## Mid-East Prophecy Update – December 1st, 2013

- For today's update, I'll begin by correcting a mistake that I made last week, when I misspoke concerning the blood moons on Jewish feasts.
- I was incorrect when I stated the Yom Kippur war was associated with a blood moon; it wasn't Yom Kippur in 73, it was the 6-day war in 67.
- It's for this reason that I decided to do some research on, and a study of, what are known as the Blood Moon Tetrads, in 2014, and 2015.
- First, let me explain what a Tetrad is, as I understand it, a Tetrad is four sequential lunar eclipses with no intervening partial lunar eclipses.
- It's believed that this Tetrad has occurred on Jewish Feast Days only seven times since the year 1 AD, making 2014-2015 the eighth time. In other words, they've only happened seven times in the last 2,013 years, and three of those occurrences were within the last 520 years.
- The last three times were in 1493-94, 1949-50, and 1967-68. The common denominator with all three is they represent significant events.
- 1493 the Jewish population was driven out of Spain in the inquisition as the great dispersion resumed and Columbus discovered America.
- 1949 the Jews celebrated their first Passover after their rebirth as a nation in 1948. 1967 the Jews regained Jerusalem in the 6-Day war.
- This is why prophecy watchers are so excited, the thought is that if the last three times marked significant events then this next one will too.
- Namely, if the first began persecution, the second began rebirth, and the third began Jerusalem, the fourth may begin Daniels 70<sup>th</sup> week.
- This because on April 15th, 2014 the first of the four total lunar eclipses occurs and it just so happens to be the Jewish Feast of Passover.
- After the April 15th, 2014 Feast of Passover blood moon, the next blood moon occurs on October 8th, 2014, which is the Feast of Succoth.
- Then the third one occurs on March 20th, 2015, which again, is the Feast of Passover, and the fourth is on September 13th, 2015, Succoth.
- Also, there are solar eclipses in between these four blood moons, one of which is on the Jewish New Year, another the Feast of Trumpets.
- Now, I'm keenly aware, there are those who would argue that this so called Blood Moon Prophecy has the propensity to be extra biblical.
- Be that as it may, I think we would err greatly to quickly make predictions based on this, or to quickly be dismissive of this. Here's why:
- You would have to somehow come up with an explanation of certain passages of scripture that foretell signs in the moon sun and the stars.
- While I don't have the time to expound on this, I think I'd be remiss were I not to at least mention this for those interested in a study of it.
- What I'm speaking of is fascinating prophecy found in Revelation twelve, specifically verse one, concerning the sun, moon and the stars.
- If you're interested you can do your own search of this and the Blood Moons, though I would caution you to use your discernment if you do.
- Having said that, I'll bring today's update in for a landing by first reading, then expounding, on three prophecies that foretell of these events.

Revelation 12:1 NIV A great and wondrous sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and a crown of twelve stars on her head.

Luke 21:25-28 (25) "There will be signs in the sun, moon and stars. On the earth, nations will be in anguish and perplexity at the roaring and tossing of the sea. (26) Men will faint from terror, apprehensive of what is coming on the world, for the heavenly bodies will be shaken. (27) At that time they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. (28) When these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is drawing near."

Acts 2:17-21 NIV "In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. (18) Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. (19) I will show wonders in the heaven above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke. (20) The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and glorious day of the Lord. (21) And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'
