And before we get started, we do want to take a moment to wish all of the moms a happy and certainly a blessed Mother's Day today. We just couldn't do it without you, literally. I'll give you a moment on that, right? Yeah.

Also I am keenly aware that for some, Mother's Day can be a hard day. And I just want to say to those of you who would-be moms or used-to-be moms or used-to-have moms, the Lord knows, the Lord sees, the Lord cares. And so God bless you on this Mother's Day.

Well, we have two services on Sunday morning, and the first is the Prophecy Update we've been doing weekly for a number of years now. And the Second Service is actually the sermon. It's a verse-by-verse study, currently in the Book of *1 John*.

And today we're going to consider a question concerning the dramatic changes that would take place in every arena of our lives were we to just show loving kindness.

Some of you might remember a while back I had shared that I was praying about and thinking about doing a topical teaching on kindness.

So I was waiting on the Lord, and I'm so glad I did because as it would turn out, it's not going to be a topical teaching. It's right here in our text today in *1 John*.

So when I shared this with my wife, she said, "Well then you have to be kind this week."

[Laughter]

How am I doing so far?

[Laughter]

And then she said, "Because it's Mother's Day, you really have to be kind." So please help

me, Lord, to be kinder.

For those of you watching online by way of YouTube or Facebook, we would encourage you

to go directly to the website at JDFarag.org. There you will find the uncensored,

uninterrupted entirety of today's Update. And with that, let's get to it.

I just want to talk with you today, and it's my hope and prayer that the Update today will be

an encouragement, an encouragement to all of us. I include myself in that. And this as it

relates to two matters.

First, the matter of how evil the world is becoming. And second, the matter of how much

longer before the pre-trib rapture at our Bridegroom's coming.

If you're anything like me, and I suspect that you are, these are very difficult matters,

especially in the day in which we are living today. And many of us are grappling and

wrestling with this. It seems that with each passing day, evil continues to wax worse and

worse. And it's an indicator of how close we are, really on the doorstep of the 7-year

tribulation.

And yes, this comes packaged with much hope for those of us in Christ knowing that the

rapture is prior to the 7-year tribulation.

However, it's getting considerably more difficult, nonetheless. And what makes it even more

difficult and please hear me out is that we're continually bombarded with what I'll refer to as

this dialectic narrative.

What's the dialectic narrative?

It's this narrative that things are getting worse particularly here in America because who's in

the White House. Oh, good. Thank you for responding that way.

Now this is what I mean by just hear me out and bear with me on this. I want you to think

about this and think through this with me, okay?

To say this and believe this suggests that if the problem is because of who is in the White

House, then the solution must also come from who gets into the White House.

Both are wrong. I say that in love. They're both wrong, such that the problem of increasing

evil is because we live in a fallen world, a world not our home. And Bible prophecy tells us

that as we near the end, it's going to get worse and worse seemingly with each passing day,

and it is.

So that's where the problem is. That's why the problem is. That is the source of the

problem.

Now what about the solution? Oh, the solution comes not from who's in the White House,

but who's on the throne, who's on the throne!

I think of Isaiah: His world has fallen apart. The king has died. And here he is, he's crying out

to God, as we're going to see today, and he is so shaken, and he looks and beholds the Lord

seated on the throne. And it settles him.

It's not who's in the White House. It's who's seated on the throne, and spoiler alert: He's still

on the throne.

Now some of you are looking at me with that look again. Pastor, where you going with this?

Why are you starting out like this?

Because would you agree that this is being earthly minded? And being earthly minded

comes at the expense of being heavenly minded? Let me just expound briefly.

If my focus is on turning things around down here in the temporal, my focus cannot be on

being raptured up there in the eternal.

In other words, if I still hold out hope for this world, it will obscure, dare I say even dismantle

my hope for being taken out of this world. Is that not our blessed hope, nay even our only

hope?

If I could just be candid and open with you. Sometimes I know doing so can make people

feel uncomfortable, but this is just from the heart. This is a profound personal struggle for

me. And I will tell you why.

I struggle greatly — I sorrow greatly as I see the fulfilling of Bible prophecy specific to this the

end unfold at breakneck speed. And nobody's talking about it at a time when Bible prophecy

is being fulfilled, and nobody's talking about Bible prophecy as it's been fulfilled?

