Lamentations 3:22b-23a

22b ...For His compassions do not fail;

23a They are new every morning...

Psalm 69:32b

...You who seek God, let your heart revive.

Psalm 27:4

One thing I have asked from Jehovah; / That do I seek: / To dwell in the house of Jehovah / All the days of my life, / To behold the beauty of Jehovah, / And to inquire in His temple.

Proverbs 8:17

III. A fixed time and place

John 20:1

Now on the first day of the week, Mary the Magdalene came early to the tomb while it was yet dark and saw the stone taken away from the tomb.

Isaiah 50:4b

...He awakens *me* morning by morning; / He awakens my ear / To hear as an instructed one.

Matthew 6:6

But you, when you pray, enter into your private room, and shut your door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will repay you.
