I want to talk with you today about what's come to be known as Stockholm Syndrome, specifically how it eerily and prophetically describes everything that's happening in the world today.

Now I want to by way of introduction read a compilation from several sources that define what Stockholm Syndrome is and more importantly, why it happens.

Stockholm Syndrome is a psychological phenomenon of an emotional attachment to a capture formed by a hostage as a result, listen, of continuous stress, dependence, and a need to cooperate for survival. It's a coping mechanism to a captive or abusive situation wherein a captive begins to identify closely with his or her captors as well as with their agenda and their demands.

The name is derived from a botched bank robbery in Stockholm, Sweden. In August 1973, four employees were held hostage in the bank's vault for six days. During the standoff, a seemingly odd bond developed between captive and captor.

One hostage during a telephone call with the Swedish Prime Minister stated that she fully trusted her captors but feared that she would die in a police assault on the building. The hostages were rescued, but despite threats and abuse, including being strapped with dynamite, they were surprisingly supportive of their captors.

Amazingly, one woman later became engaged to one of the hostage takers and another developed a legal defense fund to assist their captors. Those who have studied this syndrome believed that the bond is initially created when a

captor threatens a captive's life, deliberates, and then chooses not to kill the captive.

The captive's relief at the removal of the death threat is transposed into feelings of gratitude toward the captor for him or her life. As the incident proves it takes only a few days for this bond to cement proving that early on the victim's desire, listen very carefully to this, the victim's desire to survive supersedes the urge to hate the person who created the situation. The survival instinct is at the heart of the syndrome.

Victims live in enforced the and interpret rare or small acts of kindness in the midst of horrible conditions as good treatment. They often become hypervigilant to the needs and demands of their captors, making psychological links between the captors' happiness and their own.

Indeed, the syndrome is marked not only by a positive bond between captive and captor but also by a negative attitude on behalf of the captive toward authorities who threaten the captor- captive relationship. The negative attitude is especially powerful when the hostage is of no use to the captors except as leverage against a third party.

And then lastly, and again, listen very carefully, a person can develop Stockholm Syndrome when they experience significant threats to their physical or psychological well-being. I hope, and my hope and prayer is and has been, that all of us can start to connect the dots with what's happening now especially as it relates to today's global taskmasters.

Sadly, many a professing Christian has fallen prey to this notion that said taskmasters are in control of everything they do and even whether they live or die.

Thankfully, they don't; God does, and we're not to fear man. The fear is an enslaving trap and snare. Rather, we're to fear the Lord. Listen to what Jesus said in Matthew's Gospel and *Chapter 10* beginning in *verse 26*.

"Therefore do not fear them. For there is nothing covered that will not be revealed and hidden that will not be known."

Can't wait!

"Whatever I tell you in the dark, speak in the light; and what you hear in the ear, preach on the housetops. And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell."

Here's the truth. We have a Savior. His name is Jesus. And He will save us from hell and deliver us from the sin and the bondage of this world, the flesh, and the Devil. However, these horrible conditions and as we just read, significant threats to our physical and psychological well-being seemingly continue to worsen with each passing day.

Now hear me out when I say this because at first it might seem a little bit hard to grasp, but what if I told you that this is actually a good thing?

Yeah, I knew it, pastor, you're sick. What is wrong with you?

I know. They have clinical terms for this. But this is actually a good thing, and I will explain why if you will hear me out.

It's a good thing because like Israel's slavery in Egypt, Egypt, a type of the world, it was excruciatingly unbearable right before God delivered them from their captors, if I can say it like that.

Exodus Chapter 5, beginning in verse 10. "And the taskmasters of the people and their officers went out and spoke to the people, saying, "Thus says

Pharaoh..." [You're back in lock down - no, that's not what it says, but I should

give you a little bit of the back story here]

So Moses as God commanded him to had gone to Pharaoh and said to Pharaoh let my people go. Pharaoh's response was yeah, no problem. No, his response was: Are you kidding me? They are complaining? They must have extra time on their hands. Here's what we're going to do. Here's what they can do with that extra time on their hands. Have them get their own straw to make those bricks.

