PASTOR JD: Amen and Amen. Good morning and welcome. You can be seated. Thank you. I want to welcome those of you that are joining us online. We're so very glad that you are. This is our first of two services on Sunday morning, which is devoted to the weekly Bible Prophecy Update.

Second Service, which will be at 11:15 a.m. Hawaii Standard Time, that will be livestreamed as well, is our verse-by-verse study through the Bible. We're currently in *1 John*, the *third chapter*, and today we're going to look at why it is that the fruit from my life will always expose what's at the root of my life. It's got a catch to it, yeah? Nice title? Just humor me. Tell me it's a nice title.

Those of you that are watching by way of YouTube and Facebook, you might want to go directly to the website at JDFarag.org because at some point, we'll end the livestream, and there you'll find the uninterrupted and uncensored entirety of today's Update. So with that, let's get started.

What I want to talk with you about today is what I'm going to affectionately refer to as one having a pre-trib rapture preparedness. And the reason I'm choosing this title and topic is because whether we realize it or not, we are being prepared and even in some cases programed, dare I say.

It's not really a matter of if we are being prepared. It's more of a question of: Are we prepared for what's being prepared? I know this might come off as maybe an oversimplification, but I'll say it, nonetheless. We are either prepared by the world for the world, or we're prepared to be taken out of the world.

And this, by way of the pre-tribulation rapture of the church, which I will never shrink back

from. I don't care who says what about that.

[Audience says, "Amen!"] I will never cower or falter or be intimidated by anybody that

says, "You're so dogmatic about the pre-tribulation rapture."

[Laughter]

I needed to get that off of my chest right out of the chute.

[Laughter]

But the pre-tribulation rapture is when "we who are alive and remain are caught up to

meet the Lord in the air," as 1 Thessalonians Chapter 4:17 in my Bible says.

But the sad truth is that the masses, including professing Christians, are actually being

readied for the tribulation coming upon the world and not the pre-trib rapture when we're

taken out of the world. And that's just the fact of the matter, sadly.

Even sadder, not only are many Christians not prepared for our soon departure in the

rapture, they, along with others, including some pastors and teachers, demean those,

belittle those who dare to believe that the rapture of the church, the pre-trib rapture of the

church can happen, like, right now.

[Audience says, "Amen!"]

I was just checking.

[Laughter]

It's actually even worse than that. I want to get this out of the way. But it's worse than that

because teachers of Bible prophecy are joining in and piling on anyone who dares to suggest

that we don't have decades before the rapture could happen. We are that generation.

But anybody who dares to say that — you're a date setter! Stop, just stop.

I didn't realize I'm so upset already, and we haven't even started. Let me try to calm down.

Lord, I'm sorry just help me. Actually, I'm going to share with you a most interesting email

that we received a couple of days ago. I'm going to share some portions of this email with

you. It speaks to this exact issue.

I mean, I have been struggling personally. And we get this email, and I'm like, Lord thank

You. You knew I needed someone to email this to me. So I want to share it with you.

"Good day Pastor JD. I follow you online from Trinidad in the Caribbean.

Today however, I would like to spell out very plainly yet another reason why I appreciate

your ministry. A pastor, while he seemed concerned about the harm caused by date setting,

had an attitude toward those among us who are excited about Christ's return, and it was

very discouraging.

He said of these brethren that, "Their eschatology lacks scholarship and academia, and that

they should not try to teach Hebrew and Greek because they are so far from a proper

knowledge of these languages.""

[Laughter]

I didn't write this, okay? Just so you know. I could have, maybe not as well. But I've been

struggling with this, and she's hitting the proverbial nail on the head because there seems to

be this, I'll use her word, "attitude" on the part of "some who possess certain academic

credentials, have a proper understanding of the original Hebrew and Greek language, are

biblically qualified in their scholarship."

They've sort of banded together now and teamed up on and piled up on brothers and sisters

in Christ who are going, "Hey!"

"Yeah, but where are your degrees? Where are the letters after your name?"

"I don't have any, so I change my name. I just put the letters in front of my name, JD,

[Laughter]

which stands for "Jesus' disciple," by the way."

It reminds me of the Apostle Paul — I'll get back to the email, just bear with me — but it

reminds me of the Apostle Paul when he writes to the Corinthians in his first letter — by the

time you get to — I mean at the beginning — by the time he gets to the second chapter, he

writes about how he did not come to them seeking to impress them with his intellect. He

did not come to persuade them with the eloquence of his speech.

