can because as beautiful as it

is, even here in Hawaii and all that stuff, do you realize this is the messed-up version of the

planet after the worldwide flood?

Think about that. This is the messed-up planet. This ain't like what it used to be. This is a

messed-up version. We still find beauty and, Wow, look at that sunset and look at that crag

and the mountains and the ocean, all that stuff.

But listen, God made this planet, and this is the messed-up version after He had to judge it

because of sin. He made it in six days.

Jesus Christ has been working on our bridal chamber for 2000 years. It's going to be decked

out. It's going to be awesome!

I'm sorry to ruin you guys' day with this news. I just...

[Laughter]

Let's sing that song again. I got the joy, Joy, Joy, Joy. (Singing joyless)

You kidding me, man? This place is awesome, right?

This is the first reward. And again, that's your first clue it's going to be amazing! He likens it

unto a bridal dress.

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But if you keep studying the Bible, which for some strange reason I highly recommend,

you're going to see all kinds of characteristics of this place called heaven. It's totally decked

out, right?

And this is what we see: It's the 'Dwelling Place of God.' No more invisible stuff. We get to

see Him face-to-face.

Man, it's going to be awesome! It's the 'Dwelling Place of His Holy Angels.' It's a 'Heavenly

Country.'

Not like the messed-up version we're dealing with. Hello? A heavenly country, right?

It's 'A Holy Place.' No sin whatsoever. It's 'An Eternal Paradise.' You get there, you don't get

kicked out.

Anybody glad about that?

It's not just for a weekend. It's an eternal paradise, right?

It's also a place where the streets are made of gold. Everybody's running crazy. The rat race.

Oh, I just – And you're going crazy. I ain't got time for God.

I got to do this for – For what?

For what we get to walk on in heaven.

Think about that for a second; how the enemy's twisted it around. The place where the

streets are made of gold. The place where the gates are made of actual pearls. A place

where the foundations of precious gems, right?

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That's concrete in heaven, precious gems. It's amazing, right? A place of eternal rest; it never

stops. A place of eternal joy. A place without wickedness. It's a place without darkness. It's a

place without sin.

Think about that. No bad day, no bad relationship, no bad thought, no bad experience,

nothing bad, sin's gone, oh, including the people around you! You're actually going to get

along. Can you believe that? What a concept, right?

Hey, a place without tears. It's going to be a place without mourning. It's going to be a place

without pain. It's going to be a place without death. It's a place of absolute purity. It's a place

filled with the glory of God.

And again, it's an everlasting place. It just keeps going on and on and on and on. Even that

Energizer Bunny is going to be a wimp compared. It's just forever. It's going to be awesome,

folks, and we're just getting started, right?

Okay, but then that's just the surroundings that's decked out like a bridal dress. The

concrete, the streets are made of gold and precious gems, and it's amazing!

No sin, nothing's bad, it's all gone forever and ever and ever. And you're just getting started.

And then God says, Watch this. I'm not just going to give you the beautiful bridal-like

surroundings, all decked out, I'm going to give you a brand-new body to handle those

surroundings, right?

Now, I didn't say that; God did. Watch this.

Now some of you young whippersnappers don't get this, but the older you get – Have you

guys noticed that? It's like the older you get your face starts to slide off. It's like, what

happened to that? I know gravity is real, but you didn't have to show it on my face?

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But hey, let's move on. All right, 1 Corinthians 15, rapture passage again. What's he say,

Paul?

"I declare to you, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor

does the perishable inherit the imperishable. Listen, I tell your mystery: We will not all

sleep, but we will be changed – [Bang!] in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last

trumpet.

For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised [What?] imperishable, and we will be

changed."

So we not only go to be with Jesus at the right hand of the Father in Heaven, in that place

that we just described that's all completely decked out, but we get brand new bodies at the

same time to enjoy that without that sin nature thing.

