KAPONO: Amen. Would you join me as we pray? Lord, this is the day You've made, Lord.

Rejoice and be glad in it. We give You all the praise and the glory, Lord. Lord, I pray in these

times Lord, as we worship You, we realize where everything comes from, Lord. You provide

for us above and beyond our needs, Lord, and You care for us more than any policy and

anybody in government or official places, Lord. It's You that is our source. So would we look

to You, Lord?

And would You please help us during this Prophecy Update, Lord, to understand what it is

that we have before us, Lord, that we will not be deceived, but we will be confident living

because Your Word lives in us. And so we're looking up to You, Lord. Be with Pastor JD.

Give him the strength and the courage, as You do, to do what he does, serve You, Lord. In

Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

PASTOR JD: Amen and amen. And good morning and welcome. You can be seated. So glad

you're here today. Those of you joining us online, we're so glad that you are as well. Before

we jump in, though, I have a praise report on Pastor Leitu. So the surgery on Tuesday went

well. The doctor said the heart already looks like it's functioning better. He told me, actually

just this morning that he was taken out of ICU last night. Yeah.

[Applause]

That's the Lord. He's going to start, though, the rehabilitation and physical therapy and all

that comes with that and has just kindly asked that there be no visitors. If you can just, you

know, give him and them the time they need. It's one less text to respond to, one less email

to reply to, one less phone call to call back. And so, God's got him safely in the palm of His

hands, under the shadow of His wings, and He is answering prayer, selfish prayer on my part.

Lord, keep him for me. Because I think the Lord feels sorry for me. He knows that I need

him. So I told him; I said, you can't go anywhere. If you die, I'll kill you.

[Laughter]

In love. In Jesus' name, of course.

But lastly, just thank you to all of you that have been praying and please continue to pray for

Pastor Leitu. We are really looking forward to and praying that he is able to re-tune — re-

tune — return (Chuckling) sooner than what even the doctors are saying. Again, selfish

prayer on my part.

So this is the first of two services that we have on Sunday morning. You know that by now,

most of you at least. And it is the service that we devote to the teaching on End Times by

way of these weekly Bible Prophecy Updates.

And then Second Service, a number of years ago actually, became the sermon, separate

from. And it's a verse-by-verse study through the word of God. We have made it all the way

through to the last book in the Bible, the Book of Revelation.

And today we are, Lord willing, going to finish *Chapter 16*, and our text will be *verses 17-21*

in a sermon I titled 'The Way God May Choose to Use in My Life.' I hope you like that title. It

took me a while to come up with it. In it, we're going to look at three ways, despite how

oftentimes they can be very puzzling, the ways of God, of course, not our ways that God may

choose to use in my life to wake me, to deliver me, or to save me because Father knows

best.

So that'll be Second Service. For those of you online, it'll be livestreamed 11:15 a.m. That's

Hawaii time. And those of you on YouTube and Facebook, we'd really encourage you to go

directly to the website, JDFarag.org for the Prophecy Update livestream. And with that, let's

get to it.

I realize that the title that I chose for the Update of 'The Closer We Are, The Clearer We See'

is a firm grasp of the obvious. I mean, duh! But actually it's a message of hope, especially

for those who may be weary, battle weary, losing hope. I chose the title because the closer

we are to our blessed hope of the pre-Tribulation rapture of the church, the clearer we can

now see how quickly Bible prophecy is coming to pass.

Now, this for a number of reasons, chief of which is that Daniel, you might remember, for

those that were with us on Thursday nights for our verse-by-verse study through the Book of

Daniel, Daniel is told to seal up prophecy until the end, when it's unsealed and revealed in

Revelation at the end.

For some reason, I don't think I said that right. We're at the end. So that which was

heretofore sealed up has been opened up, and now we're beginning to see more clearly how

it all fits together, how all the prophecy puzzle pieces are being put in place. If you'll kindly allow me to, I want to draw your attention to four — I limited it to four — I had more — four New Testament scriptures that speak to this for this reason.

It's for all of us, myself included, to have renewed hope, renewed faith. 1 Peter 4:7, Peter, by the Spirit, writes, "But the end of all things is at hand; therefore [And whenever you read a therefore, it's there for a reason] be serious and watchful in your prayers."

Now, why did I choose this particular verse? Well, there's many like it, but I chose it because if there was nothing to see — think this through with me — why would we need to be watchful at the time when the end of all things is at hand? Why would we be exhorted, admonished to watch and see at the time of the end, when the end of all things is at hand, if there's nothing to see?

You know, here's an illustration; it's not in my notes, so... The longer you spend in a room, let's say, and the more you observe in that room, the more you'll see. But you have to be looking and watching in order to see. And that's what the Apostle Peter is admonishing here. I chose the second one because even though we were to watch and see this side of eternity, we're still unable to see clearly. We can see clearer, not clearly.

