Good morning and welcome to our Bible Prophecy Update. On Sunday mornings we have two services, the first of which is our weekly Bible Prophecy Update that we do. And then Second Service which will be livestreamed at 11:15 a.m. Hawaii time - what? Hawaii time, 11:15 - I don't know that might be Monday, wherever you're at, which is fine too.

So we're going to look at today four things that Satan doesn't want us to know when it comes to temptation in the life of a Christian. So I encourage you to join with us. We're going through verse-by-verse the Bible, and we are currently in the Book of James.

Now for those of you who are watching by way of YouTube or Facebook, we would encourage you at this time to go directly to the website JDFarag.org for the uncensored and uninterrupted entirety of today's Update. And with that, let's get started.

We got a lot to get to, so we're going to get right to it. And today I'm going to cut to the chase and get right to the bottom-line, interesting combination of metaphors.

Did you know that 'cut to the chase' comes from the old film days when they would cut out the scenes and get right to the chase scenes, which were the really exciting part of the - now for you younger people, that was in the days of film.

#### [ Laughter ]

Never mind. That's where that comes from. So were going to cut to the chase and get right to the bottom line concerning the only thing that really matters in the end.

And here's the only thing that really matters in the end, whether or not someone is saved or not. That's the bottom line. Either Jesus is my Savior, or He is not.

In other words, we are either saved or lost, regardless of who we are or who we think we are. And the day is coming when that will be the only thing that really counts.

The reason I sense that the Lord would have me go in this direction is because this is the bottom-line. The bottom-line is the person of Jesus Christ.

Let me define the bottom-line. The bottom-line is defined as the final result or the most important consideration of a situation, activity, or discussion. As such, when it comes to bible prophecy, the most important consideration or discussion that anyone can have is about Jesus.

I know this is going to sound cliché, but it's all about Jesus. And such is the case with Bible prophecy which all points to Jesus. And not only is it all about Jesus, the Spirit of prophecy is Jesus.

And this is what the Apostle John was told in the Book of Revelation. This after the fall of Babylon when all of Heaven is shouting and singing hallelujah! Shouting: It's in the Bible, so shouting. That's my story and I'm sticking with it.

Shouting and singing hallelujah, salvation, glory, and power belonging to the Lord God Almighty!

Can I draw your attention to Revelation Chapter 19, beginning in verse 6?

John is writing and he says, "And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns!"

[The Lord God Almighty reigns!]

"Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."

And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!'" And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God."

And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus.

Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus [And here it is] is the Spirit of prophecy."

Wow! This is why Satan does everything and stops at nothing to get us away from the main thing, so the main thing is no longer the main thing.

What's the main thing?

Jesus.

And you know what's sad? He's been met with an astounding measure of success in this regard in the sense that everyone is arguing with everyone about everything.

And what's the end result or bottom-line, if you will?
Well, arguing about everything with everyone, Jesus doesn't get to anyone.

I hope you don't tire of me saying this, but the purpose of these Prophecy Updates is to get Jesus to people and people to Jesus.

And one of the best ways to do that is by way of Bible prophecy, which spoiler alert, all of the prophecy in the Bible points to the person of Jesus Christ.

All the prophecy in the Old Testament points to and is about Jesus and His First Coming. Then you fast-forward to the New Testament Bible prophecy, it's all about Jesus. He's coming again. First, He's coming to rapture His church.

Amen, okay yeah!

[ Applause ]

By the way, we're going to be talking more about that today too. I know we never talk about that, but we're going to talk about that. But then seven years, at the end of the 7-year tribulation, He's coming back again, and that's what all Bible prophecy is about.

That's why it is again that Bible prophecy is one of the best ways when it comes to this, and here's why.

People today are asking questions, right? They're asking questions about everything that's happening in the world. And as believers in Jesus and followers of Jesus, we have the answer. We have the answer that they are looking for.

What are they looking for?

Bottom-line: They're looking for hope. They're looking for hope.

The Apostle Peter in his first epistle, Chapter 3:15, "But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone [And this is important, don't miss it] who asks.