And by the way, archaeologist has found that many of the structures that were built by these very Israelite slaves, you'll notice the quality of the bricks changed, the composition of the brick. I love it when archeology proves the Bible. I could go on that, I won't because it will be me from what I really want to talk about today.

But you know when they find-something, they dig, they do a dig, you know these archaeologist, and the one that discovered the civilization. Wow, what we found? Well, how do we know? Well, I know. Let's go to the Bible.

Anyway... that's all I'm going to say. So instead of letting them go, he makes it harder on them and now they've got to go out and get their own straw. 'I will not give you straw. Go, get yourselves straw where you can find it; [Yet it is even worse than that] yet none of your work will be reduced.'"

Those quotas, same quotas.

And don't complain because I will increase the quotas with no straw. He didn't say that; I'm saying that.

"So the people were scattered abroad throughout all the land of Egypt to gather stubble instead of straw. And the taskmasters forced them to hurry, [Come on] saying, "Fulfill your work, your daily quota, as when there was straw." Also the officers of the children of Israel, whom Pharaoh's taskmasters had set over them, were beaten and were asked, "Why have you not fulfilled your task in making brick both yesterday and today, as before?"

Question: Why, why did God choose to deliver His people in this way? And He's going to deliver them, but why allow this to happen? Why have it be so much worse, and so much more difficult? Because they would want to be delivered.

Stay with me. Had the conditions under their captors been more bearable, they wouldn't have been as eager to be delivered. You got to know that by that tenth plague, in fact the detail in the narrative says they left with haste. They were commanded to get out of here.

You don't have to tell me to get out. I'm out of here man! Are you kidding me? You had me at frogs. Not Farags, frogs. The stench alone, you had me at that! But the tenth plague, the death of the firstborn son? Oh, it's so powerful the whole typology in the 10 plagues, but again, I don't want to digress. But did you make that connection?

See, I got to get my people out of Egypt but the only way - because they are too comfortable there.

Yeah, but they're slaves.

Yeah, I know but they kind of developed a little bit of a bond with their captors and taskmasters.

They did?

Yeah.

What do you mean?

Well, after being delivered during the wilderness wanderings, they wanted to go back. They had this bond with, and this dependence on the Egyptian taskmasters.

Exodus 16:2-3. This is just two-and-a-half months after being delivered from their slavery in Egypt. We're told, verse 2, "Then the whole congregation of the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness. And the children of Israel said to them [Listen to this] "Oh, that we had died by the hand of the Lord in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the pots of meat and when we ate bread to the full! For you have brought us out into this wilderness to kill this whole assembly with hunger."

At least in Egypt we could depend on them to feed us! Yeah, but you were being held hostage! Yeah, but they ordered in pizza that one day, remember? Is that too much? I'm just trying to help you connect the dots here. They were hungry. At least our captors fed us! We really appreciated their lifting of restrictions and kind of giving us a little bit of freedom in ordering pizza or letting us go out to a restaurant and eat.

Okay, I'm going to leave that when there with you and the Holy Spirit.

Oh, this is just one part. No, I am trying to establish a principle here concerning the aforementioned Stockholm Syndrome.

Numbers 14:3-4, and by the way, for those of you who know the Bible, this is just a fraction of all of the accounts in Scripture when the Israelites complained

against God, against Moses and, and wanted to go back into slavery. They wanted to go back into bondage. They wanted to go back into that bank vault because at least there they had something to eat. They are out of the wilderness. There is no food.

And here's is God going I'll provide food. Watch Me now.

No, we don't... and then God does it; the manna is there every day without fail, and then what happens?

We want meat to eat! They fed us meat in Egypt. You know prime rib. Are you hungry?

So verse 3, Numbers 14, "Why has the Lord [Listen to this] brought us to this land to fall by the sword, that our wives and children should become victims? Would it not be better for us to return to Egypt?" So they said to one another, "Let us select a leader and return to Egypt."

What? I realize that it was not known as Stockholm Syndrome then, but it sure seems to be textbook as it relates to the world now. The world today has developed a bond with and a dependence on the Egypt of this world, and it's come as a result of the abuse and the need to cooperate for survival. That cooperation supersedes the hatred for those that perpetrated this to begin with.