This is what Paul wrote to the Corinthian church in his first epistle, the 13th chapter, verse 12. Listen to what he says. "For now we see in a mirror dimly." Some of your translations render it darkly, blurry. We can't see it perfectly clearly, dimly. "...but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then I shall know just as I also am known."

Translated: Right now we can see more clearly. But there's coming a time, and this is where I'm headed, when there will be no need. And that's why I chose this one. Because it speaks to faith being key to that which we hope for, and the evidence of what we cannot yet see.

Now, these are strong words, and *Hebrews 11:1* is regrettably and sadly missed. And what I mean by that is the strength with which the writer of Hebrews writes this rises to the level of paying attention to this. "Now faith [Hebrews 11:1] is the substance [It's what makes up] the things hoped for, [And this is where the strength comes in] the evidence of things not seen."

That's a courtroom word, which I'm going to kind of use. This fourth and final one is a much-needed reminder that soon and very soon, our faith and hope will give way to sight. Listen to what Paul writes to the Romans, *Chapter 8*. By the way, whenever it comes to *Romans 8*, I have to say, especially for anyone who has allowed the enemy to plant doubts about the love that God has for you, thoughts like God is angry with you, you need to spend some time and believe in *Romans 8*. It is perhaps arguably one of the most powerful passages in all of the pages of Holy Writ. I'm not trying to be melodramatic here. I just — *Romans 8* is a goto, write out of the chute.

Verse 1, "There is therefore now no condemnation [No guilt] for those that are in Christ Jesus." No shame. Well, listen to verses 24 and 25. "For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?"

Pause. Let that sink in. I hope. Well, what are you hoping for? Well, if you already have that which you were hoping for, why are you still hoping for it? Now you've already got it. That's the best I got. So you're going to have to take it, okay?

But he continues in *verse 25* and says, "But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance."

Some of your translations use the other P word. Patience. That's why I chose this particular translation. So before we go any further, I want to establish this foundation of hope. Because absent the understanding of and the establishing of this foundation of hope, what I'm going to share with you today will not have accomplished its intended end. So that was the preface, the introduction. Doing good so far, right?

Now I would like for us to focus on that which we are now seeing as, here's that word, evidence, forensic evidence, if you prefer, of just how close we really are to our blessed hope. And by the way, let me qualify this because this is another misnomer. You know, "I sure hope." No, that's not what the blessed hope is. It's a blessed assurance. It's a done deal. God said it. That settles it. It's not an "I wish, I hope, I sure hope so, I'm hoping."

No. The blessed hope, affectionately known as the pre-Tribulation rapture of the church, is our blessed assurance. We have been assured of this hope. Now, by virtue of how much

closer we are to the pre-Tribulation rapture, we can see how much clearer the Bible prophecies are even now beginning to be fulfilled.

Another illustration not in my notes — I'm on a roll. You know you can't see when you're driving, right? And you're —it's a windy road. You don't know what's around the corner. But the closer you get the more you're going to see what's around the corner. And that's the idea here. The closer we get to the pre-Tribulation rapture, the more we're beginning to see clearly how Bible prophecy, with 100% accuracy, is coming to pass. I'm going to use "breakneck speed" for a reason. You'll know why here shortly.

But what follows are the facts of the case. I'm sorry I'm taking you to court today. We're on the same side. But I want to borrow a legal metaphor. And I'd like to enter into evidence Exhibit A, exhibit B, evidence that proves not beyond any reasonable doubt, no. This evidence proves beyond any doubt this is it. This is it. And that should just, I mean, light the fire of hope.

I think the writer of Hebrews. "...strengthen your feeble knees..." and you know, (Struggling to find words) that's a picture of me sometimes, you know, droopy arms. You know, you're kind of... No. Stand tall. Lift up your heads. Look up and see. Your redemption draws nigh. When you see these things begin to come to pass, and I'm going to use, this time, "at lightning speed." You don't like that? How about "warp speed"? That'll come up again. Don't worry.

Let's start with this 'Time Magazine' cover from back in 2023, pictured here. No photos, only words. "THE END OF HUMANITY." Note the A/I is highlighted with white in the word "humanity," suggesting that AI, artificial intelligence, will be the end of the human.

The subtitle below asks the question of "HOW REAL IS THE RISK?" It's "A SPECIAL REPORT," written by Katia Grace, which we always provide links to all of these. So just be patient with us. Here's just a couple of brief quotes. Listen very carefully.

"Experts are scared. I'll add, not quoting, rightfully so. ...machine intelligence would lead to impacts that had at least [And this number has gone up, by the way] had a 10% chance of being 'extremely bad' [They have that in quotation marks] ergo, human extinction." [What?] "...progress in AI could lead to the creation of superhumanly smart artificial "people" [In

quotation marks] with goals that conflict with humanity's interests and [Get this] the ability to pursue them autonomously."

