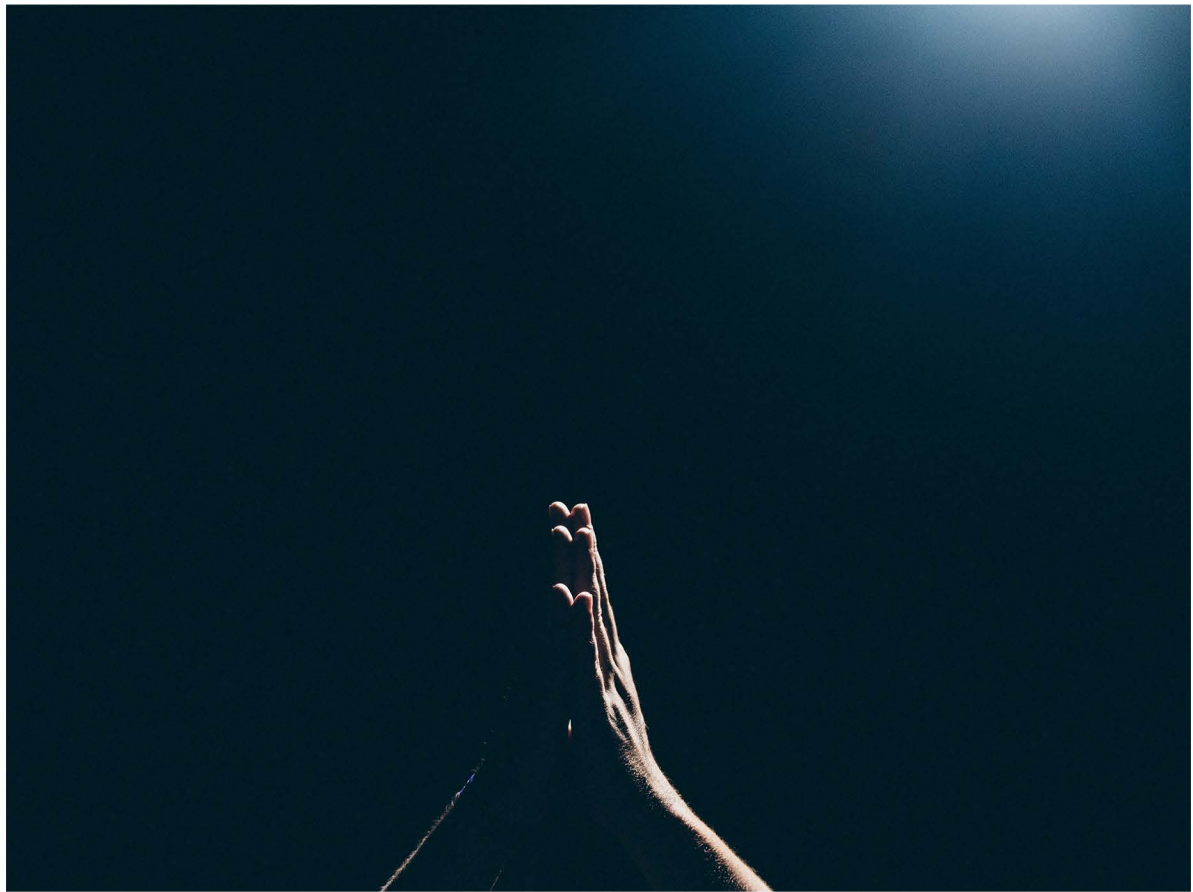

Praise is a verbal/auditory extension of our worship.

AINĒŌ [*GREEK*] - TO PRAISE

BARAK [*HEBREW*] - TO BLESS, DECLARE BLESSED

EPAINEŌ [*GREEK*] - TO GIVE PRAISE TO

EULOGĒŌ [*GREEK*] - TO SPEAK WELL OF

HALAL [*HEBREW*] - TO PRAISE, TO BOAST IN

HUMNEŌ [*GREEK*] - TO HYMN

SHABACH [*HEBREW*] - TO GLORIFY

SHEBECH [*HEBREW*] - TO GIVE PRAISE

YADAH [*HEBREW*] - TO STRETCH OUT THE HAND,
CONFESS

ZAMAR [*HEBREW*] - TO GIVE PRAISE