And think about what that word 'imperishable' bodies means. Let's break it down. That

means your body, listen, will never die. It won't rot, it won't decay, it won't break down, it

won't even age. You're not going to have anymore – Yeah, praise God!

You won't have any more backaches, no more broken bones, no more broken toes, no more

diseases. Ladies, no more anti-aging creams, right?

Your body will not, it won't wear down. You're not gonna have any wrinkles and crinkles and

age spots, none of that stuff. No more facelifts, tummy tucks, lipo suctions. It's all gone!

Yeah, praise God!

And then listen, you'll never ever, ever, ever, forever, never have this conversation with your

friends again like these people; watch this. There's this group of Florida senior citizens,

they're sitting around, they're talking about their ailments.

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And then one person says, Oh, man, my arms are so weak, I could hardly lift this cup of

coffee.

And another one says, Yeah, I know. My cataracts are getting so bad I can't even see my

coffee.

And then the person with the loudest voice in the group says, Yeah, well, it's gotten to where

I can't hear nothing anymore.

And then the fourth person nods weakly in agreement and says, I know what you mean, I

can't turn my head with the arthritis in my neck.

And another one says, Well, that's nothing. My blood pressure pills make me all dizzy.

And another person said, Well you think that's bad? I can't even remember what I'm doing

half the time. If I don't make myself a note, I forget what I'm doing in the first place.

And then the old wise person in the group, they wince and shake their head and says, Yeah, I

guess that's the price we get for getting old.

And then there's a short moment of silence.

This woman cheerfully pipes up and announced, Well, I guess it's not all that bad. Thank

goodness we can all still drive.

[Laughter]

Turn to somebody and say, get off the road. (Chuckling)

Think about that. We ain't going to have those kind of conversations again because that's

not the bodies we're going to have.

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They're going to be imperishable, which means, listen, no more when you wake up and go to

the breakfast table and you hear snap, crackle and pop and discover you ain't eating cereal.

That's you making that noise.

No more when you sit in a rocking chair, and you can't even get the thing going.

No more you and your teeth not sleep together anymore, right?

No more you wake up looking like your driver's license picture.

No more will your knees buckle, but your belt won't.

Now here's a whopper: No more will you have more hair on your ears and up your nose than

what's on your head. What's up with that?

Somebody needs to patent that man because I don't know, have you noticed this? It's kind

of gross, but it's a guy thing, right? You wake up one morning and there's a six -foot nose

hair going like – Well, how did that happen?

Put it on their head. What do you – How do I – We're not going to have to deal with that

anymore.

In fact, no more, listen, will people call you at 9 p.m. and say, oh, I'm sorry, did I wake you

up?

And no more, listen, will you look for your glasses for a half an hour before you realize what?

They're on your head the whole time. You won't need glasses. You won't have memory

problems.

And we're just getting started! And it happens, bang, at the rapture.

And I'm sorry I had to tell you all this.

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[Laughter]

Let's sing that song again. Joy, joy... are you starting to get it? Have we forgotten what Christ

has won for us?

Oh, and we're still not done. I love God; He's so cool. He's like the ultimate gentleman, like

the ultimate – It just – As much as what we just saw from the scripture about heaven, as cool

as that is, it keeps getting better.

And basically God says, you know what, as cool as that is, and He's given us sufficient

knowledge to get excited about heaven, but He hasn't told us everything. And that's what I

see here.

Watch this: 1 Corinthians 2:9. This is cool. That is what the Scriptures mean when they say –

Watch this - 'No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind [You can't even imagine] what

God has prepared [For what?] for those who love Him."

And basically God's saying, listen, as cool as it is what I've already told you, there are some

things that I've got in heaven going on for you.

Do you love Him? Then guess what?

You can't contain it right now. Your eyes can't really understand, and your brain can't even

conceive. I can try to describe it. You won't get it until you get there.

But see, I'm a guy and we got to try to figure things out. So let's try to look at what this

passage means.

What's God trying to say to us? What's heaven going to be like? Eye, ears?