You know what that means, right? They can think on their own, act on their own with autonomy. And then the writer, to her credit, writes this. And this is at the end of the article.

"...we shouldn't let people throw the world away in a perverse race to destruction."

Oh, my goodness. I don't know this particular author, but she may unwittingly, unknowingly, unbeknownst to her, she's quoting scripture. Keep in mind this was two years ago. But right now that, quote, perverse race to destruction is swiftly moving forward at warp speed. I still may use it again because — just hang on to that.

You know what I'm talking about when I say that. It's also important to keep in mind what the goal of AI is. Do you know what the goal of AI is? World-wide governance. Sound familiar? Also, with world-wide governance, there's the goal of immortality. I spent some time, but I ran out of time.

I have a quote from Elon Musk that I can't find the original source for. If you have it, please send it to us. Basically saying, and this is a loose quote, that we can achieve immortality. Of course, Yuval Harari out of Israel has already said as much, that we can upload our consciousness into the Cloud and live for all eternity without God. It's called transhumanism. And transhumanism is the sole goal of the Fourth Industrial Revolution.

No wonder Jesus would say what He said in *Matthew's Gospel, Chapter 24:22*. "And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; [No human would survive] but for the elect's sake..." [Speaking in this context of the Jews during the Tribulation] [which is the purpose of the Tribulation] [being that of the salvation of the Jewish nation] [we're going to talk about that a little bit more Second Service] "...but for the elect sake, those days will be shortened."

In other words, God's saying, listen, if I didn't intervene, no human flesh, humanity is at stake here. Humanity would not survive. What the enemy, who is behind all of this — because we wrestle not against flesh and blood, president or prime minister. We wrestle against principalities and powers of darkness, wickedness in high places.

And Paul, in *Ephesians 6*, delineates between four ranking entities in the demonic realm, sort of akin to military ranking. On Friday, the World Government Summit concluded, but not before Klaus Schwab's speech titled, "Governments in the Intelligent Age."

Now I want you to use your God-given intellect because God has given you intellect. God has given you an amazing mind. And we're to love the Lord with all of our heart, soul, and mind. Use your mind. I know I'm having a school flashback. Let me have it. When the teacher would say, "Put your thinking caps on." (Chuckling) They would say that to me a lot. But I want you to put your thinking caps on here because you're going to need them.

They couched in very interesting and curious terms to kind of throw you off. Why? Because, of course, the devil is the master deceiver, the master impostor, the master counterfeiter. So when they say, "intelligent age," they're talking about the New Age.

Here's two excerpts quoting Schwab. "...we are now moving from the Industrial Age to the intelligent age, but there is one big difference compared to the first transition from the agricultural to the Industrial Age where we had several generations to adapt. Now this transition is happening at [Here's a new one to add to your list] exponential speed."

So are we good so far? We've got warp speed, lightning speed, exponential speed. Okay.

"Everybody [Quoting Schwab] Everybody speaks about artificial intelligence. But just imagine what progress has been made just in the last three years now." He's right. He goes on to say, quote, "...so we are living in the transition to a new time which will change everything. It will change.

[He's on the record being interviewed as saying it doesn't change what you do] [It changes you] [It doesn't say that here, but that's what's behind what's here]

He says, quote, "It will change how we communicate, how we work, how we live. In the agricultural age, the economy was mainly based on agricultural products. In the Industrial Age, industrial products and services. But now in this new age, the base will be knowledge, [Hmhm] [The tree of the knowledge of good and evil] data, [Okay, that sounds that sounds nebulous, inconsequential] [Not until you find out that it's your data] and intelligent insights.

What does it mean for governments? Governments have to be enablers of this change. [And he says again] At lightning speed they have to provide the necessary infrastructure."

Oh, now I'm starting to see more clearly what's really going on here. If nothing else, this at least explains the declaration of a national emergency. Did you know about this? A national emergency has been declared [Wha-what?] to immediately build these massive AI infrastructure. We covered this over the last couple of weeks.

However, today I want to explain how now we're seeing the prophesied beast system, much of which has already been put in place but is even now about to be completed and put in place at, to quote Schwab, lightning speed. So I want to talk more about that, but we're going to end the livestream a little earlier than usual. So bye! Hope you're on the website.

Back in January, Klaus Schwab's World Economic Forum unveiled plans for permanently mass vaccinating the general public every six months with, quote, "long- acting" mRNA vaccines as part of an alleged effort to supposedly tackle multiple diseases, of which, by the way, if you haven't noticed, there's a new one every day.

You go into the store, especially if it's a drugstore, a pharmacy, and they got the music playing so loud. You know, when you're older, it's loud. "Turn it down." When you're younger, "Turn it up."

