Mid-East Prophecy Update – December 10th, 2017

- For today's prophecy update, I want to talk about the prophetic implication of the President's declaration concerning Jerusalem.
- I would suggest the President officially and formally establishing Jerusalem as Israel's capital is more prophetic than historic.
- The reason being is because of where doing so will lead, such that, this now has the potential of speeding things up, as it were.
- I'm hoping that you'll kindly indulge me as I present a plausible scenario, subsequent to this significant prophetic development.
- What follows is based on some of the specific details in prophecies like Zechariah 12, 1 Thessalonians 5:3, and Daniel 9:27.
- Specifically, Zechariah 12 related to Jerusalem, 1 Thessalonians 5:3 the "two-state solution," and Daniel 9:27, the peace deal.
- Because we took an in depth look at Zechariah 12 last week, I'll proceed with the presupposition that you know what it's about.
- Simply put, the world's intoxicating obsession with dividing Jerusalem is the catalyst for two states living in peace and security.
- This insatiable quest for peace and security between Jews and the so-called Palestinians may be realized vis-à-vis Daniel 9:27.

I'll start with this Jerusalem Post article on Friday about the Security Council now pushing Trump for a detailed Mideast peace proposal. Here are a few interesting excerpts, "Britain, France, Germany, Sweden and Italy called on the United States on Friday to put forward detailed proposals for peace between Israel and the Palestinians and described as "unhelpful" a decision by President Donald Trump to recognize Jerusalem as Israel's capital. ... In a joint statement after the meeting, they said, "We stand ready to contribute to all credible efforts to restart the peace process, on the basis of internationally agreed parameters, leading to a two-State solution," ... "We encourage the US Administration to now bring forward detailed proposals for an Israel-Palestinian settlement." ... US Ambassador to the United Nations Nikki Haley said, "Our actions are intended to help advance the cause of peace," she said. "We believe we might be closer to that goal than ever before."

It's important to understand that any peace agreement/two-state solution has to not only include Jerusalem as Israel's capital, it must also include the rebuilding of the Jewish Temple. Consider this Breaking Israel News titled, "Trump's Jerusalem Declaration 'Enormous Step Towards Bringing Third Temple'". Quoting the article, "President Donald Trump's epic proclamation on Wednesday acknowledging Jerusalem as the eternal capital of the Jewish people was a major step towards establishing the Third Temple and bringing the Messianic era, said a number of Jewish activists working to rebuild the Holy Temple.

- It's the rebuilding of the Temple that I believe will seal the deal for Israel given that they will give anything for that to take place.
- This is what everything comes down to for Jerusalem and the temple mount, which today is controlled by the Gentiles/Muslims.
- Actually, this is a fulfillment of a prophecy that's found in Revelation 11:1-2 describing the Gentiles trampling on it for 3 ½ years.
- It's important to understand that all three of the world's main religions lay claims to Jerusalem, however, only two are legitimate.
- I'm speaking of course about Judaism and Christianity both of which are legitimate, which makes Islam claim totally illegitimate.
- The fact of the matter is Jerusalem isn't mentioned even once in the Qur'an despite attempts by Muslims to interpret otherwise.
- While the Qur'an doesn't mention Jerusalem one time, the Bible mentions Jerusalem 806 times, 660-Old Testament, 146-New.
- To me, the guestion that needs to be asked is why. Why is dividing Jerusalem the intoxicating obsession of the entire world?
- To answer this why question, we need look no further than to the pages of Holy Writ where we find that God put His name on it.
- If you'll permit me to for the remainder of our time together, I'll explain how God has put His name of ownership on Jerusalem.
- God not only put His name of ownership on Jerusalem literally, He has also put His name of ownership on His people eternally.
- One of the highest blessings you can place on someone in the Middle East, is to pronounce and declare God's name on you.

Numbers 6:22-27 - 22 And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: 23 "Speak to Aaron and his sons, saying, 'This is the way you shall bless the children of Israel. Say to them: 24 "The LORD bless you and keep you; 25 The LORD make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; 26 The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace." '27 "So they shall put My name on the children of Israel, and I will bless them."

- In addition to God putting His name on the children of Israel, He's also put His name on Jerusalem, the eternal capital of Israel.
- 2 Chronicles 6:6a But I have chosen Jerusalem, that my name might be there;
- **2 Chronicles 12:13b** ...he (Rehoboam) reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the LORD had chosen out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his name there.
- **2 Chronicles 33:7b** ... in Jerusalem, which I have chosen before all the tribes of Israel, will I put my name for ever:
- 2 Kings 21:4b ... In Jerusalem will I put my name.
- Now, the question becomes, what is God's name. In other words, we know that "God" is His title, but what is the name of God.

One commentator of this wrote; "It is generally accepted that Job is the oldest book in the Bible. It is commonly accepted that Job lived during the patriarchal age, and possibly even predated Abraham. For Job a common name for God was 'El Shaddai."

Adam Clarke in his commentary wrote: "El Shaddai, I am God all-sufficient; from shadah, to shed, to pour out. I am that God who pours out blessings, who gives them richly, abundantly, continually."

Pastor J. Mark Martin of a Calvary Chapel in Phoenix Arizona had this to say; "The Hebrew letter "Shin" is used by the Jews as the abbreviation for the name "El Shaddai". The "Old City of Jerusalem" resembles the shape of the "Shin" making it possible that God Almighty literally put His name in Jerusalem.

- I would submit that this Shin as the abbreviation for the name of God, which is El Shaddai, is in fact, on Jerusalem as God said.
- Consider these images of the Old City of Jerusalem as outlined by the city walls, as we superimpose the name of God on it.







- Simply put, this alone should shatter any myth that Jerusalem belongs to anyone other than Israel, whom God has given it to.
- Keep in mind, that this is just one piece of the prophecy puzzle that today is coming together in its fulfillment like never before.
- Lastly, if you've never called upon the name of the Lord to be saved I would like to share the gospel of Salvation in Jesus Christ

The ABC's of Salvation - A is for Admit you're a sinner – Romans 3:23 says that all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. The B is for Believe. Romans 10:9-10 says if you believe in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead, you will be saved. The C is for Call. Romans 10:9-10 also says if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. Romans 10:13 says that all who call upon the name of the Lord will be saved.