Just imagine, and this is what the Scripture says, we lose the sin nature. What will it be like

to have a perfect body without sin nature? And what does it got to do with this text?

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MAN: This is the electromagnetic spectrum. This contains all the different wavelengths, radio

waves, microwaves including a small piece called "light."

Well, one guy breaks it down. Let's take a look at that.

Now your eyeball can see the colors" red, orange, yellow, green, blue, violet; that's all. The

spectrum goes forever in both directions beyond that.

Suppose we get to heaven, and God gives us new eyes that can see the entire spectrum.

That means there will be brand new colors, trillions of them, not new shades of these colors,

brand new colors. That's why heaven has to be so large. It's for the women's closets.

[Laughter]

My wife is going to say, Honey, does this go with this?

I'll say, Dear, I couldn't figure it out back on earth.

She has to number my ties to go with my suits. It's not that I'm colorblind, It's that I don't

know what goes with what. Secondly, I don't care, I just want to get dressed. Lay it out,

would you?

Anybody else feel that way about it? Don't tell me about it. Just put it together for me,

please.

Can you imagine if we get new eyes that can see the whole spectrum, you're going to be

able to see the sounds coming off the piano. Right now we can only hear them.

Imagine seeing the sounds. What if we get new ears that can hear the whole spectrum?

You're going to be able to hear the colors. (Pretending to hear the colors in his clothes.)

Wow!

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Or smell them. (Sniffing the air) Yellow, ahh.

Or taste them. Yum, green. Wow!

We've only got five senses, folks. Maybe there's more. But if God just took these five and

expanded them to the max, we would spend forever walking around heaven going, Wow,

wow! Did you smell that? Come here. Lick that. Wow!

[Laughter]

PASTOR BILLY: "No eye has seen; no ear has heard." You can't even imagine in your current

state what God has prepared for those who love Him. Isn't that awesome?

This is our first reward at the rapture. The rapture is called "the blessed hope." It's not the

blessed torment. It's not the bad news. It's the blessed hope. It's best-case scenario. This is

the first thing we get rewarded with.

We deserve, myself included, to die and go straight to hell. I got rescued from that, but then

I get this on top?

I'm sorry I did it again, guys. You're just – You're going to leave here so bummed out,

depressed. I tell you what, I don't know what's going on. We just better wrap it up.

No, let's keep going because it gets even better. Nobody has a brighter future than we, the

church. That's just the first reward.

The second one is: I'm going to the millennium. And it's really strange, it's like, you know, the

Scripture says again, keep your mind on things above, not this earth.

You know how I know that Christians are not doing that?

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It's because look at your countenance. That's all you think about is this earth. You keep your

mind on things above like we just talked about, (Excited sounds) you get excited.

But we don't think about that. We don't think about heaven, right? But listen, do you realize

that we're not just going to be in heaven?

We get to come back to the planet. You realize that, right?

And how many times do you hear people say, Well, okay, Pastor Billy, heaven sounds pretty

cool, but uh, it's almost like I shouldn't say this, but isn't it going to get kind of boring?

I mean, after two weeks of floating on that cloud and strumming that harp. (Strumming harp

sounds)

And then here comes another Christian on his cloud, (Strumming sounds) and we say, aloha.

And I keep (Strumming sounds).

An hour later comes another Christian. (Strumming sounds)

Isn't that going to get kind of boring?

You've heard those people, right?

No! Are you kidding me?

We just saw what it's going to be like, It's going to be incredible. You're not going to be

(Strumming sounds).

But listen, most Christians don't realize, listen, we're coming back. We're coming back to the

planet, but it's going to be renovated to Garden-of-Eden-like conditions. It's going to be

awesome!

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And the first thing that makes it so cool in the millennium is Satan gets shut up. This is going

to be awesome, right?

I didn't say it; God did, right?