Be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect."

Now you'll forgive me for the bluntness with which I say this, but I say it nonetheless. If no one asks you about the hope you have, maybe it's because you have no hope.

Or your hope is in someone or something else other than Jesus. And if that's the reason, well, that would explain why they don't ask you. I mean, no need because you're just like them. There's nothing peculiar about you, nothing different about you.

They're not going to ask you if they don't see in you something that they want to have that you have: Hope which they need and want.

In other words, no one's going to ask you about the hope you have if it's the same hope they have, which is that of placing one's hope in this world and the things of this world.

The Apostle John in his first epistle Chapter 2 beginning in verse 15, you know this well. "Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them."

That's pretty strong. It needs to be and here's why.

"For everything in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life comes not from the Father, but from the world. The world and its desires pass away."

Dare I say the world is dying. There's no hope for this world. It's hopeless. The world is dying. "But whoever does the will of God lives forever."

Notice the contrast. "The world is dying, but whoever does the will of God lives forever." Death. Life.

If you'll kindly allow me to, I'd like to provide examples of how it is that we can give to everyone an answer of the hope

that we have in Jesus. And at this time, we'll go ahead and end the livestream on YouTube and Facebook.

So what follows in no particular order are what I'll affectionately refer to as "The Big Three" in terms of giving the bottom-line answer of Jesus to everyone as our only hope, not just the blessed hope of His soon appearing. It's our only hope. This is our only hope.

We'll start with the questions being asked about what's going on in the Middle East, specifically concerning Russia's invasion of Ukraine. A lot of people asking a lot of questions, by the way.

Now while there is indirectly Bible prophecy about Ukraine, first and foremost, we need to pray for the people of Ukraine, in particular this prayer request we received last night.

It comes from Jennifer Heinemann who writes, "Pastor Farag, I am in desperate need of prayer. My husband and I have been in the process of adopting our daughters (Vika and Oksana) from Ukraine. They were evacuated from their orphanage and have made it L'viv.

We are praying they can be released to cross the border into Poland. The orphanage chaperone that accompanied the children is afraid that she will be held accountable for removing them from Ukraine.

The local pastor tried talking to her, but she is scared, rightfully so; however, these children need to get to safety. My husband and our ministry group Legacy Refuge are trying to get to Poland (we are not Vaxxed) to find a way to get our girls and other children out of Ukraine, and into safety.

Can you PLEASE pray our children? Thank you, Jennifer."
Let's do that right now. Will you join with me please?

Father in Heaven, we cry out unto You because You always hearken unto the voice of our cry. Lord, for the people of Ukraine, we want to pray specifically for their safety and more importantly, their salvation. That's what happening there right now would be that which would lead many to You, Jesus, in this last hour.

Lord, for Jennifer and her plea for prayer concerning these two precious girls and the many other children like them, God, oh, how You love the little children.

Please Lord, as only You can, would you move Your mighty hand?

Make a way where there is no way and miraculously provide a

way? Get them to safety.

And Lord, we're going to, with great anticipation, look for a good report to come because we prayed. And so Lord, thank You in advance for what You're going to do.

Thank You for this precious couple, their ministry to children, these precious children. Lord, thank You, thank You for prayer. Thank You that we can come to You and pray. And thank You that we can petition Your thrown in prayer and know that when we do, You hear. You hear every prayer, and You answer every prayer.

Lord, thank You, in Jesus' name, amen.

Now for the questions concerning Russia's invasion of Ukraine, the way I answer this for people is - and the rule of thumb here, by the way, is to keep it simple, okay?

I simply say that - and it's very generic, I know, but everything - and by the way, everything that's happening in the Middle East today was foretold in the Bible.

So then if they, depending on who you're talking to, if they follow up with more questions and want more specificity, then

it's incumbent upon us to have the Scriptures at the ready, and not just refer to them, but if possible, actually read it to them.

