Mid-East Prophecy Update – October 14th, 2018

For today's prophecy update I want to talk about what I would argue were major developments towards a Mideast peace plan.
Namely, the long anticipated peace plan from the Trump administration, which many believe will be finally unveiled very soon.
I would suggest that when, not if, it is, it will set in motion very suddenly, the fulfillment of significant prophecies in the Bible.

I'll begin with this Times of Israel report on Tuesday about the shocking and sudden resignation of US Ambassador to the UN, Nikki Haley. As you might imagine, speculation abounds as to why, and why now, in spite of claims that she told President Trump she might want to take some time off, six months ago. What I found to be very telling was Haley's comments concerning Jared Kushner, Trump's special adviser and son-in-law, on the Trump administration's Israeli-Palestinian peace plan. Of Kushner, Haley said, and I quote, ""Looking at what we've done on the Middle East peace plan. It is so unbelievably well done," ..."Jared is such a hidden genius that no one understands."

Haley's sudden resignation begs the question of who her replacement will be, or perhaps more importantly, according to The Jerusalem Post, will her replacement be as supportive of Israel as she has been. Quoting the Post, "Haley was a godsend at the UN from Israel's point of view, passionately, eloquently and calmly defending the Jewish State and calling out the world for its hypocrisy and bias towards the country. Whomever US President Donald Trump appoints to replace outgoing Ambassador to the UN Nikki Haley will have very large shoes to fill, said Danny Danon, Israel's ambassador to the UN, in response to Haley's surprise resignation on Tuesday. ...No sooner had Haley announced her departure than the speculation began as to whom Trump would tap as her successor. One of the first names mentioned was the president's daughter Ivanka, who Trump said would be "incredible" in the job. She, however, made it clear that this was not in the offing, tweeting Tuesday evening, "I know that the president will nominate a formidable replacement for Ambassador Haley. That replacement will not be me."

It should probably come as no surprise that within 24-hours of Haley's shocking resignation that US Secretary of State Mike Pompeo would seek to reassure Israel that relationship between the United States and Israel, "...is everything we want the entire Middle East to look like going forward." He went on to say, "The bottom line is that the US-Israel relationship is stronger today than it has been ever, and that's good for both countries," ...Pompeo also noted that the administration is making "a truly historic push for peace between Israel and the Palestinians", a reference to the Middle East peace plan being prepared by Trump's senior adviser, Jared Kushner, and his Representative for International Negotiations, Jason Greenblatt. The Secretary of State provided no further details other than saying the plan will be released "before too terribly long, and we are hopeful that both sides will have constructive conversations to lead to that."

While I realize I could be accused of reading too much into the timing of this, it is suspect at best, as some suggest that Hurricane Michael formed as suddenly and even simultaneously with the aforementioned "historic push for peace between Israel and the Palestinians." Al Arabiya dubbed the storm that decimated Florida's Panhandle the "hurricane of a century." Other sources are reporting that it's now the third strongest storm to ever hit the Continental US falling short of a Category 5 Hurricane by only 2 mph. Please know that I never want to be dogmatic about something this serious in nature, however, there is compelling evidence that every time a U.S. President has pushed Israel concerning the land, a catastrophic event devastates our land here in America.