God — this is a "But God" for me I guess — this wrestling and struggling has actually been

the impetus for my seeking and inquiring of the Lord in my own time with the Lord. And in

so doing, He has led me ever so gently — He's always so gentle, isn't He — and

compassionately to His word.

That's the best place and the first place to go, isn't it? And He settled my heart as only He

can and always does.

And if you'll kindly allow me to, I'd like to share with you as an encouragement to you about

two men of God who wrestled with this. They wrestled with how much longer it would be as

God seemingly tarried in the face of unspeakable evil that exponentially escalated, and they

couldn't wrap their minds around it.

God, don't You see the evil that is taking place? It seems like You're letting them get away

with this. You're letting them get away with murder.

Two men; there's more, but just two men I want to talk with you about today. King David

and the prophet Habakkuk, both of whom were surrounded by said escalating evil, which

then prompted them to cry out to the Lord, and is that not what we do when we're faced

with unspeakable evil, surrounded by pure evil?

It prompts us, it propels us to the Lord to seek the Lord and cry out to the Lord, and here's

the thing. The Lord will always hearken unto the voice of our cry.

We're going to start with Habakkuk, interesting guy. His name says it all. The name is the

nature, as you know, particularly in the Old Testament.

In fact, they would wait to name the children until they knew a little bit more about the

nature of that child unless God had showed them otherwise.

Can you imagine that at birth, you don't have the name on the birth certificate, TBD, to be

determined. We'll see what this one's going to be like, and then we're going to name them

accordingly.

I would've not named my two boys Elias and Levi. I would have named them "search" and

"destroy."

[Laughter]

But enough of my problems.

So his name is his nature. The name Habakkuk carries with it the idea of wrestling, clinging,

embracing, and grappling, which describes exactly what this man of God did.

Thankfully though, he goes from wrestling with God to embracing and trusting in God which

then leads to his worshiping of God. However, the process, and it is a process, was grueling

in the sense that he first had to grapple with how much longer, Lord, how long? How much

longer is this going to go on?

I'll begin with a few passages in Habakkuk first, then a couple of verses in *Psalm 6* in which

David also cries out unto the Lord asking, "How long, O Lord."

As we're about to see again, the Lord is going to hearken to the voice of their cry, and He's

going to settle their troubled hearts despite — listen very carefully now — despite the evil

surrounding them getting considerably worse. He's going to settle their hearts in the midst

of that, in the face of that. That's what we're going to see.

And after we establish this biblical foundation with Habakkuk and David with him, then

we're going to apply it to our own lives. Because I know that there are many, perhaps here

today or watching online that are very troubled and struggling and hurting.

Let's start with the *first chapter*, verses 1-3 in Habakkuk. There's only three chapters in this

amazing book, by the way. If you want to read it, you can read it in one setting. I can assure

you you will be blessed if you do.

"The burden [Verse 1, Chapter 1] which the prophet Habakkuk saw. [Verse 2 - here it is] O

Lord, how long shall I cry, and You will not hear? Even cry out to You, "Violence!" And You

will not save. Why do You show me iniquity and cause me to see trouble? For plundering

and violence are before me; there is strife, and contention arises."

That alone: Contention. You've got to know this was a softhearted man. He had a soft heart

and a loving heart, and this hurt his heart to see all of this happening, all the striving and the

arguing, and the fighting and the posting on social media.

Of course he didn't have that back then. I'm just trying to bring it into modern-day terms.

Everyone is fighting with everyone about everything and anything every day, all day; I can't

take it anymore, Lord. And I am crying out to You, and what do I see?

And why are You allowing me to see this? What I see is violence. What I see is evil. What I

see is iniquity, what I see is trouble, problems all around me surrounding me.

This is what's known as the whys and the ways of God. He is asking God: Why, Lord? Why?

The Lord response in *verse 5* of *Chapter 1*.

Listen to His response. "Look among the nations and watch..." I'd like to see this and say

this as God saying to us today: Watch Me now. "Look among the nations and watch – Be

utterly astounded! [Here's why, Habakkuk] For I will work a work in your days which you

would not believe, though it were told you."