Rather, he came to preach Jesus and Him crucified. And here's a guy that by any standard, I

mean pretty impressive, and he could have certainly — I would've have — which is why God

probably never allowed me to ever further my education. I barely graduated high school.

I'm not proud of that, but I just think God still chooses to use the foolish things of this world

to confound the wise and the week to shame the strong.

Nothing wrong with that except that when that becomes the credential, the authentication,

the validation, and there's this superiority, like, "Well, who are you? You're a nobody."

"Well, last time I checked, God uses nobodies."

[Laughter]

I love how one said, "You're not in the 'Who's Who."

"Well, I'm in the 'Who's He."

[Laughter]

This is a problem, and I'm going to just hit it head-on because I see it getting worse. So she's

just sharing her heart with me about her struggle with this idea that you have to have

eschatological scholarship and knowledge of the Greek and Hebrew. And you have to have

the academic credentials to be able to even teach Bible prophecy.

Quoting the email again, very well-written, "He did not have to call the names of the

brethren he was levying his attack on. I was so disheartened to hear him speak this way. I

know I'm no theologian and am not a graduate of any cemetery — [Actually seminary — she

didn't say cemetery]

[Laughter]

[I added that]

[Laughter]

But of late, I have taken a position to be somewhat of a watcher because of what I observed

where I am, but after hearing him, I doubted whether I should desire or pursue such a

course.

After all, I do not know Hebrew or Greek. But I can surely make a good go at researching the

Scriptures. [Oh...]

Does it make me less worthy to [And this makes me want to cry] does it make me less

worthy to labor in the vineyard because I am not as learned as he or they?

Sometimes I wonder if brothers like this and such likes are angry more at the fact that these

brethren are revealing information that they did not have years ago, especially since some of

them have many books out there about "end time prophecies" and what they felt were

"signs of the times."

Now they know that they were wrong, and it seems to me that they're still trying to justify

their positions from years before. That position is just as damaging as the brothers he's

accusing. He did not seem too kind in my opinion, not very gracious, almost not embracing

them as brethren in the Lord.

Before I found your ministry two years ago, it was these preachers I was listening to, and it

was exactly this effect their preaching had on me. They did not call a specific date, but they

did not need to, and I made some very important decisions based on what they taught. And

they puzzled me too. I heard them planning for things way into the future while delivering

these powerful sermons of Christ's soon return. Then I listened to some of their conferences

and was left puzzled and angry.

People asked questions like: Is the Antichrist alive today? Or: How long after the Rapture

would the Tribulation begin? Or: How long before the Rapture happens?

Here's one answer: We don't know if the Antichrist is alive.

My brain can't make sense of this. The Rapture could happen anytime, but the Tribulation

could begin months, years, or even 50 years from now? These same preachers use John 14

to prove the Rapture, making reference to a Galilean wedding.

When the Scriptures tell us that when we see certain things begin to happen, "Look up for

your redemption draweth near," where do these two examples fit in with an answer as

stated earlier? They do confuse me greatly.

Then, with respect to when the Rapture will occur, I have actually heard one of them in an

interview say it could be as much as 50 years from now. Imagine that!

I'm like, you, Pastor. [I love you — I feel sorry for you if you're like me...]

But she goes on to write: There goes my "Blessed Hope." These preachers say that even

though everything is lining up, God could make it play out for as long as 50 years more

because "we do not know the day or the hour."

They think that they are innocent, but they are not. They have robbed me of the joy of my

"Blessed Hope," all the anticipation and so forth from watching so many other good brothers

in the Lord. It does take its toll because they seem to be seasoned prophecy watchers on

the block [Talking in this manner]

And some seem to have hinged so much on scholarship and education and academia that I

wonder what place the Scripture has in this thinking when it tells us that we have an unction

from the Holy Spirit so that "we need not that any should teach us."

That was 1 Peter — yeah, 1 Peter or 1 John — We just got done with that. It's pretty bad

when the pastor doesn't remember what he preached on. We just talked about this: "The

unction from the Holy Spirit that gives you discernment."

But here's this precious sister in the Lord going: Oh, I guess I have to listen to them because

they are the authority now because they have the academic credentials now. They have the

scholarship now. So I guess I don't need the Holy Spirit or the — oh, I don't need the

Scriptures because apparently, I can just go to them, and they'll interpret it for me instead of

me. Hmm.

"Studying is important, but to project that it is only the formally trained should have a voice

is humiliating. Still we are Christ's, not so?"

