[Cheers and applause] The love that God has for us, unfailing love, amazing grace. I do want

to note that the start time will be at 7:00 p.m. Hawaii time for those of you joining us online.

We're going to get started right away. Usually we start at 7:00 p.m. with the worship, but

we're just going to get right to it at 7:00 p.m. instead of 7:30.

So please note that start time, and then we're going to need all of the time to the better part of an hour-and-a-half until about 8:30, but Gabriel, myself, his mom and dad are going to be up here, and it's just going to be, I believe, a powerful time, a testimony to the power and the love of Almighty God for us. So I hope you are able to come and join with us on

Thursday night.

And again, those of you online, 7:00 p.m. instead of 7:30 this Thursday. All right so we have two services on Sunday mornings. As you know, the first service is the Bible Prophecy Update that we do weekly, and then Second Service is actually the sermon, which is a verse-

by-verse study through the Word of God.

Now today, we're going to, Lord willing, finish the Book of James, and then the following week again, Lord willing, we're going to begin in 1 Peter.

I can't wait! I know I say that about every book, but I can't wait for 1 Peter.

But today we're going to finish James and look at why it is that God will choose to use someone like me to bring back a brother or sister in Christ who has wandered from the truth.

So again, for those of you online, that will be 11:15 a.m. Hawaii time.

By the way, one more thing. On Thursday night because of the time zones for those of you online, it will be on the website, so you can watch it any time on demand. So it will, the video, the entire video will be online, also on YouTube, we hope, and Facebook as well, Lord willing.

Speaking of YouTube and Facebook, now for today's update, we would encourage you to go directly to JDFarag.org for the uncensored, uninterrupted entirety of today's update. And do that now.

And by the way, this is probably as good of a time as any to thank you online for your patience with us. We have had some livestreaming issues. We're working on it, and again, would covet your prayers for that. We hopefully will be able to resolve the issues that we've had recently with the livestream.

So if you go to the website, you will find some differences there, and hopefully, today there

will not be any buffering/censoring/cutting off and anyway... and please pray, by the way,

because that is something, of course, the enemy does not want going out to the uttermost

parts of the earth.

All right, let's get started. For today's update, I want to talk with you about how everything

that's happening in the world today will either make us get angry or get ready.

Now I would be grossly remiss before the Lord and before you if I didn't confess that this is

an area in my own life personally that the Lord has been dealing with me and doing a work in

me, specifically as it relates to my response to everything that is happening in and to the

world today geopolitically, economically, and certainly spiritually.

One of the lessons I'm learning is that my anger, though I may be righteous in my stand, my

anger at what's happening, especially here in the US is very telling. And by very telling, I

mean it's an indication that somehow this nation is my home, and as such, my final

destination.

And it's for this reason that anything or anyone who poses a threat to my country of which

I'm a citizen, will arouse the ire of my anger and my wrath.

Conversely, it's only when I come to the realization that this world is not my home - I'm in

the world, but not of the world. I don't have a dog in this hunt. I don't have a horse in this

race. You got two metaphors to pick from, whichever you prefer.

And when I come to that realization, then the anger will subside. Then what will and should

ensue is a looking up instead of a riling up by virtue of the fact that Bible prophecy tells us

this is exactly what will happen at the time of the end.

In other words, instead of getting angry, I'm getting ready. I'm a citizen of Heaven, and my

redemption draws ever so near.

Philippians 3:20-21, listen to what the Apostle Paul by the Holy Spirit wrote. "For our

citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ,

who will transform the body [Can't wait] of our humble state into conformity with the

body of His glory, [Our glorified bodies] by the exertion of the power that He has, even to

subject all things to Himself."

I want to point out something here that is maybe not so easily seen at first read, and it has

to do within verse 20 where Paul, by the Spirit, connects the eagerly waiting for the Savior's

appearance in the rapture, the appearing is the rapture; the Second Coming is the Second

Coming.

I know that's deeply profound, but please make that delineation. So he's connecting one

who eagerly waits, longs for His appearing, and he connects it to, meaning it's proportionate

to, the one who sees their citizenship as being in Heaven, not here.

So if my citizenship is in Heaven, as Jesus would say in Matthew's Gospel Chapter 6 - That

was close (Chuckling) - If my treasure is in Heaven, if my citizenship is in Heaven, then that's

where my heart is and that's where my eyes are, and that's where my mind is stayed on, not

here.

So I don't want to get ahead of myself, but this world is not my home. And we, as Christians,

as believers in and followers of Jesus Christ, have long-overstayed our welcome in this world

not our home.