For a thousand years, Revelation 20:1-4, "And I saw an angel coming down out of heaven,

having the key to the Abyss and holding in his hand a great chain. He seized the dragon,

that ancient serpent who is the devil, or Satan and bound him [What?] for a thousand

years."

Now I get a kick every time I see it. Listen, Satan, he gets the church to do two things

wrongly.

One: He gets us to de-emphasize him and act like he doesn't exist. Here's the current stat:

65% of professing Christians, churches today, do not believe in a literal devil. No wonder he's

having a heyday.

Or then he goes to the other extreme and he gets us to give him way more attention than he

deserves, way more power. Yeah, you don't want to mess with him, right?

But again, compared to God, and we belong to God, he's not even the hair on the back of a

flea compared to God.

And here's my point. You want to know how? How many angels from God did it take to bind

Satan?

One.

You don't want to mess with him but at the same time, he's a little pipsqueak compared to

God, and we belong to God.

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That's why John in the Scriptures said, "Greater is He that is in me, than he that is in the

world."

But this is what he did for the Millennium Kingdom. "He threw him into the Abyss, and

locked and sealed it over him, to keep him from deceiving the nations anymore until the

thousand years were ended."

Now, break down that verse. We're coming back to the planet. It's going to be Garden of

Eden like conditions. I'll get to that in a second.

But the first cool thing about the Millennium Kingdom is Satan is bound during that whole

time, which means all the junk, all the rottenness, all the evil that he incites today, all the

leftover baloney, evil that we're dealing with today, all the rottenness: It's gone!

You're never gonna have to deal with it the whole time for a thousand years. Woohoo!! It's

awesome, right?

And then you're just getting started. You read the Scriptures, which again, I highly

recommend. You'll come up with other characteristics of the Millennial Kingdom. It's going

to be amazing, folks!

The government will be a theocracy with Jesus Christ, the Messiah ruling and reigning as

King over the whole planet in Jerusalem. I'll get to that in more detail in a second.

Then you're going to see the 12 disciples will rule over the 12 tribes of Israel. There's going

to be other smaller subdivisions of authority awarded for faithfulness. That's you and I, the

church. Judges will be raised up to demonstrate the theocratic power of Christ to rule with

inflexible righteousness and justice.

Again, I'll get to that in a second. War is going to be a relic of the past; not at all in the

Millennial Kingdom. Jerusalem right now, known for war, bloodshed, international tensions,

will at last become the city of peace and the capital of the whole world.

There will be religious peace with Jews and Gentiles worshiping the Lord together, okay, on

the whole planet. There's going to be a just economy for everyone.

No longer will wealth be monopolized by only a few privileged families like the Gates and the

Musks, and the Zuckerbergs, and all these guys. None of that stuff's going to be there. It's

going to be abundant.

Listen, nature will cooperate with man again, like the Garden of Eden. Productivity will

return. You're never going to have any earthquakes, tornadoes, floods, all that's going to be

gone, okay?

And work will no longer be in vain. The people in that time frame will not be doomed to

misfortune. Work will continue on in the Millennium because God designed work as a source

of provision. But in the Millennium, work will yield multiple gains, much more than what we

need for survival, which means there will be enough resources for nice vacations, leisure,

and fun.

And you could actually go through the drive thru and get 'add cheese'. It's going to be a great

time! Have you ever been that poor where you went to the drive thru and you couldn't

afford 'add cheese'? Forget about bacon; that's way out of there.

Okay, apparently I was the only one. But at that point. But it's going to be awesome! It's

going to be a super-abundant time, right?

So put that together, So you got Satan bound during the whole time. Woohoo!

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The planet's just going to be amazing, super abundance, no more catastrophes, all that stuff!

It's going to be lush; it's going to be great, Garden-of-Eden-like conditions.

And then let me give you another thing. It's going to have a righteous government.

Now stop right there because your first inclination is like, whoa, ho, ho, righteous

government?

Isn't that one of those, um, one of those oxymorons? You know, like Icy hot, peaceful war,

yummy chicken? There's no such thing, right? It's like, what's going on? What do you mean,

righteous government, right?