In fact, what comes packaged with this bond and dependence is a defensiveness - we started up our own legal defense fund. And we're so quick to defend the narrative of this world.

Yeah, I mean they imposed harsh restrictions on us but there were those acts of kindness where they just kind of let up and hey, I don't have to be injected to

go to a restaurant now or get on a plane now. So thank you, thank you. You're so kind, so grateful.

Well, this brings me full circle to Stockholm Syndrome and how it eerily and prophetically describes exactly what's happening today. If you'll kindly allow me to, I want to expound on this more for the remainder of our time together today so we will go ahead at this time and end the live stream on YouTube and Facebook.

So I want to approach this by asking a series of specific questions that I think all of us would do well to consider in this regard. And this is kind of maybe a litmus test of sorts, for lack of a better description, or a test to diagnose whether or not we have the Stockholm Syndrome.

First, and I want you to think through these questions and please have ears to hear, okay?

Are we looking to a leader for our freedoms and liberties under the banner of them saving us from that which they themselves created?

Second, are we grateful to the perpetrators of this evil, and it is evil, for the temporary relief from restrictions, and as such their imposed threats? Again, the physical and psychological threat to our very survival.

Third, am I full of anxiety, confused, stressed, fearful, and depressed because of COVID and the abuse and torture that it continues to inflict? Yeah, we got a little bit of a reprieve, a little bit of a respite. Oh, perfect; enjoy it.

Fourth, have my feelings changed as a result of the abuse and torture at the hands of those responsible for this attendant genocide? And for and finally and perhaps more importantly, and I really want you to think through this one.

Have I developed a defensive and combative attitude towards anyone who dares speak truth to me in love? Let me ask the same question in a different way. Am I defending the perpetrators?

So someone comes to me and says hey, you know you are being held hostage, right? You know that you're in bondage, right? You know that they are trying to control you, right? And you pull your mask down and start defending them.

And all anyone has to do - I mean how dare they because they love you, that's how dare they. We don't just speak the truth in love, we speak the truth because of love.

Think about it the parenting relationship. You love your children. I mean if you didn't love them, you wouldn't care. I mean go ahead.

No, I love you so much, I have to say something. This path that you are on, oh, it may feel right.

How can something that feels so good be so wrong?

It is the way of death. You're deceived. And I love you enough to put our relationship and friendship in jeopardy and tell you the truth because the wounds of a friend can be trusted but an enemy multiplies kisses.

By the way, I just thought of this and probably should mention it. This Thursday 7:00, we're in Jeremiah, right, midweek going to the Bible? Two chapters, Lord willing, this week, *Chapter 27 and 28*.

And it's so interesting because in *Chapter 27 of Jeremiah*, four times, no less than four times we read, "They prophesied lies." They prophesied a lie, four times. Then you get to *Chapter 28*, and we read, "They make people trust in a lie."

Okay, wow! That could've been - that's what I love about God's Word, right?

No matter where you're at in God's Word is where you're at in your life because God's Word is active and alive and sharper than any two-edged sword, able to cut, surgically. You're believing a lie. You been deceived. I'm telling you the truth and you're defensive.

Hmm, why are you defending the very perpetrators of the evil in which you are now suffering? Why are you defending the narrative? Have you been so brainwashed? You know there is a difference between being brainwashed and having - washing your brain?

Yeah, I know, Pastor, you lost me a long time ago.

But hey, think about this. The washing, the renewing of your mind with the Word of God, the water of the Word of God. Don't be conformed to this world Egypt, this world, but be transformed how? By the renewing of your mind, how? By the renewing of your mind, by the water of the Word of God. We've been brainwashed. We need to have now a washing of our brains, a renewing of our minds. That's *Romans 12:1-2*, by the way.

When we were going to Romans verse-by-verse, I still after teaching the same passage twice, I had to go back the second week and say you know what? There's more here. We can't go to *verse 3* yet.