In other words, Habakkuk, oh, just wait. You'll see. Watch this. Oh, Habakkuk, listen, it's

not that I wouldn't tell you, it's that I couldn't tell you. The reason I couldn't tell you

beforehand is because if I tried to tell you, all it would do is create a thousand more "why"

questions, right?

Like when our kids are young. Why is the sky blue? And then, of course, us as parents we

try to answer it, and all we do is create more "why" questions.

My answer was — by the way, you can use this if you want. There's no copyright on it. I

would just say because that's God's favorite color. I thought that would settle the case and

close the file. It did not.

So now the next question is why is that God's favorite color? Oh, gosh — because it is. It is,

So Habakkuk, I would have told you. I wanted to tell you, but you wouldn't have believed Me even if I did. You wouldn't have been able to get your mind around it if I did. You would have been so utterly — it would've been beyond the capacity of your bandwidth in the temporal. I am infinite. You are only finite. I couldn't.

Now when the Lord goes on to explain to Habakkuk that He's going to use the Babylonians as the instrument of His judgment on His people for their evil, well, that makes it almost worse for Habakkuk.

Now he's struggling even more.

Why?

Because Babylon is more evil than is Judah. Listen to his next plea in *verses 13, 14, and 17.* This is now Habakkuk responding to the Lord who has just responded to him.

"You are of purer eyes than to behold evil and cannot look on wickedness. Why do You look on those who deal treacherously [Speaking of Babylon] and hold Your tongue when the wicked devours a person more righteous than he? Why?

[Here's the "why" questions — I told you about these, right?]

[Why, why, why? Aye yi yi yi yi!]

Why do You make men like fish of the sea, like creeping things that have no ruler over them? Shall they [Verse 17] therefore empty their net and continue to slay nations without pity?"

You know Habakkuk is pleading with the Lord, inquiring of the Lord concerning? Why, Lord? How long are You going to let this go on, Lord? You're going to use a people that is more evil than Your people to judge Your people with people that are more evil than Your people?

I hope you got that because I don't know if I can say that again. And then not only that, if that weren't bad enough, why — why do You make us have to witness it? Why do you make us have to sit and watch this happen?

Watch what happen? Oh, that they, with impunity, seemingly continue to in a murderous way slay nations? People are dying. Lord! How long?

Now this is where it gets very interesting. By the way, I'm sorry if I'm yelling. I'm supposed to be kind, remember?

It gets very interesting here because the Lord is now going to respond to Habakkuk. It's in Chapter 2, and I'll read verses 2-4. "Then the Lord answered me and said: [Take notes. Write this down] "Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it. For the vision [Verse 3] is yet for an appointed time, but at the end, it will speak, and it will not lie.

Though it tarries, [Meaning though it seems like it tarries] wait for it because it will [Will] surely come. It will not tarry. Behold the proud, [Verse 4] his soul is not upright in him; but the just shall live by his faith."

By faith. Well, this is what settles his heart, so much so that Habakkuk puts it to song, and we have that song, the lyrics to the song in Chapter 3:17-19. Listen to this.

"Though the fig tree may not blossom, nor fruit beyond the vines; though the labor of the olive may fail and the fields yield no food; though the flock may be cut off from the fold and there be no herd in the stalls – [Or no food on the shelves — oh, that's not in the original] Yet [Verse 18] [Yet] I will rejoice in the Lord.

I will joy in the God of my salvation. The Lord God is my strength. He will make my feet like deer's feet. And He will make me walk on my high hills. [And this song is] To the Chief Musician with my stringed instruments."

Who's the Chief Musician? That better be capitalized in your Bibles. That's the Lord. It's the same Chief Musician that the sweet psalmist of Israel, David, would write and pen the words to the song, *Psalm 6*. It's "to the Chief Musician. With stringed instruments. On an 8-stringed harp. A Psalm of David."

Listen to *verses 3 and 4*, David crying out to God. **"My soul also is greatly troubled. But You,**O Lord — how long? Return, O Lord, deliver me! Oh, save me for Your mercies' sake!"

He goes on to describe very graphically, for lack of a better word, how he just soaks his bed at night with his tears, meaning he can't sleep. He's not sleeping through the night. He's weeping through the night.

He's physically sick. It's taking its toll on him physically because of the intensity and the enormity of his situation. And he cries out to God echoing that which the prophet Habakkuk would also cry out to the Lord.

