

## Mid-East Prophecy Update – November 10<sup>th</sup>, 2013

- Before we leave Hawaii for Israel, I think I'd be grossly remiss were I not to address a number of emails concerning some breaking news.

Two days ago, on Friday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, Both the Canadian Free Press, and the Examiner.com reported on this, the latter running the headline, "Communist Chinese troops 'boots on the ground' in Hawaii next Tuesday" Here's a couple of excerpts, "...Almost totally ignored by the American media, PLA troops will be in Hawaii from the 12th through the 14th of this month, to be hosted by the U.S. military's Pacific Command, also headquartered in the Aloha State. Communist Chinese troops will be participating in the U.S. government's massive GridEx II military, quasi-military and civilian emergency response exercise. The **New York Times** reported on Aug. 16, 2013 that GridEx II specifically consists of: ... thousands of utility workers, business executives, National Guard officers, F.B.I. antiterrorism experts and officials from government agencies in the United States, Canada and Mexico are preparing for an emergency drill in November that will simulate physical attacks and cyberattacks that could take down large sections of the power grid. They will practice for a crisis unlike anything the real grid has ever seen, and more than 150 companies and organizations have signed up to participate.

- While I haven't really had time to research this, I did at least want to let you know about this especially given that it takes place on Tuesday.
- Back to what happened last week in the Mid-East. For those who've been following this, you're likely just as stunned by it, as I myself am.
- It seems that the United States has just driven the last nail in the coffin of any support for Israel in their push for a possible deal with Iran.

Friday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, The Telegraph published an article titled, "Iran nuclear talks: Benjamin Netanyahu lashes out against deal" - Here's some of what they reported, "Speaking before meeting John Kerry, the Israeli prime minister effectively accused Western negotiators of caving in during talks in Geneva and handing Iran the "deal of the century". "I understand that the Iranians are walking around very satisfied in Geneva, as well they should be, because they got everything, and paid nothing, they wanted. They wanted relief from sanctions after years of a grueling sanctions regime," ...He called the proposed short-term agreement "a very bad deal" and said Israel "utterly rejects it". ..."Israel is not obliged by this agreement and will do everything it needs to defend itself, to defend the security of its people, ...

That was Friday, then breaking just this morning was a Reuters News report with the headline reading, "France says no certainty Iran talks will succeed" Here's what they had to say, "France said on Saturday there was no certainty nuclear talks under way with Iran in Geneva would succeed because of major stumbling blocks over an initial proposed text on a deal. ..."As I speak to you, I cannot say there is any certainty that we can conclude" the talks, French Foreign Minister Laurent Fabius said on France Inter radio, noting that France could not accept a "sucker's deal".

Early this morning, Joel Rosenberg posted an article on his blog with the title reading, "France scuttles disastrous U.S. nuclear deal with Iran at last minute. American delegation en route to Israel for high-level talks as crisis erupts in U.S.-Israel relations." Here's what he had to say, "It's been a weekend of high drama and high tension on the Iran nuclear front — and in U.S.-Israel relations — and it's not over yet. ... The situation looked very grim from the Israeli perspective for most of Friday and Saturday, with the Iranians signaling they expected to sign a deal by Saturday evening at the latest. Then suddenly, out of the blue, the **French delegation objected** to the proposed U.S. deal. ... Iranian leaders were **stunned** by the last minute turn of events that went against them. **Haaretz is reporting** that "a delegation of high-ranking U.S. officials is set to arrive in Jerusalem on Sunday to update the Netanyahu government on the weekend talks in Geneva about Iran's nuclear program. According to foreign news reports, Israel has been working with the UAE on the Iran issue....Netanyahu is due to visit Moscow on November 20, the same day as the next round of Iran talks in Geneva."

- Because I have the privilege of speaking to a well-taught church, I'll conclude with the presupposition you know where I'm going with this.
- I don't know how else to say it, but if this doesn't look like Ezekiel 38 is beginning to come to pass, then I honestly don't know what does.
- The reason I say that is because Russia and Iran are at the helm of this nuclear attack against Israel, and the US at best, only protests it.

- It's important to understand that the conspicuous absence of Syria, Jordan, Lebanon, Iraq, and Egypt suggests other prophecies come first.
- Namely, Isaiah 17 concerning Syria, Isaiah 19 concerning Egypt, and Psalm 83 with Zechariah 12 concerning Israel's surround neighbors.
- This happens under the banner of moving Jerusalem's boundary stones for Jews and Palestinians living side by side in peace and security.

**1 Thessalonians 5:3 NIV (3)** While people are saying, "Peace and safety," destruction will come on them suddenly, as labor pains on a pregnant woman, and they will not escape.

- As I mentioned last week, I would suggest that this sudden destruction that's coming down may be simultaneous with the church going up.
- If that's the case, and I'm becoming increasingly convinced that it in fact is, then the handwriting is on the wall as to how close we may be.
- If you take into consideration what's happening in Israel, and what's happening in Hawaii, you'd be hard pressed to conclude otherwise.