Now you don't have to go into a whole, you know, sermon or dissertation, but it can be as simple as going to Ezekiel 38 in your Bible, on your phone, which is where your Bible is, right? It's okay, it's all right, whatever.

I still like the pages, the smell too and the feel too, I like the feel.

So anyway go to your phone. That's fine if you want. And turn to the page and show them in the Bible. True story: Many years ago I was on the mainland - this is long before I got into the ministry.

And I had a business and had a guy in my car that we were going to an auction. He was in the passenger seat. I'm driving and started talking with him about the Lord. And so he started asking questions, good questions too, by the way.

And so I started, you know, kind of doing what I do when I do that thing I do, which you do it too, so... You know, you just start rattling it off.

And you know, well, it says that - and he said, No, no stop, show me.

Oh? Well, I have my sword, I mean, Bible in my pocket there in the driver's door, so I pulled over and I opened up my Bible and I started showing him in the Bible where it said that - that's the Word of God.

And Isaiah the prophet writes, the Lord declares through Isaiah, "My Word will not return unto Me void."

Well, as the Lord would have it, course many years later after we moved here, I heard that he came to a saving knowledge of

Jesus Christ. I had the privilege of watering; somebody else got to harvest. That's all right, that's okay. He got saved.

My point, what's my point? My point is show them. Don't just tell them, show them. And this is where you need to study to show yourself approved, rightly dividing the Word so you're not embarrassed when they say hey, can you show me that in the Bible?

Um, let me go to the index here. Where was that?

That's where the phone, I guess, comes in because you can search where it says that.

Oh, it's right here. I knew that.

No, you didn't.

Um, rightly divide the word and be at the ready. Ezekiel 38, this alliance of nations that invades Israel. Verse 13, specific to Saudi Arabia that only protest, not involved in the invasion. And maybe even talk with them a little bit about why. Because it's to take what Israel has.

What does Israel have?

They have natural resources.

What are the natural resources?

Natural gas.

And that is where the Ukraine comes into the picture. Take them to Isaiah 17:1 concerning Damascus, Syria. It's just one verse, Isaiah 17, and is a prophecy about the destruction of Damascus, so much so that it's uninhabitable.

And by the way, while you are at it, take them to Zechariah  $12.\ 0$ 

kay, now I have to confess; this is many years ago. in the front of my Bible I have cheat notes right here, not for Bible

prophecy because well, as you might imagine, I kind of know those verses, but early on when I wanted to share the Gospel with somebody, I had the verses here. So it made me look really smart, like I really knew my Bible, right?

But there's nothing wrong with that. Just have your notes there and show them in the Bible. But have the verses at the ready because that's the Word of God, that's the Word of God.

Don't get preachy. Don't get preachy, like me.

Oh, one more thing: Don't tell them something like this, "Well, that's what my pastor said." Don't do that!

#### [ Laughter ]

You need to know not only what you believe but why you believe what you believe, and you should be able to go to the Word of God and show them where it is, right?

#### [ Applause ]

Oh, good now I'm off the hook. By the way I'm already in enough trouble with a lot of people, so quit using my name on stuff like that.

But again, depending on the individual, and this requires discernment.

And here's something I do that works for me. I'm in a conversation with someone, and I'm like okay, Lord, I need wisdom, kind of like a Nehemiah, just a real quick, doesn't have to be a, you know, fancy Nancy prayer. It can just be a couple of words: Help, Jesus! Help me! Help, Lord! Bring to my remembrance what I need to speak.

Because you see, the Holy Spirit knows the heart of the person you're talking to. And how do you know that the Lord might not have a word of knowledge, a word of wisdom which is a gift of the Holy Spirit?

And maybe when I say this, some of you will recall a time when this happened to you.

You're sharing the Lord with someone, and you just say, Lord, help me with the right answers.

And don't get into a long debate. Get to Jesus as quickly as you can.

Now if they want to take you down this road of: Well, can God make a rock so big that He can't lift it? Get back to Jesus.

And oh, here's another thing. Make sure you have the discernment to know whether or not they're looking for an answer or an argument.