You know what she's saying here? She's saying: I'm just a nobody that loves Jesus, and I'm

watching for His soon return as I'm told in the Scriptures I should. And I'm watching, and I'm

discerning the times and I'm understanding the times, and I know like the men of Issachar

what I need to do. And I happen to know a couple of verses. Oh, not like you though!

But if I go to the Scriptures, that's the final authority.

The reason I wanted to start out this way and share this with you is because we're exhorted in Scripture, as the sister so eloquently and passionately writes, to be at the ready in our expectation of the rapture at any time. Paul was. 2000 years ago: "We who are alive and remain."

Every generation has, by God's design, thought that the rapture could happen in their lifetime. And it could have. And they were ready. And they weren't Greek and Hebrew scholars. They were not theologians, and you don't need to be a Greek or Hebrew scholar or theologian to know that the end is not near; the end is here.

One more thing before I turn this next corner. I wonder sometimes if it's not the opposite that's true. Stay with me; hear me out. For those of you who see me as your pastor, which I'm profoundly privileged to be, you understand that I stand before you, as is my privilege to every week, as one who has no formal education.

Again, nothing wrong with that. I have no Greek or Hebrew scholarship. I can speak a little bit of Arabic. I just thought I'd throw that in. I'm just somebody that God looked at and thought, "You know I probably could use a guy like that."

"Yeah, but — here's the heavenly host going — he doesn't even — not only does he not have an impressive resume, actually doesn't even have a resume."

[Laughter]

"I know."

"Yeah, but him? Come on, You can do better than that."

"Actually I'm going to use somebody like that because then they will know it's not him because look at him."

(Chuckling) I can't stand before you and give any credit to my credentials. Paul says the reason I didn't come to you with my crushing intellect [which he possessed] my persuasive speech [which he possessed] the reason I didn't come to you... [I could have, but I didn't] You want to know why?

That way you would know it was the Holy Spirit, the power of the Holy Spirit, and God's

word, not my intellect. So when you walk away, you're going, "Wow! If God could use

somebody like that, there's hope for me."

Because again, I'm pretty sure it's still there. You can look it up after the Prophecy Update,

but God does "choose the foolish to confound the wise" so that He alone gets the glory.

I think of David. One last thing. He's not even in the lineup. Are you kidding me?

Here comes Samuel. He's got the Urim, the Thummim. He's ready to anoint the next king of

Israel to succeed Saul, from whom the kingdom has been taken away. He shows up. Seven

young, built, buff, work out every day at "24 Hour fitness,"

[Laughter]

especially the oldest brother, Eliab.

And in that culture to this day, the firstborn, that's the one, the heir apparent. Surely Eliab is

the next king of Israel. Can you picture them standing there? Eliab looking at his other

brothers going "You know it's me. I don't even know why you're bothering."

So here comes Samuel. And even Samuel is baffled. "It's like, it's not you."

Eliab is going, "Here try again."

"No, it's not you." And then by age, he goes down the list: seven brothers, none of them.

He's flabbergasted. He says to Jessie, the father, "I'm pretty sure I did not pull the wrong file

here. "You have another son?"

"Oh, yeah, but come on he's the youngest."

"Where is he?"

"Well, he's out tending to the sheep."

"Well, go get him. And nobody sits down, has a cup of coffee until he gets here."

So could you imagine the surprise on David's face when they come out, and they get him and

say, "Hey, the prophet Samuel is there, and he's asking for you."

"Me?"

"Yeah, you."

"You talking to me?"

"Yeah, you."

So we're told the detail — I love it — God's got a sense of humor. A little ruddy — he's a teenager, smells like sheep. Comes in from the sheep that he's been tending. Could you imagine?

I know — I think like this. Just pray for me because I picture Eliab going — the body language?

[Laughter]

Here walks up David: "What?"

[Laughter]

Samuel: "It's him."

The brothers: "What?"

[Laughter]

Dad: "No way."

Even David's probably going: "Okay, well... my heart is after God's own heart. I am His to do with as He pleases."

And then Samuel is even — and we're talking the prophet Samuel here, okay? The Lord has to pull him aside to say, "Hey Sam, Sam, get over here. We got to talk. I know your blown away here."

"Yeah, you think?"

"Well, let me explain something to you. Man looks at the outward appearance, but I look at the heart."

I think about when King Asa is sent this prophecy from the prophet on the heels of a victory over a one-million-man Army of the Ethiopians. And the prophet prophesies to him and

says, "Don't you know that the eyes of the Lord searches to and fro throughout the earth

looking for hearts fully devoted to Him so that He can be strong on their behalf?"