But folks, I'm not making this up. Jesus Christ is coming back, and He's taking charge of the

planet, and us with Him. I didn't say it.

It's a prophecy from Isaiah about the Millennial Kingdom. How many times have we read this

verse, sung it even during Christmas, we don't realize he's talking about the Millennium,

right?

Here it is, Isaiah 9:6, "For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and [the what?] the

government will be on His shoulders. And He will be called Wonderful Counselor."

Now, the key word there is "government." And again, he's talking about not here, now. He's

talking about the government in the Millennial Kingdom when Jesus Christ comes back, us

with Him at the end of the 7-year tribulation, Revelation 19, and sets this up. Jesus Christ is

going to be in charge of the government. Isn't that awesome?

[Amen!]

And again, sometimes we hesitate with this because we think, well, yeah, yeah, I get it.

Jesus, He's the, He's the Lamb who was sacrificed to take away our sins. And that's true.

Or we say, Jesus, He's the Lion of the tribe of Judah. He defeats our enemies. And that's true.

But the Bible says Jesus Christ is coming back, watch this, to be the divine political ruler! All

two of you appreciate that. So let's break it down, right?

So that means, listen, Jesus Christ, when He comes back, it's going to be amazing!

No more are we going to have to deal with all the junk that we see from governments and

politics today and politicians. It's all gone.

And that's going to be a big relief, because let's be honest, folks, let's break it down, we all

know politics comes from two words, 'poly' meaning many and 'ticks', bloodsucking

creatures.

[Laughter and Applause]

So I mean, so to think of Jesus involved in the government, we go, Woah! Wait a second,

wait a second, right? You know, it gets a bad rap because they're so horrible and rotten.

Okay, but listen, this is what Isaiah says here about the government of Jesus: He says,

"Wonderful". It's actually the Hebrew word 'Pele'.

And it means this. Not just wonderful. Yeah, it's wonderful, but it's wonderful, It's astonish,

it's extraordinary! Literally in the Hebrew, a marvel!

And so Isaiah says, when Jesus Christ comes back, us with Him and when He takes charge of

the planet, the government, the whole thing, listen, it's going to be the most wonderful,

astounding, extraordinary, marvelous government you could ever imagine!

Why?

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Pastor Billy Crone

Because He's the Wonderful Counselor. And that means Jesus Christ only tells the truth;

unlike what we deal with now. You can't bribe Him. You can't go against Him. You can't make

Him do anything wrong. He only does that which is right and just every single time.

No more chicanery, none of that stuff. He is the King of kings, the Lord of lords, the

Wonderful Counselor. Listen, that means His time in office will be what's best for the people

every single time.

Which means, listen, there's not ever going to be another election, ever!

[Applause]

Nobody is running against Jesus, ever!

Which means, that means, no more election campaigns, no more of those commercials, no

more of those signs on the road.

Can you kick it down? That was six months ago, right? No more of the hanging chads;

remember that baloney?

The government – None of it, listen, and all this new world order stuff that's unfolding

before our eyes, Jesus Christ is going to woop! He's going to roll it up just like that and slam

it in the trash can and rule the planet. It's going to be awesome!

[Applause]

And again, I'm sorry I had to share that with you today.

[Laughter]

It's a rough word, but let us close with that wonderful song, I've got the joy, joy, joy...

(Singing in a depressed tone)

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Pastor Billy Crone

[Laughter]

The Millennium. Do you get this? We're coming back, man, right?

So get this (Strumming sounds) out of your head, as cool as that is. We're coming back,

Satan's going to be bound the whole time, Garden-of-Eden-like conditions, productivity,

nothing's short, you can add cheese, add bacon, do whatever you want. You're going to have

all kinds of stuff. It's going to be amazing!

And Jesus Christ, we, the church, get to rule and reign with Him. A just government. It's

going to be awesome!

