MOSES	JESUS
Was saved from death in Egypt as an infant (Acts 7:18-21)	Was saved by fleeing to Egypt as an infant (Matthew 2:13-16)
Learned wisdom and was mighty in words (Acts 7:22)	Astonished many in the synagogue in His teachings (Mark 6:2)
Pharaoh's daughter adopted Moses (Exodus 2:10)	Joseph adopted Jesus (Matthew 1:25)
Moses became a prince of Egypt (Exodus 2:10)	Jesus is the Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:5, Matthew 28:18)
Went from being a prince to a pauper (Exodus 2:15-19)	Went from being God to being man (John 1:1-3; Mark 6:3)
Saved women at a well (Exodus 2:15-19)	Saved the woman at the well (John 4)
Became a shepherd (Exodus 3:1)	Is the Good Shepherd (John 10:11)
Supposed his brethren understood but did not (Acts 7:25)	The world and His own received Him not (John 1:10-11, 6:66)
Was rejected by his people (Exodus 2:12-14, Acts 7:35)	Was rejected by Israel (John 1:11, Mark 15:12-15)
Fled to Midian wilderness before delivering them (Acts 7:29)	Retired to the wilderness before His ministry (Matthew 4:1-11)
Spent 40-years in the wilderness (Deuteronomy 8:2)	Spent 40-days in the wilderness (Mark 1:13, Luke 4:1-2)
Fasted for forty days and forty nights (Exodus 24:17-18)	Fasted for forty days and forty nights (Matthew 4:1-2)
Ministered to by angels and was tempted (Exodus 23:20-23)	Ministered to by angels and was tempted (Mark 1:12-13)
Delivered Israel from slavery in Egypt (Acts 7:34)	Delivered us from slavery to sin (John 8:33-36)
Freed them through a lamb without blemish (Exodus 12:5)	Freed us through His own blood as the Lamb (John 1:29)
They were ready to stone him (Exodus 17:4)	They took up stones to cast at Him (John 8:59)
Took twelve men (Deuteronomy 1:23)	Chose twelve disciples (Mark 3:13-14)
Gathered seventy men of the elders (Numbers 11:16)	Appointed seventy also (Luke 10:1)
Delayed his coming down from the Mount (Exodus 32:1)	Mocked for delaying the promise of His coming (2 Peter 3:3-4)
Was given a parting blessing (Deuteronomy 33:1)	While He blessed them He parted from them (Luke 24:50-51)
Gave the law from a mountain (Exodus 19-24)	Gave a new law from a mountain (Matthew 5-7)
Parted the Red Sea (Exodus 14:21)	Calmed the Sea of Galilee (Matthew 8:26)
Performed signs and wonders (Acts 7:36)	Went about healing all manner of sickness (Matthew 4:23)
The people turned back again in their hearts (Acts 7:39)	Many went back and walked with Him no more (John 6:66)
