Mid-East Prophecy Update - October 9th, 2011

- Every week, since back in 2006, we have set aside a few minutes on Sunday mornings so as to devote some time to studying Bible prophecy.
- The reason that we do this is because the Bible predicts certain specific events that will take place in the last days before the Lord returns.
- We believe that what's happening in the world today is a fulfillment of those Bible Prophecies, and that the rapture could happen at any time.
- We look primarily at events in the Middle East, specifically related to Israel because, as it's been said; "Israel is God's prophetic clock."
- For today's update, I want to talk about the intersecting dynamic of Bible prophecy and how in concert together prophecy is in harmony together.
- I believe that the geopolitical landscape in the Middle-East is changing so dramatically and rapidly because specific prophecies are intertwined.
- The drastic changes with Turkey, the increasing instability in Syria, and the pseudo solution of Palestine, will collectively fulfill Bible prophecy.
- When you add what's happening in Russia with Putin, and Iran with Ahmadinejad, you put even more pieces of the prophetic puzzle into place.
- We do err when we approach Bible prophecy with a "stand-alone" interpretation. If we do this we end up with an incomplete picture of prophecy.
- Sometimes we need to step back from the proverbial tree in order to see the bigger picture of Bible prophecy, with everything coming into play.
- I'm keenly aware of the privilege I have to teach a well taught group of Bible believers and prophecy students but, if this is new to you, that's OK.
- Perhaps painting the canvass with a broad brush will help to understand that we are witnessing the fulfillment of prophecy before our very eyes.
- Everything that we see happening in the world today, was predicted with 100% accuracy in the Bible, hundreds of years before it would begin.
- We need look no further than the impending global collapse of the world's financial markets to understand that this was prophesied to happen.
- The Bible tells us the time will come when the Anti-Christ will rule, by force, the entire world in what some believe is "The New World Order."
- The Bible foretells how this world dictator will control the new world with a one world economy, one world government, and one world religion.
- All of these prophecies and the others with them are coming together in these last days to form what I like to call; "The Perfect Prophetic Storm."
- The world's nations are against Israel, the world's economies are about to collapse, and all the world's governments are begging for a leader.
- In addition to all of this, all the world's religions are on the verge of a merge. At the risk of sounding too clever and coy, please hear me out.
- For those who have not yet heard about this, you will start hearing more of this, and it may come as a shock to you but it's called; "Chrislam."
- If this sounds like the merging together of Christianity and Islam, that's because Chrislam, is the merging together of Christianity and Islam.
- Lest you're quick to dismiss this as being on the fringe of Christianity, I'll warn you, it's already taken up residence in mainstream Christianity.
- That's why I am bringing up the intersecting dynamics of Bible prophecy. This is just one more example of how it is that everything ties together.
- I'm in the camp with those who believe that Chrislam will pave the way, along the way, with the likes of the "Emerging," or "Emergent Church."
- Furthermore, it stands to reason that everything is right on schedule as it relates to a global merging of religions, governments, and economies.