Luke's Gospel 21:28, a verse I'm sure familiar to most, if not all, Jesus is speaking, and He

says, "Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because

your redemption draws near."

In John's Gospel Chapter 13:19, Jesus speaking, listen to what He says. "I am telling you now

before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe that I am who I am," the I

AM.

And then He says the same thing in a different way in the next chapter, Chapter 14:29. "I

have told you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe."

In other words, when all of these things begin to happen, know that Jesus said, I'm going to

tell you what's going to happen before it happens so when it begins to happen, believers will

look up and nonbelievers will believe. That sums it up.

But that also presupposes that instead of getting worked up, we're looking up. So we're

seeing all of these things happen in the world.

What's our response? Do we get angry?

I can't believe this! Did you hear what happened?

Hey, I'm going home, so you can, you know, get angry all you want.

And proportionate to your anger is - how do I - I want to be careful how I say this - Help me

out, Holy Spirit. Proportionate to your anger is the depth of your roots in the temporal soil

of this world not your home. It's - can I say it like this - a litmus test?

And I'll, again, speak for myself and just be very open with you that this is an area that I still

struggle with, and the Holy Spirit checks me.

What are you getting so worked up about? I told you it was going to happen. You preach it

every week, Preacher.

Somehow in the back of my mind I hear words like, "Practice what you preach," but... And I

just tell my wife to pray for me when she says that.

I wanted to start this way because it's with this understanding that I think I can now address

the political anger and demonic division in light of the events of last week. While I realize

that what I'm about to say will have a sanctified strength to it, I will say it, nonetheless. If

you're getting angry, you may very well be getting deceived, and I'll explain why.

Satan has done a number on anyone who buys into this demonic division which in the end

leads to destruction. That's the end game. That's where the goalposts are because the

enemy comes to steal, kill, and destroy.

Listen to what Jesus said in Mark's Gospel Chapter 3 beginning in verse 24. "If a kingdom is

divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided against itself,

that house cannot stand. And if Satan has risen up against himself, and is divided, he

cannot stand, but has an end."

Doubtless you've heard it said this way: United we stand; divided we fall. That's what Jesus

is saying.

See, Satan has a problem. That's an understatement.

His problem is, and he knows this, would to God more Christians knew this, that he cannot

prevail against the Church of Jesus Christ from without because the gates of hell cannot

prevail against the church. It cannot happen, and he knows that. Outwardly, he cannot

destroy the church so what does he do?

He does it inwardly, division. Oh, I know how to do it: Bring division. So if I can get

Christians divided, I can just sit back, take the rest of the day off, and watch the show.

Please just - I appreciate your patience with me and bear with me, and please just hear my

heart here, okay?

This last days' demonic division from the White House to the schoolhouse, even our house,

and everything in between, has found its way into the church house, I'm sad to say.

1 Corinthians 14:33, the Apostle Paul, by the Spirit, writes, "For God is not the author of

confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints."

When he writes to the churches in Galatia, Galatians 5:14-15, he says this, "For the entire

law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." [And then

he says this, verse 15] If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be

destroyed by each other."

Wait, these are Christians!

Yeah.

So they're divided?

Yeah. They're divided against each other; they're devouring one of another

What's going to happen?

Oh, they're going to destroy each other. It's just a matter of time.

This is a principal you don't break; it breaks you. Division, confusion equals destruction.

Hang onto that.

1 Corinthians Chapter 1:10-13. Now the Apostle Paul is begging them, pleading with them. He says, "Now I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. [Of one mind, and one accord, one heart and one accord]

For it has been declared to me concerning you, my brethren, by those of Chloe's household, that there are contentions among you. Now I say this, that each of you says, "I am of Paul," or "I am of Apollos," or "I am of Cephas," or "I am of Christ." Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?"

Romans Chapter 16 - I only have 350 more of these so hang in there. And please, please, please don't let the enemy distract your mind so you wander and start thinking of something else because he does not want you to hear this.

Chapter 16 Romans, beginning in verse 17. He's pleading, he's urging, he's begging. "I urge you, brothers and sisters, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them. For such people are not serving our Lord Christ, but their own appetites. By smooth talk and flattery they deceive [Deceive] the minds of naive people."

Gullible people: They're deceived. They buy it hook, line, and sinker, as we say.

2 Timothy; I need to preface this one, Chapter 2 beginning in verse 23. By way of a preface, this particular passage was of immense help to me many years ago when I entered the ministry and the pastorate.