And then I got to share this one because I'm really personally looking forward to this.

We're going to have peace with nature, right? Peace with nature.

[Applause]

Now, I don't know if you guys notice this or not. But as beautiful as this island is, you've got

these two-legged demon things running around everywhere. It's like, who started that

trend? You call them chickens all you want, all right?

[Laughter]

Peace with nature, right?

Right now we went to the aquarium down the deal, right? I thought, okay, that's a pretty big

looking seal-looking thing, but probably wouldn't want to get in the water with it, you know,

might kind of squish me or eat me.

Or the snapping turtle, that big giant turtle, I don't think I want to put my fingers in there

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unless I pull them out like that, you know?

Pastor Billy Crone

You know, I mean, just lions and things and – you know, that's why you put them in zoos.

One day in the millennium, no more of that. It'll be just like the Garden of Eden.

Animals were vegetarian back then. Adam named them. There was peace with nature. That

means you can have a pet animal. I'm looking forward to pet hippos

[Laughter]

because it reminds me of a larger version of my plump wiener dog.

That's my rationale, and I'm sticking to it. But no, seriously, I encourage you, I'm going to

bring out the text in a second; I'm not making this up. I encourage you as a born-again

Christian, we are headed for this, so pick out what animal / animals you'd like to have as

pets.

I've got one prophecy to teacher, I kid you not, he's dead serious too, he wants pet lions.

And he says, I'm going to put them on my front porch, one on the left, one on the right. And

he's already picked out their names, Leo and Cleo.

[Laughter]

Bring it home, folks. This is what we're headed for.

Again, this is two chapters later. Isaiah, Chapter 11 talks about this in the Millennial

Kingdom.

Isaiah 11:6-9, "The wolf will live with the lamb."

(Sounds of a car braking) Stop right there. If you put a wolf and a lamb in the same cage,

what would happen?

It rhymes with lamb chops.

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Pastor Billy Crone

So obviously, this is not here and now. This is in the future. But this peace is coming back

with the animal kingdom. "The wolf will live with the lamb, the leopard will lie down with

the goat, the calf and the lion and the yearling together; and a little child will lead them.

[What?]

The cow will feed with the bear, their young will lie down together, and the lion will

[What?] eat straw like an ox. [Go back to being vegetarian.]

The infant will play near the hole of the cobra, and the young child will put his hand into

the viper's nest."

(Siren sounds) 911, 911!

No, they'll be perfectly fine. "They will neither harm nor destroy on all my holy mountain,

for the earth will be full of the knowledge of the Lord as waters cover the sea."

The Bible says the Millennial Kingdom on top of everything else we just talked about: Satan

bound, lush, government and incredible conditions; it's awesome!

That the whole planet is going to be basically domesticated Africa. Even the leopard will be

tamed like a goat. All animals will be tame, not just my vicious wiener dogs. All animals will

be tame.

Okay, now you're thinking like, wait a second. Is this to be taken literally like a kid's going to

be leading them around and like you stick your hand in a viper's nest and it tickles or

something, apparently?

What! Really?

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Pastor Billy Crone

Yes, literally. In fact, I think sometimes God in His mercy shows us how it was supposed to be

before it got messed-up in the garden with sin, but how He's going to make it again right in

the Millennial Kingdom.

I think He gives us little teasers of this peace with nature here and now. Watch this. This is

cool.

MAN: It's not exactly the partner you would expect a primate to fall for. But an unusual love

story has been forged between Syria, the six-year-old orangutan and a stray hound dog

named Roscoe. For these logic-defying friends, it's all hugs and cuddles since the day they

met three years ago when Syria spotted the dog from high atop an elephant while on a ride

with his trainers at his South Carolina animal park.

DOC ANTLE: To me they seem like long-lost friends.

TV HOST: This other, more whimsical partnership between predator and prey has been seen

on YouTube some 5 million times.

A cat and a bird that shouldn't get along, playing hide-and-seek, even wrestling. Two of

nature's enemies frolicking like fast friends.