We spent a couple of weeks in *verses 1-2 of Romans 12* and even after that I'd like I still don't get it. There's so much more here about the renewing of your mind because the battleground is in your mind. Mind control, brainwashing, programming. They programmed us. That's why it's called programs, by the way, on channels [Spooky music]

We talked about that. Hollywood - Holly - it's even worse than that. It's a deception. It's a lie. And why are you getting so defensive? I'm telling you the truth, and you're getting all defensive? You're defending the captor? You're the captive. Your defending Egypt?

Do you remember, apparently, you have selective memory. Because this same Egypt that I guess gave you a buffet meal one day with leeks and onions on the side in a tray I guess maybe they did that but you're not remembering that is the same Egypt that also made you get your own straw and keep the same quota of bricks.

You also seem to have forgotten that is the same Egypt that abused you and beat you and tortured you and tormented you. Why are you defending them?

Why are you setting up a legal defense for them?

I got to keep going here. Let me share with you the genesis of this update today. About three weeks ago I'm just you know in my time with the Lord and I'm in the word and I'm in prayer and I just remembered the Stockholm Syndrome. I remembered reading about it, doing some research on it. And so I decided just to kind of refresh my memory. I kind of knew a little bit about what it was about but I knew there was something there.

So I started doing some research, and I put some notes in my file and saved it in a file that I call "need more information file" You know which one I'm talking about, the file you put more information in, and I might come back to that.

Well, I did that. And actually, I had a pretty good amount of notes on Stockholm Syndrome. I thought hmm, the sounds very familiar, Stockholm Syndrome. So last week I'm talking with a dear pastor friend of mine on the phone.

And in the course of our conversation which was long overdue, he says to me, "JD it's like Stockholm Syndrome." I'm like, that's it, boom! I think they have a word for it. It's called confirmation.

So we kind of went back-and-forth, and I ran out of time. I had a staff meeting to get to so I just texted him and said, hey, can you just kind of expound on that? Because I was thinking the same exact thing. And I'd like to hear more about what you have to say, so he did. And he's given me permission to share some of what he wrote in regards to Stockholm Syndrome and the COVID abuse and torture.

He says, "I noticed that people were ever so grateful when even the worst abuses were only mildly curtailed. The population in Hawaii who were severely abused mentally, physically, and emotionally seemed to celebrate their captors for the most minor concessions. But it was a one-way ratchet, ever tightening and never substantially loosening. Our people were the battered wife in an abusive marriage.

If our population were an abused spouse, she could have said, "He won't let me go to work or see my friends or go outside, but it's my fault. I shouldn't have gotten sick. I should've known better, so I'm thankful that he hasn't beaten me in a couple of days." The similarities are uncanny once the metaphor becomes clear.

Why would anyone stay in such a relationship? Battered wife syndrome? Stockholm Syndrome?

Unfortunately, there is another side to the Stockholm Syndrome, that of the perpetrators. The victims become subservient, but the criminals become

emboldened. [Stockholm Syndrome] was a perverted bond that had formed around the dehumanizing abuse they'd endured.

The victims identified and empathized with their abusers, even protecting them, and in our cases, [Listen] continued to vote for them."

I could close in prayer now, and we would be good right? I won't. You're not getting off that easy.

That got me by the way I just have to say. In a separate text message, this pastor friend of mine wrote the following, which in a way took the proverbial words right out of my mouth.

Quote, "Denial of the diabolical events and abuse surrounding the COVID operation has placed us, speaking of him and I, whose eyes are open in a wholly different camp.

I find it nearly impossible to be in fellowship with those ministers who refuse to see things as they truly are. We have resisted the initial forays into transhumanism while others, including pastors, have embraced 'the new normal,' the beginning of it anyway.

Speaking to pastors who naively move along like its church in 2018 is an exercise in madness to me. Bombs are falling yet they refuse to see that we are in a war. Real fellowship in such times becomes rare and sweet. Thanks for being awake and alive!"

I could probably count on one hand the number of pastors that I could have this kind of dialogue with, by the way, sadly. Well, over the last few weeks as you probably noticed, I don't know how you couldn't, the Prophecy Updates

have been intense, and the common denominator has been that of lies and deception as really the main sign of the end.