And the Holy Spirit opened up my eyes to this, and it just explained why it is that there's such infighting within the church, within the body of Christ, there's such division.

And the Apostle Paul, by the Holy Spirit, writing to a young pastor, says to Timothy, "Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, [Here's why] because you know they produce quarrels. And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, [Better understood as teach-able, teachable] not resentful.

Opponents [These are Christians, this is to a pastor of a church] **Opponents must be gently**

instructed. [This is - we're going to be talking about this in James]

"Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope [Listen very carefully] that God will

grant them repentance, leading them to a knowledge of the truth, and that they will come

to their senses and escape from the trap of the devil, who has taken them captive to do his

will."

Wait, what? What, Pastor, come on. I thought that a Christian cannot be demon possessed.

That is true. That is biblically sound. If you are born-again of the Spirit of God, the Holy

Spirit indwells you, you cannot be possessed by a demonic spirit. It is impossible.

However - you knew that was coming, right? You can be satanically oppressed and trapped

by the Devil to do his dirty work for him and instead of him to wreak havoc within the church

because he can't do it. He needs you to do it because he cannot destroy from without. He

can only destroy from within.

So he finds those that he can use - they're Christians. They're born-again, they have the Holy

Spirit, sealed for redemption. They're going to go up in the rapture whether we like it or not.

And they're brothers and sisters in Christ.

That was mean - I'm sorry.

[Laughter]

But Satan has trapped them and used them to do his bidding.

What's his bidding?

Well, I got to destroy, steal, kill, and destroy, so I'm going to do it from within, and I got you,

and now you're going to be taken captive to do Satan's will.

You know we talk about: What's the will of God? What's the will of Satan? The will of Satan

is to bring confusion and division because confusion plus division equals destruction.

Can I add another D in there? Deception, deception.

2 Corinthians Chapter 2 beginning in verse 10, "Anyone you forgive, I also forgive. And

what I have forgiven - if there was anything to forgive - I have forgiven in the sight of Christ

for your sake, [Now listen to verse 11] in order that Satan might not outwit us. For we are

not unaware of his schemes."

Okay, wait! (Exploding sound) There's a couple of presuppositions here. I don't know if you

caught them.

The first of which is that Satan is scheming, right? Because that assumption is made when

Paul, by the Holy Spirit, says hey, he is not going to outsmart us. He's not going to outwit us.

He's not going to deceive us. He's not going to take us captive because we're aware of what

his strategy is, what his schemes are. He's scheming. He has an agenda, he has a plan, he

has a will, and it's destruction. And it comes vis-à-vis confusion, division, deception.

Now for those asking the question of how does all of this fit into Bible prophecy as a sign of

the end? I'll draw your attention to another very well-known passage of Scripture in

Matthew 24. You know it well.

The disciples had just asked Jesus what are going to be the signs of Your return and of the

end of the age? And Jesus answers them in verse 4.

Jesus answers, listen to what His answer is to that question because they want to know:

What is going to mark the time of the end? What will the signs be that Your coming is near,

the end of the age, the end is here? What will the world look like and be like? What will the

signs be like?

First one: Deception, first one. "Watch out that no one deceives you."

In other words, the number 1 sign that we're at the end is going to be deception, first and

foremost.

"For many will come in my name, claiming, 'I am the Messiah,' and will deceive many. You

will hear of wars and rumors of wars, but see to it that you are not alarmed. Such things

must happen, but the end is still to come. Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom

against kingdom. [Does that sound like division to you?]

There will be famines and earthquakes in various places. [And then in verse 8, He takes all

of those things on that list starting with deception and likens them to birth pains] All these

are the beginning of birth pains."

Which we know come in greater frequency and greater intensity. But can we put at the top

of the list where it belongs deception increasing in frequency and intensity, likened unto

birth pains? Deception.

Why?

Because deception is the catalyst for destruction, and destruction is the end game. That's

the sole goal of the enemy of our soul. That almost rhymed a little bit. I think we do err

greatly when we fail to emphasize deception, and how about this, another D, delusion, 2

Thessalonians Chapter 2.

It's not just a delusion; it's a powerful delusion that God Himself sends because they rejected

the truth. They reject Jesus. So you've got this deception and delusion which leads to

confusion and division, and this is a sign that we're at the end.

This particular sign is textbook in the sense that it's a satanic divide and conquer scheme,

which is actually the title of an update we did last year on February 14th: 'Divide and

Conquer.'

Because again, Satan knows this that if that church, that family, that marriage, that home is

united, I can do nothing. The only way I can do anything is to bring division because divided,

I got them. They're going to fall.