From the hippo and the tortoise who sidle up next to each other, so many of these

relationships are hard to explain.

TV HOST: How is this for a unique animal friendship? 350-pound lion, Bone-digger, is best

friends with a fearless seven-year-old dachshund dog named Milo. They may seem like

unlikely friends, but Jericho, the horse, is perfectly happy to let this baboon lay on his back

while they both soak up the sun.

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Pastor Billy Crone

It may look like this dog's days are over as the Jaguar appears to go in for the kill. But things

aren't always what they seem. In fact, this unusual pair are actually best friends.

WOMAN: These two struck it off straight away.

TV HOST: And now this feline / canine combo are inseparable.

WOMAN: They don't leave each other. They feed together, sleep together, do everything

together 24-hours-a-day. They haven't been separated at all. They are like brothers.

TV HOST: Shaun Ellis from Devon in England has integrated himself into a pack of wild

wolves.

SHAUN ELLIS: The pack itself began when the wolves in particular were only a few days of

age. I still consider myself to be a part of that family.

MARK DUMA: Oh, okay. You got that? Okay.

TV HOST: Like millions of people around the world, Mark Duma loves nothing more than to

take a morning swim. But for him, there is a rather massive difference as Mark swims with a

polar bear.

(Upbeat music)

TV HOST: Having pet cats may sound run-of-the-mill. But Janice Haley has taken her love of

felines to the extreme, keeping two huge tigers in her back garden. Saber, a 600-pound male

white Bengal, and Janda, a 400-pound Bengal female have lived with Janice since they were

cubs.

With their ability to crunch a human bone in a single bite, getting up close and personal with

a 1300-pound grizzly bear is not for the faint hearted. But for 71-year-old Doug Zeus coming

face-to-face with the fearsome predator is all in a day's work.

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DOUG ZEUS: Mark, off. Good That's good. Ah! Good. Ah! Ah! Good.

TV HOST: This pairing, researchers say, is one of the strangest animal bonds ever seen. A lioness who, instead of eating her dinner, adopts it.

SABA: I think many people felt that this was you know, it had to be a message from God. This was a miracle. This was, you know, the lion and the lamb laying down together.

BARBARA WALTERS: This is a true story. It's about a lion named Christian. Okay. There were two men who adopted the lion, Ace Berg and John Rendall, and they bought the lion from Harrods department store. Who knows that they – Who thought that they sold Cubs?

And in 1969 the little cub weighed 35 pounds. A year later, the little cub had grown, and he weighed 185 pounds. This is a love story, a true love story. Take a look. Man and beast.

This is the second reward after the rapture. It's real. One guy says this: "Under the direction

of Jesus Christ the resurrected believers of the church, will provide the leadership necessary

to create a just society for mankind. [Listen] The greatest adventure we could ever imagine

awaits for us in the reality of the Kingdom of Christ."

I can't wait to get there! And it starts at the rapture, which could happen today, just like

that. And nobody can take it away.

But then let's close with this one because this is the third one. And frankly, for me

personally, this is the one I look forward to the most: We get to see Jesus! All right, no more

invisible stuff.

[Applause]

What did Jesus tell His disciples?

He says, Yeah, I'm glad you believe. But blessed are those who do not see and yet believe.

That's us. We haven't seen Him, but we believe, and we love Him. And dare I say, don't you

hope to do that one day, right?

When you start talking about the return of Jesus Christ visibly coming back to this planet,

you should be busting loose in praise, man. And the reason why is because all of heaven is.

Revelation 19 is about the return of Jesus Christ and they're going nuts. Listen to this praise

service about the visible return of Jesus Christ.

Revelation 19:1-9. Watch this. "After this I heard what sounded like the roar of a great

multitude in heaven shouting: 'Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our

God, for true and just are His judgments.

He has condemned the great prostitute who corrupted the earth by her adulteries. He has

avenged on her the blood of His servants.'