Did you catch that? It's not earthquakes which, by the way, are increasing. It's not famines which, by the way, is happening and increasing. It's not wars and rumors or threats of war which, by the way, are happening and increasing. It's not pestilences and nations rising against nation and kingdom against kingdom, though all of that is happening and increasing like birth pains and greater frequency and intensity.

The one sign is deception, deception. Let no man deceive you. Do not be deceived. 2 Thessalonians 2, perhaps the most powerful prophetic passage in this regard. The Apostle Paul, by the Holy Spirit, actually with specificity details in great detail the chronology of the events.

First, the rapture has to happen. That's *verse 3*. The departure, spiritual departure. It's not a departing from the faith. That's later. It's the rapture, the physical departure. That comes first. *2 Thessalonians 2:3*.

Then the Antichrist is revealed, that man of sin. And here's the thing about this man of sin. He's going to do these lying, lying, lying signs and wonders. Wow! Did you see that? Wow! Jesus of that said that were those days not shortened, speaking of the 7-year tribulation, even the very elect would be deceived.

And furthermore, if those days weren't shortened, no flesh would survive. So deception, he's going to deceive. And it's going to be, get this, it's incredible, for lack of a better word. If you got a better word, let me know. But incredible because it's God Himself who sends this powerful delusion, the strong deception.

Why does He do that? That doesn't sound right. It doesn't seem fair.

No, they've already made up their mind. They've already rejected the truth.

Who's the truth?

Jesus! So because they rejected the truth and by the way, He's the truth, not a truth. He's the way, the truth, and the life, and no one goes to the Father except through Him. So they've rejected the truth. Now they've open themselves up to the lie. And they're going to believe the lie, this powerful delusion. But God.

"You meant this for evil, but God meant it for good for the salvation of many this day." Because that is exactly what is going to happen with Israel one day.

Now I want to again just bear with me here because I want to try to wrap it up but not before making this very important connection to deception. Deception as a catalyst for salvation.

Wait? What do you mean?

Well, in the 7-year tribulation the Jewish nation will come to salvation. Do you know when? When they realize that they've believed the lie, the false Messiah, that they've been deceived. It was a deception. And is deception, the false, the lie will be the catalyst that brings them to the truth, Jesus.

And for the second three-and-a-half years of the 7-year tribulation, God is going to protect His people who have now come to their true Messiah, Jesus the Christ.

And then at the Second Coming which, by the way, this is why the enemy from the very beginning has tried to exterminate, annihilate, eliminate, terminate, all the "ates," the Jewish people. See Jesus had to come from that bloodline, if I can say it like that.

So if he can somehow corrupt the bloodline, make it impure, alter the DNA, he can thwart the First Coming, didn't work. He tried starting with Cain and Abel to thwart the seed of the woman, but it came through not Abel but Seth.

And when that failed all throughout history, go to the Old Testament, in fact we were just talking about Pharaoh in Egypt. All of the Hebrew male boys were cast into the Nile to their certain death to eliminate the Hebrews. That was demonic. That was Satan trying to eliminate the Jewish people to exterminate the seed of the woman that would come from this people, this bloodline. Save Moses who was a deliver, a type of Christ.

Fast-forward to one of my favorite books and all the Bible which all of the books are my favorite books in all the Bible. But Esther, we talked a little bit about this on Thursday night. Haman, demon-possessed, get the king to issue an edict to exterminate and annihilate and terminate all of the Jews. Mordecai, Esther, "for such a time as this." And by the way, "If you don't do this, deliverance will come from another," but Haman was demon-possessed in the efforts to eliminate God's people, in that bloodline so the Messiah could not come. And so when one realizes wait a minute, [sigh] Oh, I see what that pizza was about. Okay, I won't use that one anymore.

Oh, you deceived me, and I defended you? You perpetrated this. You did this!

And I was deceived. I had an e-mail or comment last week, and this precious sister in Christ said, man, Pastor JD, just wow, I was so deceived!

Not anymore!

She said it has brought me, coming to that realization has brought me so close

to Jesus. I'm back in His word now like never before! That's the point! That's

the point.