So I know - here's the plan you guys, emergency demon meeting.

How's that for a picture? I totally stole that from a Bible commentator who's with the Lord

now.

But Satan calls in an emergency meeting. We're losing ground. People are starting to get

saved. We need to come up with something here. We need to revise the plan, the scheme.

What are we going to do?

Oh, I know. Let's get Christians divided and let's get them angry at each other. And let's get

them to post on social media. And then when, not if, what happens, happens, and it

happened, then basically, they're just going to devour each other, and then they will fall.

I want to ask this question; I've asked it before, and please ... It's a genuine question. It's not

rhetorical. I'm sincerely wanting to know how it is, and I'm not directing this at any one. I'm

talking in the broad sense.

How is it that as Christians we think we can post what we post and then hope in any way to

share Jesus with people? Can I lovingly suggest that when Christians do that, they're playing

right into the hands of the Devil himself?

This brings us full circle to the matter of getting angry or getting ready, which I'd like to

expound on for the remainder of our time, but before we do that, let's go ahead at this time

and end the YouTube and Facebook livestream.

If you were to ask me why now more than ever instead of getting angry, we should be

getting ready, my answer would be this: The COVID deception which has brought much in

the way of division and with it, destruction.

As I hope the aforementioned passages of and prophecies in Scripture show, deception can

be seen as roommates with confusion in the house of destruction. Let me say the same

thing in a different way.

Deception and confusion, and I'll throw in there division, they all live in the same house

that's going to fall. It will not stand. It's just a matter of time. It will lead to destruction.

Deception - Destruction.

Division - Destruction.

Confusion - Destruction.

It's evidenced in what's pictured here with the bullet points from the newly released COVID-

19 guidance from the CDC. This was released on Thursday. I don't know if you heard about

this. One source bullet pointed the updated guidance. I just want to read the four bullet

points here.

Number 1: Those exposed to the virus are no longer required to quarantine.

2: Unvaccinated people now have the same guidance as vaccinated people.

3: Students can stay in class after being exposed to the virus.

4: It's no longer recommended to screen those without symptoms.

Oh, you didn't hear about this? Oh, it must have slipped through the cracks. Hmm. Oh, that's right; what was I thinking? We were too busy thinking about what happened in Mara-Lago, Florida!

I'm going to add another D:

[Laughter]

Distraction.

No, no, no don't look at this. Look at this.

No, what?

Hmm, help me please, Lord. I'm getting angry talking about not getting angry. (Chuckling).

[Laughter]

(Groaning) That's the whole point of it. It's to fuel the rage to get you to rise up!

And we fall for it. It worked. It's working.

Wait, what's working?

Oh, we're so angry about that - Oh, and then add to that the report about the IRS. I guess that they've got 895 trillion - sounds like our national debt - new agents with guns that are going to show up at your house now.

And we get enraged and angry, and what about my constitutional rights? And this isn't America anymore!

And then while they've got everybody yelling at each other, calling each other names, we've got Republicans against Democrats, Right against Left, conservatives against liberals ad nauseam.

And meanwhile, people are dying every day and going to hell for all eternity.

And then they just kind of sneak this little update out on Thursday, and it goes virtually

unnoticed.

Can I just ask - now this is rhetorical - why this, why now? And by the way, what about all of

the lives that have been destroyed in the last two-and-a-half-years?

Marriages destroyed. Families destroyed. Businesses destroyed.

By the way, destroyed - destruction. And how about all the people that died? So back to

this rhetorical question. Why this, why now?

Oh, answer: The deception [Deception] has accomplished and is accomplishing its intended

end of destruction.

Please - I implore you - do not be deceived by this. It's all part of Satan's scheme. And let

me qualify that because the Devil is God's Devil, and everything is going perfectly according

to God's prophetic plan. And the Devil can do no thing unless God allows him to, and God

will never allow the Devil to do anything unless in the end, it serves His purpose for our good

and His glory.

Satan has to ask for permission, and God will grant him permission.

I think about Job of course. Job could do nothing to - I mean Satan could do nothing to Job

unless he first had permission from God to do it.

I think about Peter. (Chuckling) I'm sorry I'm laughing. It's a sanctified laughter.

But Jesus says to Peter, come here we need to talk. I need to apprise you of something. So

Satan asked for permission to sift you as wheat. And if I'm Peter, I'm like, You told him no,

right?

No, I gave him permission.

What?!!!

No, he's going to sift you, but I'm going to give him permission to do it because ultimately,

it's for your good in the end and it's for My glory.

