Middle-East Prophecy Update – October 23rd, 2011

 Every week, since back in 2006, we have set aside a few minutes on Sunday mornings so as to devote some time to studying Bible prophecy. The reason that we do this is because the Bible predicts certain specific events that will take place in the last days before the Lord returns. We believe that what's happening in the world today is a fulfillment of those Bible Prophecies, and that the rapture could happen at any time.
- We look primarily at events in the Middle East, specifically related to Israel because, as it's been said; "Israel is God's prophetic clock."
 I had a difficult time finding something for today's prophecy update, since there's nothing really happening in the world right now geopolitically. First, there was Muammar Qaddafi's death on Thursday, then, the President's announcement of bringing home our troops in Iraq on Friday. This was followed by the death of Saudi Arabian Crown Prince Sultan ibn Abdulaziz on Saturday, then in Turkey, a 7.2 earthquake just today. So, what I decided to do was address the death of Muammar Gaddafi and what the Bible says will be both the role of, and the future for Libya. It's interesting that "the tyrant of Tripoli," as he's been called, would meet his brutal death in this way, and at this time. Everything is on schedule.
 Before we go any further, I think I'd be grossly remiss were I not to share a couple of thoughts about the multitudes of Muslims coming to Christ. If you really think about it, with what's happening in places like Libya, Egypt, and Syria, many are losing hope in Islam, as it has nothing to offer. I'm not being derogatory but I'm of the belief that the Muslim in Libya is more open to the Gospel than is the American here in the United States.
 The reason I say this is, in the Middle-East, especially amongst my countryman the Arab people, family life is riddled with unspeakable hardship. These people are hitting rock bottom, losing everything they've ever known, even family members who were slaughtered at the hands of Islam. It's been said that; "you will never know that Jesus is all you need, until Jesus is all you have." The Arab's are finding that Jesus is all they have.
- Be that as it may, I'll draw your attention to two prophecies concerning Libya both of which are in the Old Testament; Daniel 11:43, Ezekiel 38:5.
Daniel 11:43 NKJV He shall have power over the treasures of gold and silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt; also the Libyans and Ethiopians <i>shall follow</i> at his heels.
Ezekiel 38:5 NKJV Persia, Ethiopia, and Libya are with them, all of them with shield and helmet;
 Here's what I'm thinking; Daniel's prophecy tells us about the future for Libya, and Ezekiel's prophecy tells us about the role of Libya yet future. The Anti-Christ will seize control of Egypt, Libya, and Ethiopia, and they will in turn play a role in the Islamic alliance of nations attacking Israel. It seems to me that with Egypt's Mubarak and Libya's Gaddafi out of the prophetic picture, the global leadership vacuum is about to be filled.
 There's something else here that I've been musing over as of late; have you noticed that there's a "revolution" of sorts taking place in the world. The protests went from Tahrir Square in Egypt, then to the shores of Tripoli in Libya, and then to the streets of the financial district of Manhattan. What I find peculiar is that this "revolution" under the banner of the Arab Spring/Occupy Movement, has inherent within it a common agenda.
 It's also odd how there are hardly any burnings of the current President in effigy after Bin Laden, and Gaddafi, as compared with after Hussein. What's even more peculiar is how the Occupy revolution is not protesting against the leader of America, it's against God's blessing on America. The unspeakable blessing and prosperity that we've enjoyed here in the United States, has been directly proportionate to our support of Israel.
Genesis 12:2-3 NKJV (2) I will make you a great nation; I will bless you And make your name great; And you shall be a blessing. (3) I will bless those who bless you, And I will curse him who curses you; And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."
 Not only is America turning her back on Israel, I would submit, for many years now, the church in America has been turning her back on Israel. What Christians don't know is, cursing Israel comes packaged with losing our blessing from the Lord, and losing hope in the return of the Lord.