Okay, now dare I say that we are closer to this day today than any can possibly

realize? And it's evidenced by this United Nations news report on Thursday.

Did you hear about this? Unprecedented! That's an understatement,

unprecedented.

Israeli Prime Minister Lapid, I guess until they can find a Prime Minister who

can form a government and keep a government for the fifth time - don't you

find that interesting? S

o Lapid, acting Prime Minister, I guess, is now lo and behold backing the two-

state solution, unprecedented! For those of you that have been a part of the

ministry or part of the Prophecy Updates, you know, I hope you know, if you

don't know, you need to know, and this is the truth. I'm speaking the truth to

you. That the two-state solution is Hitler's final solution repackaged.

What was the final solution?

What is the two-state solution?

Now listen, if you're new, that's okay. 1 Thessalonians 5:3, spoiler alert, "While they are saying peace and security, sudden destruction [Sudden destruction, that's destruction that comes suddenly - I know it's deeply profound] sudden destruction comes upon them as a woman in labor [There's those labor pains again], and they will not escape."

That's what 1 Thessalonians 5:3 says. While they are saying - he just said it - he just said it! Peace and security, right there! Oh! Sudden, sudden destruction is coming down and we're going up. Bring it on! Right here!

Oh, come on, Pastor, you're being dramatic.

Okay, that's fine, whatever.

Speaking on a nuclear Iran, Lapid said, "The only way to prevent this, is to put a credible military threat on the table and then negotiate a longer and stronger deal with them." What? That's Daniel 9:27! Ezekiel 38!

Okay, I'm going to try to bring this in for a landing. Here's the bottom line. The delusion and deception today are a powerful prophetic indication of this being how it ends because this is the end.

We're at the end, and this is why we do these Prophecy Updates. This is why we end with the Gospel. This is why we do the ABCs of salvation, a childlike explanation of salvation. Not a formula. It's just one way to explain the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ, *1 Corinthians Chapter 15*, the first four verses. That Jesus came, and He died, for you, and me, paid in full for you and me. He was buried, He rose again on the third day, and He's coming back again one day. That's the good news, the Gospel.

The word "gospel" means good news your debt has been paid. You're free to go. "And whom the Son has set free is free indeed."

Well, the A is for admit or acknowledge. Again not a formula, please don't make this into a formula. It is just a way to explain the Gospel. And if you think about it the A is the first step because unless and until I admit and acknowledge that I have sinned, why would I be interested in a savior?

And you ask a person on the street: Hey, do you think you are going to go to Heaven? What is their answer going to be? Yeah, I'm a good person. I've never murdered anybody.

Yeah, you have. Jesus kind of raised that bar in Matthew's Gospel. You've committed murder in your heart. And if you just break one of the

commandments, you actually broke - there's only 10. You've broken like 30 of them, but whatever.

You've broken God's law. And there's a penalty for that. *Romans 3:10* says, "There is no one righteous, not even one." And *Romans 3:23* tells us why. It's because, "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." We've all been born sinners which is why we must be born-again, Jesus said, in order to enter the kingdom of Heaven.

Romans 6:23 packages the bad news first with the good news. What's the bad news? Well, is the penalty and it's the death penalty. "The wages of sin is death, but [Here's the good news] the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

That's A; here's the B, and this is central, by the way. You could argue that it's simpler than ABC. It's as simple as B, believe. "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten son that whosoever would believe in Him [Put their trust in Him for the forgiveness of sins] would not perish but have everlasting life."

Romans 10:9-10 says, "If you believe in your heart that God raised Jesus from the dead, you will be saved. And the C, lastly, is for call upon the name of the Lord, or as Romans 10:9-10 also says, "If you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. [And here's why] For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved."

And Romans 10:13 - I love this verse "All [All] who call upon the name of the Lord will be saved."

And is that not what comes as a result of believing in Him is a calling upon Him? For me that was over 40 years ago. Don't do the math. I was five. Actually, I was older.

Before we do our "But God Testimony" for today I just want to say for anyone who might be watching online or even here in this church service and you've never called upon the name of the Lord believing in Him, putting your trust in Him, I don't know what to tell you except just to tell you you're running out of time. The time is now. Today is the day of salvation.

