- At our midweek Bible study last Thursday, we were in 1 Kings 7-8, which at first read can seem to be very long and very boring.
- However, in the midst of all the boring details about the construction of Solomon's temple, we uncovered a valuable treasure.
- We were introduced to a man filled with wisdom and understanding, who built two bronze pillars, with two interesting names.
- 1 Kings 7:13-14,21 Now King Solomon sent and brought Huram from Tyre. He was the son of a widow from the tribe of Naphtali, and his father was a man of Tyre, a bronze worker; he was filled with wisdom and understanding and skill in working with all kinds of bronze work. So he came to King Solomon and did all his work. ...21 Then he set up the pillars by the vestibule of the temple; he set up the pillar on the right and called its name Boaz.
- It's the names of these two pillars that I would like to draw your attention to because this is what the Israelites would see daily.
- Every time the Israelites would enter the temple they would see Jachin meaning "He shall establish" and Boaz "In it is strength."
- Here's the take away; we are the temple of the Holy Spirit, which is built up, established, and strengthened by the Word of God.
- I would venture to say that as Christians, this is our only hope of standing strong and not faltering or falling in the days ahead.
- I'll take it a step further and suggest Biblical wisdom; understanding and knowledge will provide us peace in the midst of turmoil.
- Knowing what God's Word says about what's happening in the world today will steady us and ready us until He comes for us.