And I swear, there's subliminal, subliminal-bbb-ble, subliminal messages that are entering your subconscious, but they don't need it because they just outright say it. I shared this before. I'll share it again one day. I won't say where. I'm at a store that has a pharmacy and all — you know the music is playing, and then all of a sudden, they stop the music, and you hear what is probably an Al-generated voice because, I mean, it is just smooth as butter. "Did you know that we have over 72 vaccines available to protect you and your family?"

I'm like, "Get me out of here! Jesus, Jesus, get me out of here!"

I just quoted an article from back in January, but it comports with the aforementioned emergency declaration. We talked about it last week in the Update titled 'What's The Hurry?' They're in such a hurry. They got to get this done now. There's an expiration date. There's a shelf life. There's a deadline. They've got to "...build these massive Al infrastructures that would produce [Now, I'm quoting Larry Ellison here] MRNA vaccines

specific to the individual's unique DNA via a simple blood test. And these AI infrastructures will, utilizing AI and quantum computing, be able to tailor make, according to your unique DNA, a vaccine for the cancer we gave you within 48 hours, at lightning speed."

See, this is probably as good of a time as any, and I'm just going to take advantage of it. We don't hear this. And if we do hear this, we're not really hearing this. Let me explain. You know, it's interesting. God gave us eyelids. He didn't give us earlids. Why didn't He give us earlids? I know this is a weird illustration, but it's the best I got. So why didn't He give us earlids? Because no need. Because see, you can hear, but not really be listening.

Example: You're in a conversation with somebody, and they're talk, talk, talk, talk, talk, talk, talk, talk. And you're going, "Hmhm. Oh, is that right?" And they're just going on and on and on and on. And you're not hearing a word they say. And then you get busted when they ask you a question you go, "Is that right?"

See, you weren't really listening. Interesting that every one of the seven letters to the seven churches representative of the church age in the *Book of Revelation Chapters 2 and 3* end the same way, "Let him who has an ear..."

Well, everybody's got an ear, actually, two. Like one said, "God gave us two ears and one mouth." What does that tell you? Listen twice as much as you speak. I'm not speaking of anyone here. I know that you guys are, you know, more spiritual than I am. But that was for me.

But in other words, what Jesus was saying in those letters to those seven churches is just because you have ears doesn't mean you hear. And actually taking it further, just because you hear that doesn't mean you really listen. Because listening to what you hear is evidenced by heeding what you hear.

And that's what James says. "Don't be merely a hearer of God's word, but a doer of God's word." Jesus, in the parable of two builders — apparently, they both had a building project. They're building their house at the same time. They went to the same church. They heard the same sermon. But one of the builders built his house on the sand, the other one on the rock.

And in this parable, in the lesson of the parable, is the rock, the solid rock of Jesus Christ is

the sound foundation, so that when, not if, the storm hits, and the storm hits, you don't

come crashing down. Why? Because you're on the rock, man.

Well, what was the difference between the guy who built it on the rock and the guy who

built it on the sand? Oh, interesting. The guy who built it on the rock was a doer of God's

word. The guy who built his house on the sand was merely a hearer of God's word. How do

I know that? Because Jesus said he put the word into practice. He applied it to his life. He

was a doer of the word.

Now, why do I go into all of that? Because here's what we hear. Women will not play — or

men will not play in women's sports. And then everything after that — is kinda like when I

was a kid. My mom, she would hit a certain key and tone and volume with her thick accent

when she was really mad at me. And it was like, "Wahido!" And that was it. And all I heard

after that was (Zaghrouta call)

[Laughter]

No. For real. Come on, let's be honest. Right? It's actually a very insidious way of getting

you to only hear what they want you to hear when they say what you want them to say, to

disable you from hearing what you don't want to hear and don't want them to say.

In the same article back in January, Pfizer's CEO Albert Bourla... Have guys ever watched

videos of this guy? I just like, want to take a shower after it. You know, like, you just

seemed slimy. Enough of my problems. Let's move on.

Albert Bourla, CEO of Pfizer of Al-developed MRNA vaccines was quoted as saying, it would

be, [Listen to this] "something like a GPS-guided missile: a medicine that is very precise."

[Precision] This "guided missile" would ...target the cancer cells. He said that a "warhead"

would then kill those cells."

Okay, you know what I heard in that? Because, you know they throw in — first of all, them

are fighting words, right there. Warheads? Guided missiles? Target? Kill? Who? You.

Have a nice afternoon. You don't believe me?

"Oh, come on, Pastor, you're doing it again. There you go again."

Okay. How about we leave it at this? Just wait. You'll see. Because time will tell. This brings me to last week's World Governments Summit, which, unsurprisingly, Larry Ellison would speak at virtually with none other than Tony Blair for a Q&A session.