Why would you want to put off and delay the most important decision of your life for eternal life?

Yeah, but Pastor, isn't there something else I got to do, more to this, all I've got to do is believe in Him? That's it?

Yeah, that's it. Put your trust in Him for the forgiveness of sins. Because see here's what's going to happen for everyone, every single one of us on that great and final day, we're going to stand before the Lord, and it won't matter how good of a life you've lived. It won't matter what you did, what you had. It doesn't matter. The only thing that's going to matter is what did you do with the person of Jesus Christ.

You cannot stand before the Lord in your own righteousness as filthy rags, Isaiah says - pretty graphic, by the way, in the original - and be allowed entrance into Heaven.

There's nothing you can do to earn it. It's a gift. You don't earn a gift. You don't pay for it. If you pay for it, it's not a gift. It's a purchase. He purchased the gift. You're purchased with a price. He paid the price.

Ephesians 2:8-9, lastly, "We are saved by grace through faith. It is the gift of God [Gift of God] not works, lest anyone should boast."

I implore you today. Choose you this day whom you are going to serve. And get out of Egypt, man. I don't care if they got pizza. I said I wasn't going to use pizza. Okay. Spicy ahi poke then, whatever. That's good.

All right, today's "But God Testimony" comes from Megan Haskins who writes, Hi, JD, I just finished watching your September 11th prophecy update, and I just want to thank you. Your words at the end really touched my heart and brought me to tears. It's been about almost two weeks ago that I was in one of the darkest places of my life.

My life has been filled with many highs and lows over the summer with my husband, kids, extended family, and friends. The enemy and his minions really saw the chinks in my armor lately and used a family member to make me feel like a worthless human being. I'm sure that wasn't their intention, but that was the end result.

Over the following days, I just couldn't understand why I was here anymore, what all of my striving was for when it seems I can never measure up. For the first time, I really contemplated just ending it all or just disappearing. Then there would be no more failure.

But God; He is so good. He knew what would happen that day, and He knew exactly where I needed to be at that lowest point. I was previously trying to plan a get together for our family and friends Labor Day weekend, but all my plans had fallen through, which was very frustrating.

The weekend before I had signed up for a women's breakfast at church but expected that it wouldn't work out because of our plans with family. My mom

and her husband ended up working it all out with babysitting even so her and I could go together to the breakfast. That day He comforted me through the arms of all my sisters in Christ who prayed with me. Even one sister I had never met prayed with me in the bathroom.

His presence engulfed me and deflected those thoughts that suicide or running away were the answer. They were only lies that would hurt those around me. He reminded me of who I am in Christ, loved, worthy enough, forgiven, a daughter of the King who cares for me, and even likes me!"

I like that. God likes you, by the way. No, He likes you. I know, He loves you, but He like you too. Pretty sad when you live in a day and age when "like" packs more punch than "love."

"Thank you again for your encouragement in these tough times and being the watchman who's not afraid of man, but who fears God. I love you brother, keep fighting the good fight! Megan Haskins.

Kapono, come on up. Why don't you please stand? Yes, praise the Lord.

The update that she's referring to on 9/11, at the end, I did sense a prompting from the Holy Spirit to address suicide. And every time I do, I know there is someone that is hearing or watching that has considered it. And I just want to say again today before we close, it is not the answer. Jesus is the answer. Jesus is the answer.

Please, I know despair can set in and just the hopelessness, but that's what should bring you to Jesus. Come to Jesus. Maybe for some it's come back to Jesus. You wandered and strayed. Come back. He's waiting with open arms.

And He's going to love on you. He's going to comfort you. He's going to minister to you. He's going to strengthen you, and He's going to encourage you.

Father in Heaven, thank You. How could we ever thank You enough? Oh, Jesus, Jesus, Jesus, thank You, Jesus. Lord, for anyone that might be considering suicide and the taking of their life, please right now, Lord, as only You can and are always so faithful to reveal Yourself. Lord Jesus, please save, deliver, and Jesus, come quickly please.

Please come quickly, Jesus, we pray, in Jesus' name amen.