If they're looking for an argument, don't waste your time please. Don't waste your time. If they're looking for an answer, then you need to give to them that answer of the hope of what you have.

But how many times have you been in a conversation with somebody, and the Lord just put something on your heart and sometimes it's like no way, that can't be the Holy Spirit. But before you know it, you're saying it.

And you're going wow, this is really good!

It's not you; that's the Holy Spirit. And you'll speak that word to them only to find out that afterwards, they're going to say, How did you know that?

Oh, the Holy Spirit knew. The Holy Spirit knew that. And He'll give you that word that is tailored to and perfectly fitly spoken to them right where they're at. So give the Holy Spirit the elbowroom room when you're answering people.

And the reason I emphasize 1 Peter is because they need to ask because it's when they ask, that's when you answer. Let them ask when they ask.

Don't you find it interesting that Peter doesn't say you need to find somebody and ask them and then give them the answer?

No, they have to ask because if they're asking you about this, they genuinely want to know. And they genuinely want to know why it is that you're not freaking out like everybody else they know.

You know it seems to me that when I was a kid, I heard something about the Middle East, the big Bear in the north and Israel. Is that in the Bible?

Oh, I'm so glad you asked, right here. It's exactly what we're told would happen.

You know how many people have come to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ because the Bible prophecy? So be at the ready with an answer.

And one last time on this, and I won't keep harping on this, but it is important. There first has to be that hope in us; otherwise, they're not going to ask.

They have to see there's just something different about you. I mean, everything that's happening in the world, it's so confusing, it's so chaotic. I just cannot wrap my mind around everything that is happening in the world.

But then I look - and they're watching you, by the way. The Apostle Paul says we are living epistles, we're living letters. They're reading the letters of our life.

And as they do, here's what they want to read, here's what they want to see in us before they ask us. They want to see: Wow, is he the real deal?

He's so different. He has this joy, but he's going through the same thing I'm going through. He has this peace about him, but he's going through the same thing I'm going through, and

actually truth be made known, it's actually worse what he's going through than what I'm going through, and yet he has this peace, he has this joy, he has hope. I want me some of that! I want what you got! Because you've got something that I need!

And that something is hope. And we can give it to them.

Here's why I sleep well at night, in fact, too well, I slept in. But I just - I know how it ends. And by the way, this is why sometimes I get giddy, which freaks people out, by the way.

This is why I'm excited. This is exciting, not terrifying to me because I know what this means. And what this means is Jesus is coming! And He's going to take us out of this world.

That's my hope, and you can have that hope too!

Okay, am I yelling? I can because it says in Revelation 'shouting,' so I'm shouting.

You know, I'm going to reference a couple of prior updates. Last week's update, actually, we went into some detail on this invasion of Israel and the significance of Russia and Ukraine. Well, all of these, by the way, tie together.

The second one has to do with what's happening to and with the economy globally, especially with this global crisis that they have created. The shelves are getting emptier.

Have you noticed?

The prices are getting higher. I haven't filled up my car with gas in probably a week. I don't drive much, I don't get out much, but is it over \$5 here yet?

[Comment off microphone]

Really? \$5.19?

[Comment off microphone]

(Grimacing) Anyway... how about the price of food? Um, did you know that we're told that that would happen in the Bible?

Really?

Yeah.

Well, I have been hearing a lot about inflation.

Oh, Revelation Chapter 6. You ain't seen nothing yet. Because that's exactly what we're told in the Book of Revelation will happen during the 7-year tribulation.

So how do you answer someone who asks, Why are you like so - it actually makes me sick that you're so happy and I'm so worried and fearful about my financial future, and you just seem to be just, you know, praising the Lord. You're paying the same price at the pump that I am, so what are you so happy about?

Because I know that this is one of many signs of just how close we are.

So what I do and, again, this is just how I answer the question when asked: Bible prophecy with detail, by the way, in the Book of Revelation describes a cashless economy.

And so what we're witnessing right now is actually what the Bible said we would be witnessing at the time of the end and specifically as it relates to this controlled demolition - I use those words for a reason - of the current economy.