So everything that Satan is being allowed to do right now that's meant for evil, and it is evil,

but God has meant it for good for the salvation of many this day.

So we have this deception, this scheme, this evil in full force, and it's all fulfilling what we're

told in the Bible would happen at the time of the end. So again, I go back to this. Don't get

angry; just get ready because we're out of here, man. That's what this means.

We're told in - and I'll just zero in on Revelation 13 because it's very specific actually about

this, during the 7-year tribulation, after the rapture, which is before the 7-year tribulation,

there will be this global, economic, cashless system that certainly has something to do with

biometrics because you have to have whatever this is in your forehand or your forehead in

order to be able to buy or sell.

And we know it's something biological and medical for a couple of reasons, one of which is

that in Revelation we're told in the original language of the Greek New Testament that it's

pharmakeia, where we get our English word for pharmaceuticals [reference Revelation 9:21,

13:15-18, 16:1-2, 18:23].

And we know it's something medical and pharmaceutical that is in the body because when

you get to Revelation 16, those that have taken whatever this is are going to break out with

boils and rashes, and it will come out of their skin and manifest and present as a reaction, a

medical reaction to whatever this is.

Are you okay?

Now in order to do that, wouldn't it stand to reason that they would have to have in place

something, some scheme, some plan, some thing in order to destroy the current system to

bring in this new system?

Wouldn't it stand to reason that there would have to be - I'll phrase it this way - a controlled

demolition of the global economy in order to usher in a cashless biometric ID system for

young and old alike?

Pictured here is a letter from Moanalua High School here on the island concerning biometric ID's. It states and I quote, "Moanalua High School will be implementing a biometric identification system to purchase meals. Zero Hedge published a report about how dozens of Whole Foods stores will allow customers to pay with palm print biometric data.

Amazon One: Here's a quote, "Amazon's palm-reading payment technology will expand to dozens of Whole Foods locations across California. Shoppers will be able to pay for groceries by scanning the palm of their hand at checkout devices instead of using cash or a card.

Amazon One appears to be ushering in a cashless society where a customer's body is becoming a transactional tool."

I told you before it happens that it would happen so that when it begins to happen nonbelievers will believe and believers will look up instead of getting riled up. Perhaps it goes without saying, but this is all prophesied very specifically in the Book of Revelation concerning the 7-year tribulation.

Now I kind of want to bring it together and just - I appreciate your patience with me. You know, by the way, what I've shared today, it's only a fraction of what's now happening in terms of fulfilling Bible prophecy. I've only taken one small, little part or piece of the prophetic puzzle and put it in place.

But I want to come back to what I see as one of the most heartbreaking realities. And maybe the best way to say this and share this is just to ask you and even plead with you, like the Apostle Paul would, not that I would ever compare myself to Paul, but as a pastor, who, by the way loves you very much, I want you to know that.

I am pleading with you: Please don't get caught up in this. I know it's election season.

Please...

Those people need Jesus. Democrat, Republican, saved or lost. Jesus loves them. You might

hate them and are angry at them, but Jesus loves them, and He died for them.

And we're talking stink about them because we're angry at them because we've been

deceived. We're deceived, and we're divided, and it's a satanic scheme to get you to get

enraged, make you angry, and you lash out and you don't reach out.

(Deep sigh)

I'm going to leave it there with the Holy Spirit.

So much damage to our testimony as Christians. How are we going to get Jesus to people

and people to Jesus when we do that?

One last thing, and it ties into, and I've been thinking about this all week: The Gospel, the

good news.

Because you see, for some people, Christians, good news would be a pay raise to be able to

pay the bills which are getting higher. That's good news.

Or good news is even just getting a job, good news.

Well, that is good news, but a day is coming when none of that's going to matter.

Who's going to be elected?

It doesn't matter.

Oh, come on, Pastor, are you advocating that we sit on our hands and do nothing?

Not at all. I'll say it, and I've said it before, and I'll say it again. If God has called you into the

political arena, you best be found faithful serving in that area to which God has called you.

But if that's where your hope is, you're in for a huge, and I mean, unspeakable

disappointment and let-down.

Because if you really think about it, in light of eternity - in light of eternity? The only good

news on that great and final day will be the good news that Jesus Christ came and died in

your place.

It won't matter who's in office. It won't matter how much is in the bank account. It won't

The only thing that will matter is the Gospel, the good news of Jesus Christ.

Listen, when you're on your deathbed nothing matters! All the money you have, it's of no

value to you. You're about to take your last breath in this world and your first breath in

eternity, and the only thing that matters is Jesus!