So just kind of picture this. Use your God-given imagination and picture God doing a search.

"I'm looking for somebody. I can't use him. He thinks more highly of himself that he ought.

And even if I tried to, well, he would certainly take all the credit for it. And everybody would

be more than happy to give him all the credit for it. After all, look at his credentials. No

wonder. Nah, I think I'll choose that guy. (God chuckling) It's laughable. So that when I find

a heart that is after My own heart, fully devoted to Me, fully depending on Me, fully relying

on Me, fully committed to Me, now we're talking. I'm going to use him."

"Yeah, but he's not even a pastor."

"I know."

"All he's got is a YouTube channel."

"I know. But I can use somebody like that."

"Yeah, but he hasn't written any books."

"That's actually going to seal the deal for Me. That's the guy I'm going to use because he's

not going to be selling books at the table out front afterwards."

Nothing wrong with that. I'm just saying that they have fancied themselves now as being

"the experts," so that if God should happen to choose a David to use, the problem isn't that

God is going to choose to use a David; the problem is when these other guys who have all of

the credentials are not.

And they crossed the line when with that scholarship and academia and knowledge and

theology and all of the above, they start looking down on, and piling on, and are

condescending of, and belittling of, and dismissive of the guy that God chooses to use.

Are we okay?

So you've got a group of people now that God, in His sovereignty, in His grace has, in His

search found to choose and use that baffled the minds of all the experts, and they're actually

daring to say, "I think we're out of here."

And this is the direction I want to go. And it's for this reason I'm going in this direction. And what I want to do is build upon a detailed account in the Book of Exodus, namely that of the departure preparedness, as it were, when the Israelites had to be at the ready to leave Egypt in haste.

They started up YouTube channels there in Egypt. And they were doing these podcasts, and they were saying, "Hey, this is it! This is it! We need to be ready!"

Enter Exodus *Chapter 12* replete with typology concerning Jesus as the fulfillment of the Passover prophecy. I want to draw your attention to the specific details as it relates to the urgency and haste with which the Israelites had to be ready at any moment.

"No, no hurry. We've got 50 years."

"No, no, no. Come back, Come back. Exodus 12. No, this is it. This is it."

I want to kind of, by way of an introduction —

"This is only the introduction, Pastor?"

"Well, not really, but we'll get there."

It's going to be germane to our understanding of what the Spirit is saying to us as the church today, for those who have ears to hear and hearts to receive. "Behold I come quickly."

Listen to verse 11, Exodus 12.

Now you understand the Passover? I'm not going to go into it, nor do I have the time to. But that tenth plague: The angel of death would pass over if they had the blood of the lamb in the shape of a cross on the door posts. They would be saved, and the angel of death would pass over them, a prophecy that would be fulfilled by the person of Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God.

Okay, now the Israelites are about to be taken out in haste of Egypt. No time. We don't have time. You don't have 50 years. "And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist [Ready to go] your sandals on your feet."

We call them slippers. Don't call them flip-flops. I did that. Never call, in Hawaii, "slippers," "flip-flop." You'll get flip-flopped if you do.

[Laughter]

[I mean you got your slippers on] "And your staff in your hand so you shall eat it in haste."

[There's no time] [Why?] "It's the Lord's Passover." [It's time]

This is happening. We're doing this!

Verses 33 and 34, Exodus 12, "And the Egyptians urged the people that they might send them out of the land in haste." [Hang onto that word "haste"] [I really like this word "haste" in this context]

"For they said, 'We shall all be dead.' So the people took their dough before it was leavened [No time] having their kneading bowls bound up in their clothes on their shoulders."

"We're ready, we're ready to go."

"Good. In haste."

"Right."

"No time."

"I know; that's why."

Verse 39, "And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they had brought out of Egypt; for it was not leavened because [Here's why, listen please very carefully] they were driven out of Egypt [Can I say taken out of Egypt] and could not wait, nor had they prepared provisions for themselves."

"Why is that?"

"Because it happened so fast."

"Oh, I thought I had 50 years to prepare provisions for this."

"No, no time."

"Oh, I thought we had time. We could wait for..."

"Nope — And could not wait."

No time to prepare their provisions because I'm taking you out in haste. In haste. Suddenly. Quickly. Now. Now. Just checking again. Just checking.

"Pastor, where are you going with this?"