Because you see, you cannot introduce this digital, cashless economy until you first destroy the current economy. So the whole supply chain thing, the whole price of a barrel of oil thing, the whole empty shelf thing, the whole a dollar is now worth .00001 cent thing that's not too far off by the way - it's all foretold in Scripture.

The Update I will refer you to on this one was actually a little over a year ago now, back on December 6 of 2020, actually, yeah, about a year ago, little over a year ago.

It is titled "The Great Setup" because that is what it is. It's the great set up for the great reset. This is all planned, it's been planned for many decades, and it is now beginning to come to pass.

Well, this ties in to this last one and it is a biggie, and we've got to talk about it. Um, it has to do with the injection and whether or not this is the mark of the beast.

Okay, please, please, I'm going to say this as simply and as clearly as I possibly can.

Is this the mark of the beast?

No, not yet.

I'm going to do this again.

Is the injection currently the mark of the beast?

No, not yet.

However, in Revelation 13, we're told that there will be this mark, a tattoo-like mark that everyone will need to have in order to buy or sell.

I do need to address this parenthetically to the question of believers who have been injected losing their salvation. That is absurd. The answer is absolutely not. If you're born-again, you cannot be un-born again.

Okay, now if this is not the mark of the beast, how do you get there and say that it will become the mark of the beast? By the way, don't shout out or raise your hands, but - this is a rhetorical question - aren't you being asked about this?

Isn't there something in the Bible about this? I heard something about this being the mark of the beast?

Well, you need to have an answer for that, especially for this. You don't have to be an expert on the Middle East, and by the way, I don't fancy myself or posture myself - in fact, I don't like it when people say, you know, you're a prophecy expert.

I am like, where? Really?

So I have to be a prophecy expert?

No, I don't need to be a prophecy expert. I don't need to be an expert on the Middle East. I just need to know the Word of God.

And I don't need to be an expert, a medical expert - by the way, I saw a very humorous meme. I don't I hope you don't mind me inserting it here for little bit of levity. But I saw this meme; the first picture shows this guy, and it says, "I used to be a medical expert."

And then down below, it shows him looking at a map of the Middle East.

"Now I am a Middle East expert."

Everybody's an expert.

Really? Anyway, I guess you didn't find that very funny. I sure did. I thought was very humorous. Everybody's got - well, let me say it like this.

Okay, here we go, just bear with me. Opinions, you know, from the experts, they're like armpits. Okay, good, you know where I'm going. We all got a couple, and they stink. So I will just leave it at that.

But you're being asked about this, right?

Well, we have the answer, and if you'll just kind of hang in there with me, I will give you as much information as I possibly can.

We've done numerous updates on this that would take hours to view, so I'll just give you the bottom line by way of an overview. And in so doing, I hope to provide you and equip you with the biblical answers as to why it is that this so-called vaccine will become the mark of the beast according to the Book of Revelation during the 7-year tribulation.

I'm going to proceed with the presupposition that you know Revelation Chapter 13:16-18 about he will cause, force all, great, small, rich, poor to receive a mark in - there's a - I'll come back. Well, I might as well just do it now and get it over with.

Oh, my goodness - in, on, both.

Well, my Bible says it's "in." And you keep saying it's "on." It's both. It's put on you and gets in you.

Okay, I feel better now. I had to get that off my chest.

So there's going to be this mark that all will be forced, caused to take in order to buy and sell, and this mark will be on, in, in, on the right hand or the forehead. And it's the mark of the beast.

Now here's the question: How does a so-called vaccine injected into one's arm become this mark?

Well, let me explain.

Let me start with Revelation chapter 18:23. This is what gives us the connection to a so-called vaccine from big Pharma. This is a prophecy speaking of Babylon the Great.

John writes by the Spirit, "The light of a lamp shall not shine in you anymore, and the voice of bridegroom and bride

shall not be heard in you anymore. For your merchants were the great men of the earth, for by your sorcery [Hang on to that word] all the nations were deceived." By sorcery.

