Mid-East Prophecy Update – August 28th, 2016

For today's prophecy update I would like to address two very significant developments that took place since our last update.
The first of which has to do with Turkey moving into Syria and the second has to do with the US related to both Iran and Russia.

- It's important to note that all this is happening amidst the backdrop of terrorist attacks, earthquakes and everything in between.

As I watched the breaking news unfold about the earthquake in Italy, it once again reminded me of the increasing birth pains.
One of my go to websites on this is trackingnibleprophecy.org, which lists all the prophetically significant news events each day.

- I mention this because it seems like the birth pains of earthquakes we're also seeing increasing birth pains of terrorist attacks.

Not only are terrorist attacks increasing in frequency and intensity, they too are taking place in various and diverse places throughout the world, including our beloved United States of America. On Tuesday, Fox News reported on an FBI investigation into whether the Virginia stabbings were ISIS-inspired. A Muslim terrorist by the name of Wasil Farooqui, ...attacked a man and woman at an apartment complex and both victims were seriously injured in the attack. Witnesses told authorities that Farooqui was yelling "Allah Akbar." Authorities believe that Farooqui may have been trying to behead the male victim...

Again, this is just the backdrop, as it were, to the stunning and unprecedented development concerning Turkey's ground operation into Syria. While Turkey claims this is to fight against ISIS, the truth of the matter is it's the Kurds that they're threatened by and fighting against. You'll forgive me for quoting the anti-Israel anti-Christian CNN, but on Wednesday, they published an article about the Turkish state media report about Turkey sending tanks into Syria. Before my father died in August of 1994, he told me to keep my eyes on Syria, and he said this in the context of the September 1993 Oslo Peace Accord signing on the White House lawn between Yasser Arafat and Yitzhak Rabin. I mention this because Syria was, is and will continue to be the catalyst specifically related to the fulfillment of Bible prophecy concerning Israel. As such, I would argue that the prophecy in Isaiah 17 about Damascus becoming a ruinous heap, so much so, that it becomes uninhabitable, is about to be fulfilled. When it does, I believe it will swiftly set in motion the fulfillment of other prophecies, chief of which is Ezekiel 38 and 39, and it will either be subsequently or possibly even simultaneously.

I found this BBC report yesterday even more interesting for two reasons, the first of which is that the headline reads as if the United States has to ask Russia for permission before doing anything in the Middle East. The second reason is that they report on the situation in the town of Darayya, which is about a 21-minute drive from Damascus. Here's what they had to say, "For years those living in Darayya have endured constant shelling, as well as suffering shortages of food, water and electricity. Some of those leaving said the town had become uninhabitable."

This brings us to the developments concerning Iran, who according to The Washington Times has not changed their behavior on the world stage since Obama's nuclear deal. If this weren't bad enough, to add insult to injury we learned that the US paid \$1.3 billion to Iran just two days after the cash delivery of \$400 million back in January. According to Ynet News, "The US says it paid \$1.3 billion to Iran in January from a little-known fund for resolving international disputes, two days after allowing a planeload of cash to fly to Tehran. State Department spokeswoman Elizabeth Trudeau says the US can't say more about the Jan. 19 payments because of diplomatic sensitivities. They involved 13 separate payments of \$99,999,999.99 and a final payment of about \$10 million.

All of this begs the question of what in the world is going on with the United States of America. Perhaps we need look no further to The Washington Examiner, who on Wednesday, published a Pew Report about how Americans are giving up on God and miracles. According to The Examiner, Half of Americans who have left their church no longer believe in God, leading a surge of nearly one quarter of the nation who have no affiliation with any religion, according to a new survey. Pew Research Center said Wednesday that 49 percent of what they term "nones" left their church and religion because they "don't believe." Another 20 percent said they don't like organized religion. Other reasons included "common sense" and a lack of belief in miracles. To make sure they are not detected or reported, it is a standard procedure there to alternate their meeting places every time they gather — and not do anything to attract attention. Recently, a Frank Kessler me a book, by Herbert Lockyer titled, "All the Promises of the Bible," and I'd like to share what he had to say. A woman, going by the pseudonym of "Maryam" and only identified as a resident of the Middle East in order to protect her and her family, spoke to a group of churchgoers earlier this week, telling them to "pray a different prayer." "Don't pray for the persecution to be stopped," she said ..."But pray for the Christians there, for their boldness, their encouragement, for their faith and that they can all be witnesses for God's work and for God." She spoke at the Meadow Brook Baptist Church in Gadsden, Alabama, at the behest of a group of six pastors and ministry leaders. Maryam told the worshipers about the treatment of Christians in the Middle East even before the Syrian civil war and the rise of Islamic State. ... "We are not afraid or worried that the persecution will increase. We are just feeling that this is God's time," Maryam said. "God is working perfectly now in the Middle East. Even with all these crazy stuff happening, God is really working now."