Just as the Israelites left Egypt in haste, not even preparing provisions, so too, is this true for us. In other words, there had to be an urgency and a preparedness to leave in haste from Egypt, which in typology the world is a picture of Egypt. And just as Israel was taken out of Egypt with haste, so too will we be taken out of this world in the pre-trib rapture with haste. There's no time. There's no time.

Now, we still have a problem. What's the problem? The problem is that many Christians today do not possess this urgency, and as such, they're not preparing with haste for the pre-Tribulation rapture. And this for several reasons, not the least of which is that they still think that we have time.

"I wrote a book a couple of years ago, so it can't happen right now because then I have to go back and rewrite that book or take it and edit it or something because we still have time because this has to happen, that has to..."

"No, it doesn't."

"Well, according to the Greek and the Hebrew..."

"No - it's - no."

"Oh, have you seen my credentials?"

"No, it's okay. I don't need to see them. I know that you've got them framed, huge, on your wall in your office on display. You dust them off every day."

If this weren't bad enough instead of a pre-Tribulation rapture preparedness, many are actually focused on the next pandemic preparedness. Why is that you ask? Well, it's because many buy the lie with the prolific and powerful propaganda that's fed to the masses in ways never before known. It's the likes of which we have never seen before, nor will we ever see again.

Well, I want to talk about that for the remainder of our time. So we're going to go ahead

and end the livestream at this time.

What I wanted to say (Chuckling) was this. A couple of years ago — this is back in 2020-

2021. It's funny, but it's sad. You know what I mean? It's kind of a paradoxical thing, but it

was asked of the — I want to say it was the Amish community — why nobody in these Amish

communities were getting COVID. And the answer was "because we don't have a TV."

[Laughter]

True story. They didn't get sick. Because see, they weren't brainwashed.

We did a whole — we did more than one Prophecy Update on the programming, the

predictive programming. You know the movies from even 50 years ago were all preparing us

for this. It was predictive programing. You can go back even now, and I'll never forget that

Update. It was one of the more interesting ones. Boy, it took a lot of time to go through all

that material.

But I only quoted a handful of very well-known movies that had these very subtle, almost

subliminal, predictive programing about a virus, a pandemic. And oh, so interesting how it

was almost verbatim in how it paralleled with what really happened. And that's just the

movies, the television programs and Netflix series.

How about all the tabletop exercises that were conducted prior? You know I've shared

documentation with you — I had no intention of going this far, but too late, I'm already

there. So we will take the scenic route this time, I guess.

I've shared with you documentation. By the way, you won't find it anymore — they pulled it.

I shared with you documentation about how they already had this quote-unquote vaccine in

2017. Did you know that?

Anyway, I just wanted to say that now that we're not on YouTube and Facebook. Let's start

with this post from a couple of weeks ago on July 21st. It's a fact sheet from the White

House about the launch of what they're dubbing the 'Office of Pandemic Preparedness and

Response Policy.'

Translated: We want to prepare you for the next one. There's a next one? Yeah, the sequel.

[Laughter]

A couple of brief quotes: "The Office of Pandemic Preparedness and Response policy will:

...Drive and coordinate federal science and technology efforts related to pandemic

preparedness.

Specifically, OPPR will oversee efforts to develop, manufacture, and procure the next

generation of medical countermeasures [That right there doesn't sound good] including

leveraging emerging technologies [You know what that means] and working with HHS on

next generation vaccines and treatments for COVID-19 and other public health threats."

You know the ones that we have been planning for decades and have these so-called

vaccines already ready for, and we just needed to prepare you for this so that you would

take what we prepared for you to take.

Doubtless you know that they've been programming and preparing the population for the

next pandemic for quite some time, and it's evidenced by this quote from Tony Blair at this

year's World Economic Forum, Davos 2023 conference titled, I mean just the title alone: 100

Days to Outrace the Next Pandemic.'

Here's a quote, Blair, Tony Blair, you know who he was, right? Was, is; I don't care who he

"... You're going to have to look after that population first, and I also think this issue to do

with the technology and the digital infrastructure. I just want to emphasize how important I

think that is because in the end, you need the data, you need to know who's been vaccinated and who hasn't been. Some of the vaccines that will come on down the line will be multiple. There will be multiple shots you've got to have for reasons that have to do with healthcare, more generally, but certainly for a pandemic or for vaccines.

You've got to have a proper [Here it comes] digital infrastructure, and many countries don't have that. In fact, most countries don't have that."

In other words, they're not prepared, and they need to be prepared because we're about to launch this on you guys, y'all.