I want to share some of the quotes, starting with Blair, who's asking Ellison this question. [Blair, quote] "Just to start with a general question, I sometimes describe this Technology Revolution as the 21st century equivalent of the 19th century Industrial Revolution maybe more so. Give us your sense of the scale of this revolution, where it's taking us and its implications..."

[Ellison, answer] "About 18 months ago when we began to fully grasp what the people at OpenAI and ChatGPT had achieved a level of artificial intelligence that would actually [Listen carefully] advance human thinking, we created neural networks that could answer questions that human brains would struggle with. When we finally came to grips with that, I made a speech, and I said artificial intelligence is the most important discovery in the history of humankind."

That is so fascinating. Why, he would say humankind in lieu of mankind. No, that's deliberate. But see, we don't hear that. That's why I'm emphasizing that. Humankind. Maybe we'll soon find out. Wink, wink. He goes on. It gets worse. This is what he says.

"I think it's very, very, clear... [He took, he stole the title from my Update today] ...it's very, very clear it is a much bigger deal than the Industrial Revolution. We will soon have not only artificial intelligence but much sooner than anticipated artificial general intelligence [AGI] and in the not-too-distant future artificial superintelligence [ASI].

We will have incredible reasoning power, the ability to discover things that would elude human minds because this next generation of AI is going to reason so much faster, discover insights so much faster, whether it's being able to diagnose cancer in early stages or design therapies, [Yeah, right] custom design vaccines for those cancers, custom made for your genomics."

[Blair, question] "When it comes to governments, what it means for what government should do in terms of its digital infrastructure, you know, digital ID data centers, [Digital ID

data centers] and so on. I mean, we're here in the [UAE] United Arab Emirates, which is really at the forefront of the use of AI and government.

One of the things that people often ask from developing countries but also developed countries is what's the importance of having that basic digital infrastructure in place? You know, cloud services, data centers, digital identity. [Digital identity] How important are these things to put in place so that the rest of the system works effectively?

[Ellison] [Listen to this] "...right now, this is the last year you will ever log onto an oracle system with a password... by the middle of this year, we have biometric logins."

Biometric logins. No need for password. They've already been conditioning us. You know, we here in Hawaii — it's coming. We're starting to see it. But you go to some of these bigger metropolitan cities, and you walk in. The store's already scanned your — and recognized the facial recognition. They know more about you than you know about yourself. Bio is biology, biometric identification. So we can ID you using biometrics by AI. That's why.

Ellison continues. And you know who Ellison is, right? We know him here in Hawaii. He bought the island of Lanai. Right? I read somewhere where it was 98%. I mean, I don't know what the other 2%. Maybe that was part of the deal. But this guy bought the island of Lanai. Just let me. Yeah. Grrr.

This is that guy, co-founder of Oracle and many other big-tech companies. What's he doing in healthcare? So he goes on. This is Larry Ellison, Mr. Lanai. Sorry. Quote.

"One of the services, the most expensive of service we provide typically in our country is healthcare. We can deliver healthcare at a much lower cost, as long as [This is the fine print] the countries will put their data, their healthcare data, all of it, in a single place, where we can use an AI to help manage the care of all the patients and the population at large."

Okay. You know what these guys are talking about, right? What they're saying is exactly what the World Economic Forum's been saying and planning for many, many years now. BioDigital identity with healthcare at the top, as pictured here. I mean, this is why they need these massive data infrastructures.

And did you catch it? In a single place. All of it. Not most of it. Not spread out? No. All of it in one place. Why? Because Satan is not omnipresent. He is not omniscient, and he is not omnipotent, all-powerful, all-knowing, all-present. Only God is.

So that's why Satan needs to have it all in one place because he can't be two places at one time, so he just has to be one place at one time if it's all in one place at one time, all of it.

Did you get that? It wasn't very convincing, but we'll — I'll take, and we'll move on.

Here's what's happening. Just hear me out. This is all — some of which is already in place — but it's going to be completed and put in place so that artificial intelligence, which is satanic intelligence downloaded to man in exchange for their soul and worship with the same lie in the garden, that you can live forever without God. Hath God said, thou shalt surely not die? You can live forever.

So this AI, satanic intelligence, all in one place, all of it, can track and trace every human on earth vis-à-vis quantum computing and these AI infrastructures, which have all your data, all your health information, all your financial information, all in one place. So they will use this technology to determine whether or not you are in compliance to buy or sell.

Let me say the same thing in a different way. This is exactly what the Bible says will happen at the time of the end, a cashless system.

Enter Elon Musk, who's been given the keys to the castle of DOGE. What's DOGE? It's the acronym for the "Department of Government Efficiency." So that's an oxymoron right there. Kind of like "Microsoft Works." Oxymoron.