And again they shouted: 'Hallelujah! The smoke from her goes up for ever and ever.' The

twenty-four elders [You and I] and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God,

who was seated on the throne. And they cried: 'Amen, Hallelujah!'

Then a voice came from the throne, saying: 'Praise our God, all you His servants, you who

fear Him, both small and great!' Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude, like the

roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting: 'Hallelujah! For our Lord

God Almighty reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give Him glory! For the wedding of the

Lamb has come, and His bride has made herself ready.

Then the angel said to me, 'Write: "Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding

supper of the Lamb." And he added, 'These are the true words of God."

In other words, you can bank on it! When you start talking about the visible return of Jesus

Christ to the planet, all of heaven goes loose. This is an amazing praise service. What do they

[Applause]

The one who saved us, rescued us from the dominion of darkness. He defeated death, hell, and the grave. And He's going to throw us an amazing wedding party! It's amazing! He's the ultimate awesome King!

In fact, one guy puts it this way, watch this. He said, "The Bible says, my King is a seven-way king.

He's the King of the Jews.

He's the King of Israel.

He's the King of righteousness.

He's the King of the ages.

He's the King of heaven.

He's the King of glory.

He's the King of kings, and He's the Lord of lords.

He's my King.

Do you know Him?

My King is a sovereign king.

He's enduringly strong.

He's entirely sincere.

He's eternally steadfast.

And then I come back to the planet, and I'm rewarded with the Millennial Kingdom where I

get to have those pet hippos if I wanted.

I get peace with nature, awesome living surroundings, productivity, Garden-of-Eden-like

conditions and I get to serve with Jesus and rule and reign across the planet in a righteous

government.

And then I get to see the One who did it all for me, Jesus face-to-face.

And it begins at the rapture. And so as we close, if you're here today and you're not saved,

what are you waiting for?

You should be concerned about hell because it's real. But there's so much more.

God loves you. He loves you so much that He gave His one and only Son and He allowed Him

to die on the cross, which was the death penalty of the day, you know?

He allowed Him to die on the cross to take our punishment for what we've done, our sins

against a holy and righteous God. And the Bible says, if you believe on that, on the work of

the Lord Jesus, if you confess Him as Lord, believe in your heart that God raised Him from

the grave, you will be saved.

What are you waiting for?

It's not just escaping from hell. It's all this on top. Why would you run from that? Why would

A lot of people, you know, today – I'm not like anti-exercise or anti-if-you-want-to-eat-

healthy or whatever, you know, but some people, they get overly focused on like somehow

you're going to cheat destiny.

No, we're born on time, we're gonna die on time. We get to skip that death part if we

experience the rapture, which could happen, that's good.

So I'm not like a health nut, but at the same time, if you want to that's fine. But this is one

exercise that I can recommend every day, three times a day.

And I can guarantee you, if you really, truly do this, it will improve your time here on earth

drastically, right?

It's simply this: Just repeat after me, just do this. (Rising up and down on toes) That's called

rapture practice. You may be seated. Okay.

[Laughter]

[Applause]

Do that three times a day, man, when you first get up, woohoo! Steal away at lunch, right?

Lunch time, just in case you forgot, woohoo! Right? And before you go to bed, hey, don't

forget, woohoo! And guess what?

You remember all that we talked about biblically and what I said at the beginning?

It comes true. You have to pay somebody to slap that smile off.

Do you realize what we're headed for?

Awesome, awesome! I can't wait!

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And so let's bless ourselves as we close. We know the rapture's imminent; it can happen today. There's nothing – It's imminent.


What if, and we don't know this, but what if the rapture was in play, if you will, right now?

And God, one last time, if there's anybody still not truly born-again, please save them. May it

go from their head to their heart. May they finally get it, why it's called good news, and

surrender all to You, Jesus, and truly be saved before it's too late.

We ask and pray all these things in Your wonderful name, in Jesus' name, and all God's

people said, Amen.
