The Law of First Mention

Is a principle used in biblical interpretation that suggests the first time a word, concept, or doctrine is mentioned in the Bible, its meaning and significance are established in that initial context. This first mention provides a foundation for understanding the term or concept throughout the rest of Scripture.

For example, the first mention of "offering" in the Bible is in Genesis 4:3, where Cain and his brother Abel worship God by giving an offering. This establishes the significance of worship through presenting God an offering, a theme that recurs throughout the Bible.