How long, Lord? Don't you see what the evil is all around me? How long, O Lord before You rush in?

You know we refer to a crisis of faith usually in the context of losing one's faith in God. But there's a different kind of crisis of faith. And it's the opposite. And let me explain.

It's a crisis of faith not in losing one's faith in God, it's a crisis because you know God could instantly change everything.

But He doesn't, and it baffles you, and you don't understand why, and that's why you cry. God! Listen, it just seems so clear to me that You should just bring fire down from Heaven, like James and John, which we're going to talk about Second Service, affectionately referred to as the Sons of Thunder when they didn't accept Jesus, and John and James go to Jesus and say, "Do you want us to call down fire like Elijah did" [And just torch them on the spot?] (Chuckling)

That's Second Service. I'm not going to preach the Second Service sermon right now. But you get the point, right?

God, why aren't You torching them? Why aren't You judging them? They just continue on in their evil. And Lord, how long? How long, Lord? How long until You deliver me? How long until You save me? How long until that trumpet sounds, Lord? It's getting really bad. It's getting worse.

Well, let's go to *verse 8*. So the first seven verses of *Psalm 6*, very depressing, very depressing. I mean if you just stop at *verse 7*, you should be depressed. But *8* comes after *7*.

I know that's deeply profound. But from verse 8 on through the rest, everything changes.

Oh, David's circumstances have not changed. We'll talk about that more in a moment. But

something has changed.

Listen to what David says, verse 8, "Depart from me, all you workers of iniquity; for the

Lord has heard the voice of my weeping. [Y'all are in big trouble now] The Lord has heard

my supplication. The Lord will receive my prayer. Let all my enemies be ashamed and

greatly troubled. Let them turn back and be ashamed suddenly."

I like this. David's the one who is so troubled, and now he is saying, "Not me now. It's on

you. You better be greatly troubled. I'm no longer greatly troubled because the Lord has

hearkened unto the voice of my cry. 'O Lord, how long?' And the Lord has settled me like he

just settled Habakkuk."

Do you see the common denominator between these two men of God? God did not

immediately change the evil circumstances surrounding them, but He did change their

troubled hearts within them.

Nothing changed; in fact, it could be argued that it got considerably worse even after that.

But something changed. Yeah, what changed was God settled their troubled hearts within

them despite the evil around them.

And it's evidenced in Chapter 3:18 when Habakkuk says, and I love this so much, and it's

going to be germane to our understanding of what the Lord has put on my heart to share

with you today.

He says, "Yet I will rejoice in the Lord." I'm not going to rejoice in my circumstances. I'm

going to rejoice in the Lord in the midst of my circumstances, despite my circumstances. "I

will joy in the God of my salvation; God is my strength." That's Nehemiah 8:11.

The joy of the Lord is my strength. How about that? Take that! What do you think about

that? You've got to put the growl into it for effect.

Okay, wait, how so?

Because you know, human nature, the sin nature, the Adamic nature in all of us chafes at

this. And here's what that sounds like and looks like.

JD, you can't be happy right now. Do you see what's going on?

Oh, I'm sorry; there's been a misunderstanding. You didn't get the memo. Apparently, you still think that my joy is predicated upon my circumstances. No, my joy is in the Lord despite the circumstances. See, my rejoicing in the Lord is not synonymous with or predicated upon rejoicing in my circumstances.

In fact, with Habakkuk and David and the many others like them, and this is for you and me today, by the way, we can rejoice in the Lord.

Yeah, but do you see how bad it's getting?

We can rejoice in the Lord, the God of my salvation. I can still have joy.

Now why is this so important? Because if we're to have any hope of drinking from the cup of the joy of the Lord, which is our strength, and we need that strength if we are to have any hope as we wait for the Lord, that's the only way.

And like with both of these men, we too can know this joy in the midst of unspeakable evil if we would but live our lives, and this is key, please hear me, by faith and not sight. Because faith is the antithesis of sight. And the just, the righteous live by faith, not sight.

Yeah, I just don't see it.

Wait, oh, I'm sorry. That must've been another memo that was missed because that infers that in order to have peace of mind and joy in your heart, you have to see it first because, after all, seeing is believing.

No, it's not. Believing is seeing. Believe and you will see. That's faith. "The substance of things hoped for, the evidence [Strong word] of that which is yet unseen."