He also spoke virtually at this World Government Summit. And again, I'm just going to share with you some quotes. Quoting Musk.

"In the US there's roughly 450 federal agencies. How many agencies do you really need? ...I think we do need to delete entire agencies as opposed to leave part of them behind because if you leave part of them behind, it's kind of like leaving a weed. If you don't remove the roots of the weed, then it's easy for the weed to grow back. But if you remove the roots of the weed, it stops weeds from ever growing back."

Did you catch that? They're uprooting the current system, and there's no going back, to usher in their new system.

So still quoting Musk. "We have to really delete entire agencies. Maybe it's not shocking for those who know, but a big percentage of the problem is improving the technology that the government runs on. So the U.S. government runs on a collection of thousands of computers, many of them antiquated, running very old software.

And the computers don't even talk to each other. It's pretty bad. A lot of things should really be automated. ...that really should just be digitized and be a computer with the information stored in the cloud. ...It's like a big company, like a big corporation, America Incorporated. [Still quoting Musk] ...We pivot to artificial intelligence.

Blair then asked him about Grok-3. What's Grok-3? That's Musk's powerful AI chat bot. And to that he says, quote, "It probably gets released in about a week or two."

Okay, this was Friday, so oh, two weeks. Maybe next Friday.

"I think once you have humanoid robots and intelligence, you can basically have the infinite [Infinite] products and services available. So the most advanced humanoid robots can be directed by Deep intelligence in the form of humanoid robots. And the robots can basically do anything. You'll have [Listen] a universal high-income situation."

I have another quote. Again, I ran out of time. You know, you can only spend so many hours and days. I have a quote from Musk basically saying Universal Basic Income will be the best thing for the population of the world. And he just said it, but he kind of said it in a more amicable, palatable, you know, sort of way.

Still, quoting. And we're almost done. "It's going to be a very different world. [Excuse me, it already is] If you don't [Listen] if you don't have a scarcity of resources, [Musk] it's not clear what purpose money has. We don't need money if Al can think for us and do all these tasks.

[Cashless economy] [Digital economy] [He goes on. Still quoting Musk]

Human intelligence will be dwarfed by machine intelligence. It is inevitable that at some point, human intelligence will be a very small fraction of total intelligence. Digital intelligence will be more than 99% of all intelligence."

Do you feel stupid right now? Wow. And it's inevitable? Yeah. Let's now circle back to the evidence that I entered in, that the closer we are, the clearer we see the fulfillment of Bible prophecy, namely, that of how even now, it's all being rapidly built so as to ultimately fulfill the well-known prophecy found in *Revelation* 13.

You know it well. If you don't mind, though, I want to point out just one detail in verse 16 where we're told "He causes all to receive a mark to buy or sell, [On the forehead, forehand] rich and poor, free and slave."

I went to the original language of the Greek New Testament, and I wanted to look at this word he "causes." And it's the Greek word "poiei," [Not poi] "poiei," which can carry with it the idea of a requirement, a prerequisite.

Now, why do I point this out? Because having a BioDigital ID will be a prerequisite, a requirement as a pledge of allegiance to and worship of the image of the beast in the seven-year Tribulation, in order to buy or sell.

So picture in your mind, your God-given imagination. They're going to, at lightning speed, construct these massive AI data centers and the power sources for them, the power grid, and everything, all of it, all the data, all your data is going to be stored in these centers. So now you go out to the store.

And you want to just buy your groceries. And as soon as you walk in, the red light starts flashing, you know, security comes. Your social credit score or your carbon credit score or both are too low. You can't buy.

How do you know that? Oh because we have all of it in one place. And we have quantum computing that can use — for those of you that are savvy when it comes to quantum computing and quantum physics, I'm not one of you. You understand the speed at which they can compute data. It's a millisecond. It's so fast.

So I want to ask you a question. And the question is this. Wouldn't it stand to reason that if this technology is already in place and about to be completely put in place, that the pre-Tribulation rapture is about to take place? I do.

So what do we as born-again Christians do with all of this? I — it's a lot of information, but

it's just that. Knowledge is information, but wisdom is the application of that information.

We got to do something with it. Simply put, we need to get Jesus to people and people to

Jesus at lightning speed. Because they are.

This is why, and I hope you don't tire of me saying this, these weekly Prophecy Updates that

I've been doing for well-nigh two decades now have become more important than ever, and

so too has ending the Prophecy Updates become more important than ever with the Gospel

of salvation in the person of Jesus Christ and an explanation of how to be saved, how to be

born-again.

Nicodemus: He asked Jesus, how am I — how do you get born again? Do I go back in my

mom's womb? Be born again? No, spiritual birth. That was your physical birth. This is a

spiritual birth. Well, how can I be born-again? I'm glad you asked. It's so simple. It's

childlike simple. Now, this is not a formula. This is not a, insert tab A into slot B to get C.