This according to The Hill in a recent interview with Gates, who should know because he's the one who pre-plans for, invests in, and profits from the very crisis he creates by offering what he's actually been quoted as calling, "The Final Solution."

I'm not going to let them prepare me for what they want to prepare for me. I'm going to be prepared for what Jesus said He went to prepare for me. A place in His Father's house, and if it were not so He would not have told me that He goes to prepare a place for me, that where I am there —where He is, there I may be also."

You know what He's talking about, don't you? He's preparing a place for us as His bride to consummate and celebrate our marriage to the Lamb. And that celebration takes place for, wait for it, a period of seven, the number of completion.

I like how one said it, "While the world is tribulating, we're going to be celebrating." And at the end of the seven, the bride emerges from that place that the groom prepared for her in His Father's house, this bridal chamber. They emerge for a huge feast, the wedding feast of the Lamb.

Because you'll show up here; we're going to be gone. That's not very nice to say it like that.

I'm almost done, but can I just say I will not buy the lie from the father of lies, and here's why. He wants to give me a spirit of fear to steal my joy, kill my hope, and destroy my faith because the thief, the enemy, comes not except to steal, kill, and destroy.

"What does he want to steal, kill, and destroy?"

He wants to steal your joy, and "the joy of the Lord is your strength." He wants to kill your hope, and he wants to destroy your faith. And does this not accomplish that?

What do you mean?

Well, Jesus, in Matthew 24, contrasts two servants in a parable. It's quite a profound and powerful and poignant parable because one servant is righteous, the other is unrighteous. You got the faithful servant and the wicked servant.

And to the servants, the master says, I'm going to go, but I'll come back, and I'm going to entrust you to steward and be faithful with that which I've called you to. And then when I come, I want to find you faithful doing what I called you to do.

And that's what he did. Read it for yourself, Matthew 24.

He's says, "Oh, nah, my master delays his coming."

"Wait, what do you mean?"

"Yeah, no hurry, no worry. We've got 50 years. Have you seen my degrees?

[Laughter]

I just dusted them off this morning. No, let's party."

He drunk with drunkards and ate with gluttons and partied with partiers, and I'll leave it there. Beat on his fellow servants; I mean, no hurries.

"He delays his coming. We still got plenty time. Party on."

And then much to his surprise, his master comes at an hour that he expects not. And what does he find him doing?

The most dangerous and seductive lie the enemy ever told was that there's no hurry. I like how one Bible commentator described it and illustrated it. Like this emergency meeting with Satan and all the demons.

It's kind of like, "Hey, we're losing ground for the kingdom of darkness. We need to come up with a new strategy."

So one of the demon says, "I've got an idea. Let's lie to them that there's no Heaven."

Satan's like, "Nah, that's not going to work. Come on. The whole creation speaks of a Creator."

And then another guy, a demon, pops up and says, "Hey, I know, not no Heaven, how about there's no hell? That will kind of take the edge off."

"Nah, Satan says, no, that might work on some but not everyone because there's within

man, God has already, Ecclesiastes says, set eternity in their heart. So they know better.

You might get some, but they're not going to fall for that."

Satan says, "Here's what we're going to do. It's not the lie of there's no Heaven or the lie of

there's no hell. It's the lie of no hurry. See, if we can take the urgency, the haste, the "now"

out of this, then hey, what's the hurry? No worry. We've got plenty time. That's how we're

going to get them."

And he did. He did.

You know the believer: I don't care what your qualifications or scholarship is. The believer

that lives their life like that, like dat, is going to be the one who does the most good here on

earth.

And I beg to differ; in fact, I vehemently oppose and disagree with Mark Twain who said,

"You can be so heavenly minded, you're of no heavenly good." It's the opposite that's true.

The more heavenly minded you are, the more earthly good you'll do.

Why?

Because "this is it."

And by the way, let's just say this isn't it, which it is. What have you lost? I can't imagine

anybody in Heaven after the rapture, even just during the seven years of celebrating, our

consummating of the marriage to our bridegroom, I can't imagine anybody going, "Man, I

interested in the Savior if you don't see yourself as a sinner? You don't see yourself as God

sees you?

"How does God see me?"

"Oh, that "there is no one righteous [Romans 3:10] not even one."

"How does God see me?"

"Oh, Romans 3:23. God sees you as a sinner because "all of sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

"Okay, so I'm a sinner. Now what?"

"Well, there's a penalty for it."

"What's the penalty?"
