## Mid-East Prophecy Update - November 25th, 2012

- For today's prophecy update, I'll address the prophetic significance of the ceasefire on Wednesday, between Israel and Hamas in Gaza.
- This wasn't really between Israel and Hamas, it was between Israel and Iran, vis-à-vis Hamas to the South, and Hezbollah to the North.
- We'll need to tackle that topic in a subsequent prophecy update, so suffice it to say for now anyway, there is a ceasefire, for now anyway.
- Be that as it may, there have been some interesting dynamics that have come out of this recent war with Israel, and attack against Israel.
- It's for this reason, among others, that I sense this time around, things are very different, and the likes of which we've never seen before.
- What I mean by that is this may seemingly have been a prelude to a much bigger war, on a much larger scale in the Middle East yet future.
- Consider these headlines, most of which were from Thanksgiving, on Thursday, which was the first official day after the tentative ceasefire.

- This begs the question of how long last weeks ceasefire will last, and when, not if it falls apart, will the next prophecy fulfilled be Psalm 83.
- The reason I say this is because of what nations are named and listed in this prophecy and what these enemies of Israel are now doing.
- Actually, I see Psalm 83 as a lynchpin of sorts, by virtue of how it connects other prophecies concerning Egypt Jordan Syria Lebanon, et al.
- Perhaps a revisiting of Psalm 83 at some point in the not too distant future is in order, however, for today there's a more pressing matter.
- I must confess that while I wasn't that surprised when word of a ceasefire came, I was a little surprised by how word of a ceasefire came.
- For reasons that would arguably be inexplicable, it came by way of the newly elected Muslim Brotherhood Egyptian president, of all people.
- Then, astonishingly, no less than 24 hours after the ceasefire announcement, Mursi makes a self-proclaimed power grab announcement.
- In effect, he exploits assumed capital wrought from the Gaza ceasefire to wield absolute control over Egypt posturing himself as a Pharaoh.
- What makes this so stunning, is that it can almost give us a time-line in terms of how fast things are moving concerning Egypt in Isaiah 19.
- Please turn to Isaiah 19 at this time and in the interest of time we'll do an overview of Egypt's role in Bible prophecy found in this chapter.
- The reason being is that it's become quite clear that this prophecy is being fulfilled in real-time, especially since the last time we studied it.
- It was just January of last year when Egypt's uprising began, which propelled us to sort of blow the dust of this Old Testament prophecy.
- What I'd like to do is go through six specifics found here in Isaiah 19 concerning Egypt, and in so doing, reveal how that it's happening now.
- Let me hasten to say, that while I am keenly aware I may be wrong, there is an overwhelming preponderance of evidence to the contrary.
- Here's how I get there, everything that's happened and is now happening in Egypt fits perfectly with the first four verses in Isaiah nineteen.

## 1. Egypt will experience an uprising in the form of a civil war (Isaiah 19:1-2)

- I would suggest that this began to come to pass in January of last year, and because it's not static, it continues to find its fulfillment today.

## 2. Egypt will be ruled over by a powerful and cruel master (Isaiah 19:3-4)

- I'm of the belief this began to come to pass on last week on the heels of the Gaza ceasefire, which still has experts scratching their heads.
- Notice how that verse four says that God Himself will hand the Egyptians over to the power of a cruel master. Is Mursi this cruel master?
- Also, there does seem to be a distinction drawn between the cruel master, and a fierce king. Could the fierce king be what's next for Egypt?
- That said; I truly believe that everything that happens from verse five on through to the end of the chapter is yet future for the Egyptians.
- 3. Egypt will become even more oppressed and impoverished (Isaiah 19:5-10)
- 4. Egypt will be led astray by corruption and deception (Isaiah 19:11-15)
- 5. Egypt will be in fear of Israel because of the God of Israel (Isaiah 19:16-17)
- 6. Egypt will be delivered and come to salvation in the God of Israel (Isaiah 19:18-25) (It's thought that this is fulfilled in the Millennium.)

Luke 21:28 NKJV Now when these things begin to happen, look up and lift up your heads, because your redemption draws near."

John 14:29 NIV I have told you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe.

- I'll bring today's prophecy update to a close by simply asking a simple question, do you believe that the rapture of the church is at the door?
- If so, are you ready for the Lord's return? If not, could the reason you are not ready for the Lord, be that you are not right with the Lord?
- If that's the reason, then I would like to share with you the gospel of Jesus Christ, and how you can be sure that you are ready for the Lord.