No. It's just a tool.

So the first thing that has to happen, and I'll speak for myself. I had to come to that place

where I acknowledge and admitted that I was a sinner before I would ever think about

calling upon the Savior. Because the average person will tell you, "I'm a good person." But

that's not what determines your entrance into heaven.

Romans 3:10 says there's no one good. You might be a good person, but never, never good

enough. You — "There is no one righteous, not even one," save one, Jesus the Christ, who

was the only one. And here's why, Romans 3:23. It's because "All [And all means all] have

sinned..." We were born sinners, which is why we must be born-again, Jesus said. And all

have "...fallen short of the glory of God."

We missed the mark. That's what the word "sin" means. You missed the bullseye. It's an

archery term.

"Yeah, but I hit the bullseye 9 out of 10 times."

"It doesn't matter. You break one law, it's like breaking the whole thing. You sinner!"

Don't say it like that when you're sharing.

[Laughter]

Well, now I'm guilty as charged. We're back in court. I'm guilty.

"How do you plead?"

"Guilty."

Well, now we have to enter the sentencing phase.

"What's the sentence?"

"Oh, it's the death sentence."

"For the wages of sin is death." That's the bad news. We've all been sentenced to death because all have sinned. But here comes the good news. "...the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."

Notice the contrast between wages and gift. Wages: You earn. A gift: You don't. When you receive a gift — and don't re-gift it. Someone had to purchase it, right? It's a purchase, and you can't reimburse Him because then it's no longer a gift. It's a reimbursement purchase. No, he purchased us with His blood shed in our stead on the cross.

And that's the Gospel. The word "gospel" means good news, bruh. The bruh's not in the original.

[Laughter]

Your death sentence has been carried out by another. You are free to go. "And whom the Son has set free is free indeed." It's the gift. What do you do with a gift? Receive it. Open it. It's yours. Who paid for it? He did. How much did it cost Him? Everything. He left heaven to come to earth, become a man to die for man because of His love for man.

"For God so loved the world..." I love what Jesus says. You know, we don't go past John 3:16. There's more to that, you know. Jesus said I didn't come to condemn the world. I came to save it. Because I love the world. I love the people in the world, "And greater love hath no man than he lay down his life for another."

So He laid down His life, and He paid in full the purchase price for you and me. And He bought the gift of eternal life. And it's there for the receiving.

The B is so central. In fact, it could be said that it's simpler than A-B-C. It's as simple as B.

Just believe. "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten son, that

whosoever would believe...."

Now this is another one of those misnomers because, "Well, I believe in God."

"No, no, no."

That's not what that saying. To believe in your heart that Jesus Christ is Lord, what you're

saying is, I am putting my trust in Jesus Christ and His righteousness and not my own. I am

believing in Him that on that day when I stand before Him at the Bema Seat Judgment,

which, by the way, don't get weird on that. You got the Great White Throne Judgment.

Don't go there. Nobody from this church better be at that Great White Throne Judgment.

No, the Bema Seat Judgment.

What's that? Oh, picture the Olympic Games. And they got the judges, the panel. That's

when they give the rewards.

"Oh, I want, I want go that one. I want to go that one."

Well, that's where you'll go if you're putting your trust in Jesus Christ because it's not going

to be meritorious. I think one of the greatest dangers in the life of a Christian is to live the

Christian life meritoriously.

"What do you mean?"

In other words, you have to merit. Nah. You know, it was a bad week. God's mad. I was

bad. How sad. Doesn't work like that. There's no merit-based relationship. It's a saving

relationship. And you know, there's going to be a lot of so-called good people in hell and a

lot of people, really bad people in heaven. And I'll be at the front of the line. And don't look

at me all smug and spiritual. You're going to be right behind me. Because that's not the

gauge by which we are allowed entrance into eternity.

When I stand before God, I am justified. I love that word because it says what it means.

'Just-if-I'd' never sinned So He looks at you; He says, "Oh, you're in Christ. You're justified.

Come on in. Enter in. Well done, good and faithful servant." I hope that's what I — I long to

hear those words.

I hope He doesn't say, "Can you can you go back and just wait in line? Because we've got..." (Chuckling) That's not biblical, so don't... I just had to make sure you're still with me. We're almost done.

Because now comes the C. So the A leads to the B, which is manifested in the C, calling upon the name of the Lord, confessing with your mouth that Jesus Christ is Lord. Why? "Because out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks."

So if I've got Jesus Christ as Lord in my heart, what's going to come out of my mouth? Jesus. Jesus. When I first got saved over 40 — don't do the math. I was 5 — actually, I was 19 — 43 years ago, whatever it's been — I mean, first of all, there was so much brain damage because of my lifestyle. I'm not proud of it, but my theology was really basic. Jesus is real. Jesus is really, really real. I hadn't read the Bible all the way through yet for the first time, so that's all I knew. And that's all I talked about. Jesus.