I don't see it, but by faith I'm going to believe it. God, I don't know how You're going to do it. I don't know the way You're going to do it, but I know by faith that You're going to do it. I wish you would tell me when You're going to do it because it seems like you're taking Your time, a very long time. How much longer, Lord? I don't know when You're going to do it, but by faith I know that You will do it.

Let me say one more thing, and we'll try to turn a corner here. If we are to have any hope of surviving and even thriving in the face of what lies ahead and is even now, we have to see this through the eyes of faith.

We see through the eyes of faith. It's the only way that we're going to make it until the appointed time. When's the appointed time? It's now.

Oh, no, here he goes again. Are you going to say it again?

You betcha I am. Fast-forward to today, now, now and what's arguably the evilest day now. Did I say now? Now. Because now is the appointed time. This is now that time, that long-prophesied end of time.

And for the remainder of our time, I want to talk about this and why it is that it cannot be much longer. Be encouraged. With everything that's happening right now, are you kidding me right now? Nah, not much longer. Not much longer.

Let's go ahead and end the livestream on Facebook and YouTube at this time, and hopefully you're already on the website.

Okay, by way of a preface, let me hasten to say that multitudes of people are dying each and every day from this evil COVID-19 injection. And you're not hearing about it, and you won't, by the way.

So Wednesday of this last week — you know how it is when God orchestrates divine appointments, schedules divine appointments for you that you could have never in a million years ever schedule?

Well, He did that for me last Wednesday, and it allowed me the opportunity to talk with our mail carrier who I actually was wondering about, thinking about because I hadn't seen her for a while.

So whenever I see her, I always try to encourage her. And I just asked her — I don't come on too strong — I just ask her, "How you doing?" And I just always let her know, "Hey, I am praying for you."

Sometimes, you know, if the Lord present the opportunity, I will say, "Is there anything

specific I can pray for you for? I mean, the Lord knows. Just know that I'm praying for you."

And she always appreciates that.

Well, on Wednesday when I asked her how she was doing, a little different response. She

said, "Well, I could be doing better." And so I asked her why.

And she proceeded to tell me that there had been a number of unexpected deaths in her

family and it was a really hard time for her.

Well, I immediately told her I was really sorry to hear about that, and I was thinking about

her because I hadn't seen her for a while. And then I just reiterated how I would, you know,

pray for her, and then she started tearing up.

And in moments like that, and I know you probably do the same, you know, you just kind of

ask the Lord to give you the words to speak. And so I just got this prompting and sense from

the Holy Spirit that I was to very gently ask her if she thought their deaths could be related

to the shots.

And her response, though hesitant at first, was that, and this is almost a verbatim quote, "I

hate to say it, I hate to say it, but I believe that it is because everyone who died was

injected."

Thursday night, Ezekiel 9, Ezekiel is shown a vision, and there is this angel who is told to put

a mark which was the Hebrew letter Tav, the shape of a cross on the forehead to seal those

And if that doesn't give you a compassion for people, I mean, if they only knew what was

coming, and it is even now already here.

So after she shared that, I tried to gather myself, and just tell her again I was so sorry to hear

this and I would absolutely be praying for her, that God would encourage her and comfort

her and that she would be blessed ,and she was very appreciative of that. I'm praying for

her salvation.

What struck me about this conversation though was her hesitancy. She hesitated, and then

she said, "I hate to say it."

You know what that tells me? The hesitancy to dare say anything says everything, especially

when it comes to the evil of this and the facts about this.

You know what's sad? Any search for authentication of this or documentation on this is met

with a flurry of so-called "fact checkers" attempting to debunk it.

However, the more they tried to debunk it, the more they unwittingly lend creed to it. What

do you mean? Well, I mean why are you so hell-bent, literally, on explaining it away?

This is actually exactly what that famous line in the William Shakespeare play 'Hamlet'

speaks to. Perhaps you've heard it. "The lady doth protest too much me thinks."

It's spoken by Queen Gertrude in response to the insincere overacting of a character in the

play within a play created by Prince Hamlet to prove his uncle's guilt in the murder of his

father, the King of Denmark.

This famous line has come to be known as a cynical, ironic, and even sarcastic comment

directed at someone who seems to overdo, overreact to a situation or accusation so as to