Revelation 9:21, "And they did not repent of their murders or their [Here it is again] sorceries or their sexual immorality or their thefts."

Okay, now hang in there with me. Let's take a closer look and examination of two words, the word "mark" in Revelation 13:16-18 and the word "sorceries" in 18:23 and 9:21.

First, the word "mark." The word "mark" in the original language of the Greek New Testament is "Charagma" and it's from the root word "charax," and carries with it the idea of a stamp, tattoo, stake, or palisade. Hang onto that.

The word "sorcery," you know this. I hope you do; if you don't, you need to. It's the Greek word "pharmakeion" where we get our English word for "pharmacy" and "pharmaceutical," and carries with it the idea of a magic potion and even poisonous injections.

They would actually use this in ritual witchcraft and satanic magic arts. And they would use snake fangs, which are hollow, by the way, to inject this poisonous potion in their sorceries.

Enter the aforementioned "mark." Tattoo, sharp palisade. You know what a palisade is? It is a sharp point, like needles that are stamped on the forehand or the forehead delivering this poisonous potion by way of an injection, not in the arm, but as pictured here.

Actually, they deleted this, by the way. It shows this photo saying the details from the Greek term for mark, stamp, as in the mark of the beast when considered with today's technology, reveal both the shocking accuracy of Scripture as well as the

way the coming infamous, soul-damning mark of the beast will be. It's these palisades, these stakes, these needles.

January 6 of last year BBC News published an article about the development of the world's first vaccine smart patch, pictured here, by the way, which is a disposable device using microneedles, palisades, to both administer the vaccine and [Listen to this] monitor its efficacy by measuring the body's immune response.

These smart patches, millimeter-long micro-needles made from polycarbonate or silicon will penetrate the skin to administer a vaccine and held in place with a strap or tape. It will simultaneously measure a patient's inflammatory response to the vaccination [That alone]

In other words, they're anticipating an inflammatory response, but... by monitoring bio-markers in the skin. The device is then scanned.

Oh, wait! It's scanned? Oh, you mean like when I go to the bank, and they scan my forehead or my...

Yeah, like that.

Providing a data reading that can be used to understand the efficacy of the vaccine and the body's response to it.

Now to the question of how this technology will be powered, this is where it gets really interesting.

It's powered by way of a Quantum Dot Tattoo using Luciferase. In other words, this will be the power source, and it will be used to digitally scan the information chiefly for vaccination verification.

Pictured here is the NIH National Center for Biotechnology
Information webpage about, "Creating self-illuminating quantum dot conjugates."

Let me quote from the abstract. By the way are you getting this? Because when they ask you about this, you go, Okay, so...

Do you see this picture here? Maybe the guys could put it back up for the online viewers. Look at this thing.

It's a stamp, a tattoo with palisades that is on and then in the skin, and then it's scanned.

Back in April of 2020, Carnegie Mellon University published a report about "CMU having developed micro-needle patches which

contain hundreds of tiny needles clustered on a miniature patch about the size of the contact lens.

The micro-needles are made from bio-dissolvable sugar-like natural materials, and the vaccine *[or* 

drug/sorcery/potion/poison] is delivered and mixed with this
water-soluble material when fabricating the micro-needles.

Pictured here is a Band-Aid looking patch containing the micro-needles. Here's a close-up of the other side. There's those palisades.

Here's another view of the side that goes in and on the skin. And from that video, here's a screenshot of a woman as she places it on her forehand.

What's interesting about this video, by the way, this is from 2017, almost five years ago now. And what's interesting is the emphasis on the convenience of self-administering a vaccine in the form of a patch as opposed to an injection.

Listen to a couple of these quotes. "In the US, only 40% of adults get the flu shot [2017].

Having an option of a flu vaccine that could be selfadministered and well-tolerated could very much increase coverage of this important vaccine in the population.

So this is the first time that we been able to put a microneedle patch into a person, give a vaccine, and find out what
happens. Our vision for this really is that someday we hope