Why? "Because out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks." I remember praying myself to sleep on a cold January night on the mainland. And Romans 10:13, which I didn't know about at the time, explained what happened when I woke up the next morning, and I was a new creation in Christ. And old things had passed away. I know it's different for everybody.

Some conversions when people are born-again, you know, are pretty dramatic. I think it had to be pretty dramatic for me. I mean, just, it was so dramatic. I knew something had changed when I went to reach for the alcohol and drugs and the tobacco and all of these things, and the Holy Spirit's now inside of me going, in that still, small, gentle, refining voice, "You don't need that anymore." And I lost my desire. And I never looked back. So what I was doing, unknowingly, was calling upon the name of the Lord.

Romans 10:13 says, "That all who call upon the name of the Lord will be saved." And you'll forgive the personal illustration, but I think too much has been made of praying a certain prayer a certain way. Repeat after me...

You want to know how I got saved? First of all, I was extremely high. And I was very drunk. And I didn't know how to pray. But I just prayed myself to sleep. And I slurred my words.

God, (Slurring words) I don't want to go to hell. (Slurring words) AC/DC says I'm on the highway to hell. I want to go heaven. (Slurring words) And I was saved.

Oh come on. No, repeat after me. You have to do this and do that.

No! I was but done. Nothing you can do. It is finished. Period. Sorry I'm yelling, spitting. Free baptisms, everybody on the front row, again. Again, I'm almost done. Let me, let me just say one last thing. The Lord knows and sees your heart. And the Lord has — Ecclesiastes tells us — put and set. You know the settings, the preferences?

The settings on your heart are set for eternity. He has set the settings of your heart on eternity, you know, the button. You know the — am I ruining it? I should probably quit while I'm ahead.

He's enabled that setting for eternity in your heart. The Lord knows your heart. You don't have to pray a certain way or, you know, go down the aisle and you know — if you don't publicly acknowledge Me before men, I won't... That's taken totally out of context.

I don't know why I went there. I probably should have stopped there. Let's do this. It's so simple. Believe. Believe in Him. Put your trust in Him for the forgiveness of sin, and you will be [Will be] saved. The Apostle John said you can know that you have eternal life.

You know how many people out there believe that the jury's still out, to use our courtroom metaphor? "I don't know. We'll have to see. Wait and see." You know, "The verdict's not in."

No, the verdict's in. "It is finished." Period. Debt's been paid. Aren't you glad there wasn't a comma there? And aren't you glad that Jesus didn't say, "It is finished; however," or "if," or "predicated upon."

And we're going to see this in *Revelation* today, Second Service. You have to come Second Service. This is all you're going to get out of me from the sermon, Second Service. Out of the throne in heaven comes a loud voice, the voice of God. And He says, "It is done!" Oh! Chicken skin. "It's done!" (Gasping) Thank you God! "It's done!"

Today's "But God Testimony" comes from Grant Warren, who writes "Pastor JD, my wife had a work-from-home job online. It was to test and train AI. She was doing it to help make

extra money when we needed it. But things started taking a very dark turn with the tests she was doing. Not only can we not, in good conscience, continue for her to work there, but the experience is frightening enough that we are changing our lives.

Honestly, there has been some financial difficulty with not having that income, but God will and has been making a way for us every time the bills come due in our budget. There's more, but it's hard to put into an email. Please keep us in your prayers. God bless you. Grant and Mary Warren."

Okay, the end. Kapono, come on up. Why don't you stand up? Thanks for hanging in there with me, again. I know it's a lot of stuff. But it's happening, you know? And I'm going to keep shouting it from the rooftops as long as the Lord gives me breath to and the privilege to. If you're here today, are watching online and you're unsure about this whole born-again thing You can settle it right now, right here.

Do not delay the most important decision of your life for eternal life. Today is the day of salvation. It's not too late. It's getting later as fast as things are moving. So why take that risk? Because we're talking about eternity here. That's what's at stake. I implore you, please. Please.

Let's pray. Father, I thank You for the grace that this Your church has shown me, the love that this Your church has shown me as I scream and yell and go on and on. Lord, I pray that the seed of Your word would fall on the supple soil of the heart. That it would germinate and sprout and bear good fruit unto righteousness.

And for anyone, Lord, that has never put their trust in You, believing in You, I pray that they would do that today, so they, too, can say that they know they have eternal life. This world is gone. It's game-over. This is it. And You're our only hope. You're our only way. You are THE way. You're our only hope and our blessed hope when that trumpet sounds, and You come and take us out of this world, not our home. Thank You, Lord. In Jesus' name, Amen.
